



#### Key AFF product export value to Korea, Jun-2023



# South Korea cuts its growth outlook for 2023 due to concerns about global economic instability and weak growth in China and the US

South Korea's Finance Ministry forecasts that the country's gross domestic product (GDP) will grow by 1.4% this year, down slightly from the previous forecast of 1.6%. At the same time, the economy is expected to recover next year with GDP growth reaching 2.4%.

Analysts also downgraded their forecast for South Korea's inflation rate. Economists from the Ministry of Finance of South Korea forecast the growth rate of the consumer price index (CPI) will slow to 3.3% by the end of 2023 - down slightly from the previous estimate of 3.5% and is expected to decrease further next year.

To support economic growth, the South Korean government said it will prepare measures to support export businesses with the goal of ensuring orders from abroad reach \$ 35 billion this year.

South Korea's Finance Ministry also said it would not raise fees this year as part of efforts to ease the burden of living costs on consumers.

## **2** Exports to Korea gradually recovered clearly

According to statistics of the General Department of Customs, the export turnover of Vietnamese goods to the Korean market in June 2023 reached 1.8 billion USD, up 15% compared to the previous month. 6 months of 2023 reached 11 billion USD, down 9.1% over the same period last year.

Of which a number of agricultural, forestry and fishery products grew well such as: Vegetables and fruits exported to Korea were also in the top growth, reaching 102 million USD, up 12%; coffee 54.5 million USD, up 10%.







## **SPOTLIGHT**

The value of wood imports in May 2023 of Korea increased by 17.9% compared to April and the import volume also increased by 8.2%. The reason for the increase in import volume in May was the increase of woodchip imports by 155,000 tons, sawn timber by 42,000 m3 and pulp by 28,000 tons. However, imports of logs fell 14.6% and veneers decreased by 63%.








#### Structure of exports by products to Korea , Jun-2023





#### Japan asks South Korea to accept seafood imports from Fukushima

Japan continues to ask Korea to import seafood from Fukushima, hoping that Korea will soon lift the import ban by explaining that products in the area are still safe. The Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Rafael Grossi will visit Tokyo in early July 2023 to submit the final report on the safety assessment of the wastewater discharge plan at the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant. In the face of ever-improving bilateral relations, Japan is expecting the Korean authorities to ease restrictions on Japanese seafood products.

#### Korean pollock imports decrease

Korea's pollock imports in June 2023 reached 9,289 tons, down 71% from 31,807 tons in the same period last year. Total imports of this item in the first half of this year reached 78,415 tons, down 55% over the same period. In terms of value over the same period last year, pollock imports in June 2023 reached US\$4.26 million, down 80%; accumulated in the first half of the year reached 85.68 million USD, down 60%.






#### Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Jun-2023









## **SPOTLIGHT**



According to Korean Customs, the price of coffee imports in June 2023 has decreased by 21% since the peak of the previous year (\$7.1/ton). However, the price of coffee in the Korean market has not yet decreased due to high domestic demand and high labor costs.

According to the Korea Economic Research Institute, Korean adult coffee consumption reaches 353 cups per year, 1.3 times higher than the world average.



**TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Jun-2023** 







Korean onion producers called on the government to withdraw its decision to increase TRQ (low tariff quota) onions by 90,000 tons. However, the Korean government has planned to announce the tender for the first 20,000 tons, the remaining 70,000 tons will be discussed later.


The Korea Garlic Producers Association called on the government to immediately take measures to stabilize supply and demand, including measures to purchase and store garlic products because the market price of garlic is lower than the production cost. The reason is that this year's weather is unfavorable for production, causing garlic output to decrease, and at the same time, increased labor costs lead to increased production costs.




## Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Jun-2023





## **SPOTLIGHT**

South Korea will sign an agreement with eight African countries to help increase rice production while reducing dependence on imported rice. Under the Rice Belt Project, Korea will build seed production facilities in Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Gambia, Senegal, Cameroon, Uganda and Kenya to produce rice varieties adapted to local conditions and yield 2 to 3 times with domestic varieties. The Korean Ministry of Agriculture said that Korea plans to invest about \$77 million in this project over four years with the goal of distributing 10,000 tons of rice seeds per year from 2027.




#### Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Jun-2023












## **TOP export enterprises by volume to Korea**, Jun-2023













TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Jun-2023



The Korean Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs analyzed data provided by the US government and confirmed that BSE occurring in the United States is an atypical case, unlike typical BSE caused by contaminated food and there are no known cases of infection in humans. In addition, the department also explained that no Specific Risk Substances (SRMs) were found in US beef during the enhanced testing period. Therefore, the Korean Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs will adjust the quarantine measures for US beef to the normal level of 3% from July 31, 2023.





According to the National Bureau of Statistics, the Livestock Trends Survey in the second quarter of 2023 showed that the number of beef cattle, dairy cows and pigs in Korea decreased compared to last year, while the number of poultry such as laying hens and broiler chickens increased. Specifically: The number of beef cattle decreased by 1.3% compared to 2022, raised cows decreased by 1.4%, raised pigs decreased by 58,000 heads, hens increased by 2.9%, total broiler chickens increased by 4.3%.










#### Structure of exports by products to Korea, Jun-2023






#### **TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Jun-2023**




#### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Korea, Jun-2023

CASSAVA & CASSAVA PRODUCTS

From 2022 to now, Vietnam's exports of cassava and cassava products to South Korea have not yet created a stable growth momentum, but in general, have increased strongly. The market development for cassava and cassava products is relatively slow, so Korea is still one of the main consuming markets for Vietnam's cassava products.



**SEAFOOD** 

Seafood exports to Korea continued to have positive growth compared to the previous month. This is still an optimistic destination for Vietnam's processed seafood with high added value. In this market, Vietnamese seafood has not been under competitive pressure in terms of supply and price like in the US, EU or China.
