




Key AFF product export value to Korea, Sep-2023

Korea's export turnover increased again

Korea's export turnover in the first 20 days of October increased by 8.6% over the same period last year, marking the first increase in the past year. Previously, export data in September also recorded a positive signal with a lower decrease of 4.4%, much lower than the previous forecast of 9.3%.

Korean officials hope that the new figures demonstrate the recovery of the Northeast Asian economy's export in the last months of 2023, contributing to the economic growth when Korea depends heavily on exports. Besides, this is also considered as a signal of recovering global trade, because Korea plays an important role in the global supply chain.

Vietnam's mango market share increased in Korean market

According to Korea International Trade Association (KITA), Korea's import of mangoes (HS 08045020) in the first 9 months of 2023 was 23.6 thousand tons and 95 Mil.USD, increasing 14.7% in volume and 8.4% in value compared to the same month of 2022.

Vietnam is the third largest mango supplier for Korea. In the first 9 months of 2023, mango volume that imported from Vietnam account for 7.3% of Korea's total mango imports, reaching 1.7 thousand tons and 7.2 Mil.USD, increasing 19.6% in volume and 18.1% in value compared to the same month of 2022.






Export value to Korea, Sep-2023










Structure of exports by products to Korea, Sep-2023





Import of frozen squid poulp in Korea increased

In September 2023, Korea imported 1,696 tons of frozen squid, an increase of 14% compared to 1,482 tons in the same period last year. Accumulated in the first 9 months of the year, imports of this product reached 16,916 tons, an increase of 7% compared to 15,870 tons of the same period last year and accounting for 2.4% of the country's total seafood import volume. Regarding origin, Korea imported 11,544 tons from China (accounting for 68% of total frozen squid imports), 3,550 tons from Vietnam, 714 tons from Thailand, and 628 tons from Indonesia.

Korea's mackerel imports decrease

Frozen mackerel imports into Korea in September 2023 reached 48 tons, a decrease of 21% compared to 61 tons in the same period last year. Total imports of mackerel in the first 9 months of 2023 reached 37,384 tons, decreasing 9% compared to last year's, accounting for 4.7% of Korea's total seafood imports, of which Korea imported 27,941 tons (82%) frozen mackerel from Norway, 3,645 tons from China, 1,352 tons from Taiwan and 611 tons from the Netherlands

Vietnam's seafood exports to the Korean market returned to negative growth, especially shrimp products. This shows that the competitiveness of Vietnamese shrimp products is weaker than that of other producers such as Ecuador and India. Currently, the shrimp supply is still very abundant, causing shrimp prices to remain low in the near future. Therefore, Vietnam's exports to Korea are unlikely to have a breakthrough in the last months of 2023.






Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Sep-2023









Korea has become a coffee producing country

Korea has become to produce grean coffee with very small production, accounting for only 0.0043% of annual coffee imports. Coffee is grown on farms in Gyeongsangnam.

In Korea, coffee is grown in greenhouses, so the price is much higher than imported products. Despite this, Korean coffee still has distinct characteristics, such as terroir, that can create commercial value.

Changes in coffee consumption habits of office staff in Korea

According to a survey of Embrain Trend Monitor, 30.7% of office staff said they limit drinking coffee after lunch to save costs.

Due to the influence of inflation, the coffee consumption habits of office staff are changing. They tend to drink coffee at their home instead of coffee shops to save costs. To meet consumers' demand, businesses have launched new coffee services, such as hiring coffee machine at office.




Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Korea, Sep-2023










Percentage of import value from Korea, Sep-2023








In 2023, South Korea's rice output is estimated to reach 3,684,000 tons, decreasing 2.1% over the same period last year, due to the decrease in paddy growing area. South Korea's rice area decreased by 2.6% to 708,041 hectares, this is the lowest level since 1975. In addition, the country's rice consumption also decreased during the past decade, due to changing eating and drinking habits.







TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Sep-2023




TOP export enterprises by volume to Korea, Sep-2023









Percentage of export value to Korea, Sep-2023















Although the temporary quota eliminated the tariff advantage of US beef over major competitors and helped spur a sharp increase in imports from Australia and Canada However, this action also boosted beef demand in Korea's market in the context of increasing inflation and the sharp devaluation of the Korean Won.





The Korean Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (MAFRA) has decided to remove trade barriers with European pork and poultry products. Korea accept the strict regionalization measures that applied by EU to combat African swine fever and highly pathogenic avian influenza. The decision will create more than 1 billion euros in trade between Korea and EU over the next years. This decision benefits the 11 EU countries that have been authorized to export pork and poultry products to Korea.







Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Sep-2023






Structure of exports by products to Korea, Sep-2023






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Sep-2023




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Korea, Sep-2023

According to Korean Customs Agency, in the first 9 months of 2023, Korea imported 153.01 tons of cassava (HS 071410), worth 53.27 Mil.USD, decreasing 33.2% in volume and 29.7% in value compared to the same month of 2022. Thailand, Vietnam and the Philippines are three suppliers of cassava to Korea market. Cassava market share of Vietnam accounts for 49.67% of Korea's total cassava imports, increasing to 41.85% of the first 9 months of 2022. Meanwhile, Thailand's cassava market share accounts for 50.33% of the total Korean cassava import, decreasing sharply compared to 58.15% of the same period in 2022.
