
AFF product import-export turnover between Vietnam and Japan, Nov-2024











SPOTLIGHTS

Japan Records Trade Deficit for the Fifth Consecutive Month

Japan's trade balance continued to post a deficit in November 2024, exceeding 117.6 billion yen (approximately USD 770 million), marking the fifth consecutive month of deficits. Exports in November reached 9.1524 trillion yen (USD 60 billion), up 3.8% year-on-year, driven by growth in items such as automobiles, non-ferrous metals, and construction equipment. Meanwhile, imports fell by 3.8% to 9.27 trillion yen (USD 67.7 billion), primarily due to declining crude oil prices. However, imports of other energy sources, such as liquefied natural gas, remained high.

Japan Allocates Additional \$90 Billion for New Economic Stimulus Package

On December 17, 2024, Japan's Parliament approved a supplementary budget worth 13.9 trillion yen (USD 90 billion) for the current fiscal year to implement a new economic stimulus package. The package includes subsidies to reduce electricity bills, one-time cash payments to low-income households, and funding for post-disaster reconstruction on the Noto Peninsula. Approximately half of the budget, or 6.7 trillion yen (USD 43.4 billion), will be financed through the issuance of new government bonds. This is part of Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba's broader 39 trillion yen (USD 252 billion) economic package aimed at easing inflationary pressures and supporting economic recovery.






Export value to Japan, Nov-2024










Structure of exports by products to Japan, Nov-2024





Japan to test tracking system for baby eels to fight poaching

Japan will trial a traceability system to curb illegal baby eel fishing, a growing issue in the country's eel farming industry. The new system will enable authorities and businesses to monitor domestic distribution routes for baby eels by using QR codes to share data on transporters and transaction times. The goal is to ensure the legal trade of baby eels and minimize illegal fishing activities.

The trial will be conducted in Miyazaki, Kagoshima, and Aichi prefectures starting December 17, 2024. If successful, the full system will roll out in December next year. Additionally, the Japanese government has increased penalties for those involved in illegal baby eel fishing, with fines reaching up to 30 million yen (approximately USD 195,000).









Japan's Kiwi Imports from Georgia Surge 69% in 10 Months Compared to 2023

In the first 10 months of 2024, Japan imported 264 tons of kiwi from Georgia, marking an increase of over 69% compared to the total volume imported in 2023. Georgia is now Japan's fourth-largest supplier of kiwi, following New Zealand (108,000 tons), Chile, and United States.






Export value and volume to Japan, Nov-2024






Total Coffee Export Value Nov-2024






Singapore-based luxury coffee brand Bacha Coffee is set to open its first store in Japan in 2025 through a franchise partnership with Tokyu Group. The inaugural store is planned for the Ginza district in Tokyo during the first half of 2025, with subsequent expansions to Osaka and Kyoto. According to Taha Bouqdib, CEO of V3 Gourmet, the brand sees market potential for up to 40 stores in Japan by 2030.

Founded in Marrakesh in 1910, Bacha Coffee was revived by V3 Gourmet in 2019 and now operates in 11 markets globally. In addition to its plans for Japan, the brand aims to launch stores in Macau and Saudi Arabia in 2025.












Structure of exports by products to Japan, Nov-2024










TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Nov-2024












Volume ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Japan, Nov-2024



SPOTLIGHTS



In the first 10 months of 2024, Japan imported 9.41 thousand tons of cashews (HS 080131 and 080132) worth USD 64.6 million, marking a 15.5% decrease in value compared to the same period last year.

Vietnam was Japan's primary supplier, accounting for 54.4% of total cashew import value, followed by India at 45.5%, and Cambodia at a mere 0.1%.











SPOTLIGHTS

In October 2024, Japan's imports of office furniture (HS940330) rose by 20% compared to the previous month and by 21% year-on-year. China was the dominant supplier, accounting for 89% of the total import value, marking a 69% increase from the previous month.

Imports of kitchen furniture (HS940340) grew by 29% month-on-month and 7% year-on-year. The Philippines and Vietnam were the two largest suppliers, contributing 50% and 32% of the total import value, respectively.

Bedroom furniture (HS940350) imports also increased, rising by 20% month-on-month and 6% year-on-year. China and Vietnam were the leading suppliers, accounting for 61% and 32% of the total import value, respectively.






