


Key AFF product export value to Korea, Nov-2024

The South Korean economy slows down despite strong export growth

At the beginning of 2024, both the South Korean government and major international financial organizations forecasted an economic growth rate of around 2.4-2.6% for the year, driven by strong export performance thanks to the recovery of the chip industry and increased foreign demand. However, this forecast has been revised down to around 2.2-2.3% compared to the previous estimate, despite continued strong growth in semiconductor exports. This adjustment reflects the slow recovery of domestic demand due to high interest rates and the prolonged impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, which has led to reduced consumption and investment.

South Korea's economy faces risks from political instability

South Korea's economy is facing risks as President Yoon Suk Yeol is suspended from office and Prime Minister Han Duck Soo temporarily assumes presidential duties, creating instability and weakening the country's ability to negotiate trade deals. Meanwhile, U.S. President Donald Trump is set to take office in January 2025 and may impose import tariffs of over 10% on goods from South Korea.

Compared to 2017, an increase in import tariffs will put pressure on key export sectors such as chips, cars, and batteries. South Korea's trade surplus with the United States rose from \$16.37 billion in 2019 to \$44.4 billion in 2023. Reducing the U.S. trade deficit has become a potential target for the new administration.








Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Nov-2024









The Korean seafood industry plans to expand export markets

The National Federation of Fisheries Cooperatives (NFFC) of South Korea has announced a plan to expand its export markets in order to reduce dependence on the Chinese market, including mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan. NFFC President Noh Dong-jin stated that currently, four out of the 11 NFFC trade support centers are located in China.


To address this, NFFC plans to relocate some of these centers to the Middle East and South America by 2025, while also developing region-specific strategies to promote seafood exports to these markets. Additionally, the federation is considering opening an office in Japan to directly export and distribute seafood products, taking advantage of the growing demand for abalone, flounder, and eel in Japan.





Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Nov-2024






Structure of exports by products to Korea, Nov-2024





Paris Baguette, part of the South Korean SPC Group, aims to reach 12,000 stores globally by 2030. Currently, it has over 3,750 stores in South Korea and more than 600 stores in 14 countries, with China being the largest market, hosting 348 stores.

The chain also has branches in Southeast Asia, including Singapore, Malaysia, and Vietnam, and plans to expand into Brunei, Laos, and Thailand by 2025. In the U.S. and Canada, Paris Baguette has 193 stores and aims to reach 1,000 stores by 2030. In Europe, the company has stores in France and the UK, with plans to open 450 stores by 2036. Paris Baguette is also considering a partnership with Caffè Pascucci to enter the Italian market.













South Korea tightens tomato export measures to Japan due to concerns over leaf-eating pests

The Korean Animal and Plant Quarantine Agency has announced the implementation of stricter measures for tomato exports to Japan. Tomato producers will be required to conduct inspections using traps two months before harvest. This regulation is expected to take effect in January 2025.

The city of Gimhae is implementing trade promotion programs to expand the foreign market for Jinyeong persimmons, aiming to address the decline in exports last year due to anthrax disease. The city, in collaboration with the Hallym Agricultural Cooperative, is organizing a promotional event offering discounts on sweet persimmons at a total of 10 markets in Jakarta from December 5-22, 2024.






Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Nov-2024












Export volume and value to Korea, Nov-2024








Structure of exports by products to Korea, Nov-2024






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Nov-2024




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Korea, Nov-2024





In the first 10 months of 2024, South Korea imported rubber (HS 40) worth 2.52 million USD, a 3.9% increase in value compared to the same period in 2023. Thailand, China, Indonesia, Japan, the United States, Ivory Coast, and Vietnam are the largest markets supplying rubber to South Korea. Among these, South Korea increased imports of rubber from Ivory Coast, Vietnam, Thailand, China, and Indonesia, while reducing imports from Japan and the United States compared to the same period in 2023.










Percentage of export value to Korea, Nov-2024










Structure of exports by products to Korea, Nov-2024






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Nov-2024




Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Korea, Nov-2024

In the first 10 months of 2024, South Korea imported cassava and cassava products worth 41.7 million USD, a 49.6% decrease in value compared to the same period in 2023. Thailand is the largest supplier of cassava to the South Korean market, accounting for 42% of total cassava imports, followed by Vietnam (39%), Taiwan (18.4%), and China (0.6%)
