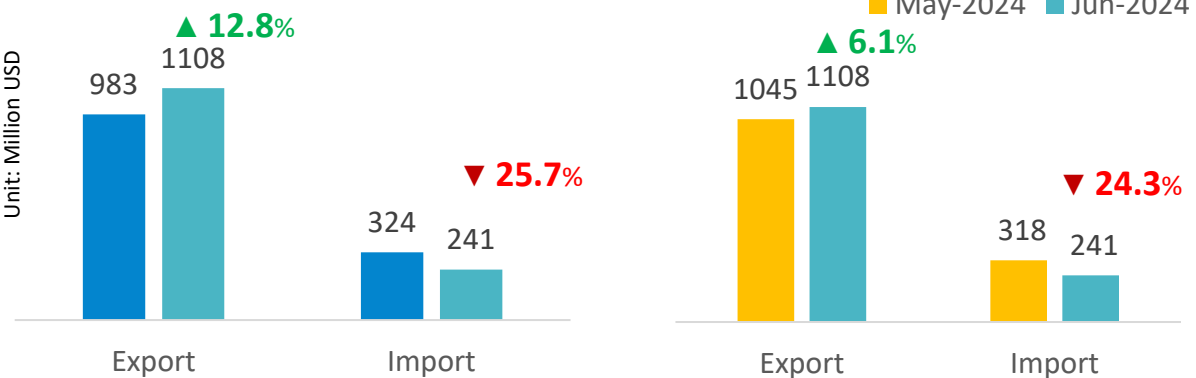

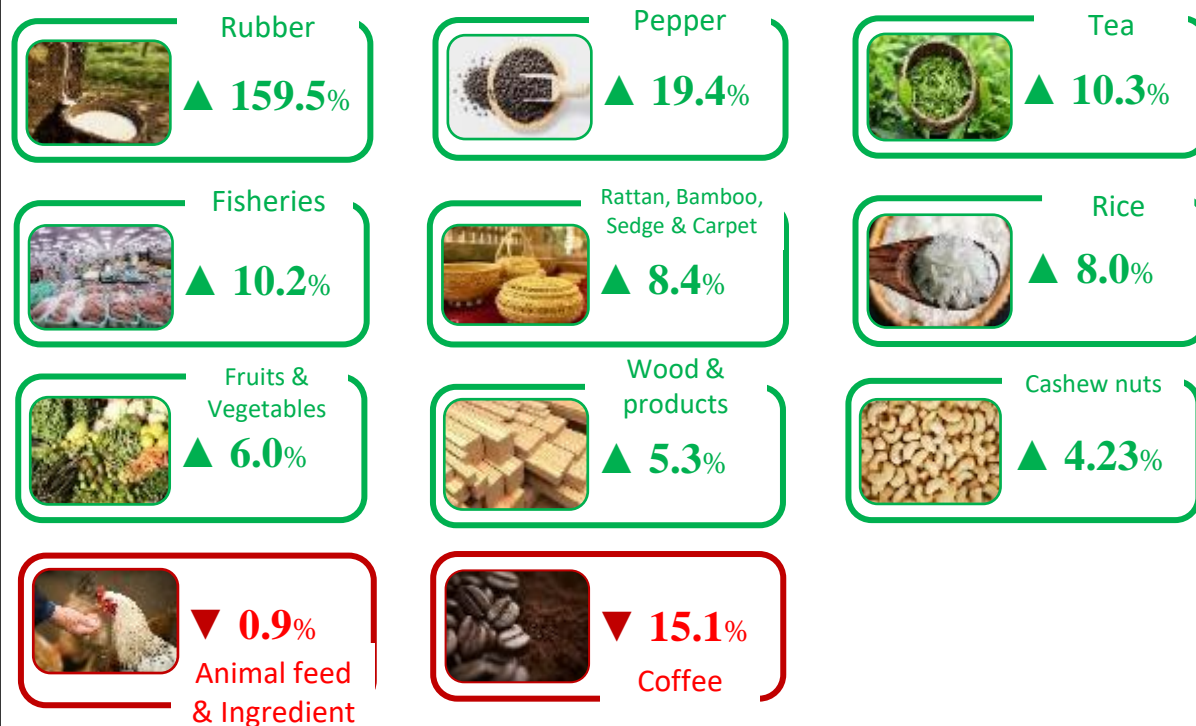

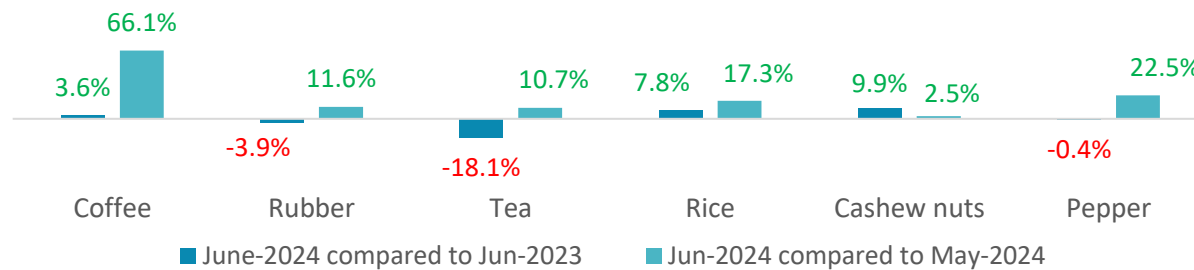
### Changes in key AFF product export value to the U.S. in Jun-2024 compared to May-2024

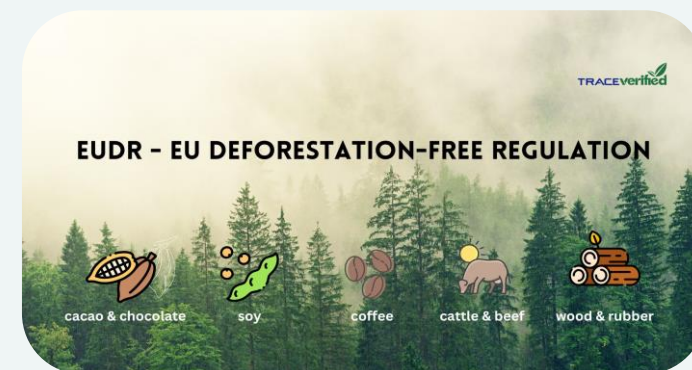
## US recommends Europe to delay implementation of EUDR

U.S. trade officials and members of the International Coffee Partnership (ICP) suggest the European Union (EU) to delay the implementation of the European Deforestation Regulation (EUDR), which is scheduled to come into effect on January 1, 2025. The regulation requires agricultural products such as livestock, cocoa, coffee, palm oil, soybeans, rubber,

and timber to be imported into Europe only from countries that have not harvested these commodities on deforested land by December 31, 2020.

These recommendations stem from concerns about the enforceability of the EUDR requirements, technical barriers, as well as a lack of support and information for manufacturers on the conditions required to satisfy the conditions

set out in a short period of time.

## US cancels tax evasion probe into wooden cabinets imported from Vietnam

The U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) maintains results of meeting in September 2023. Accordingly, three cases of wooden cabinets imported from Vietnam, with components produced in China, were within the scope of duty orders on wooden cabinets

from China, includes: The product has door components, drawer fronts and wooden frames manufactured in China, then assembled in Vietnam and combined with cabinet wood boxes and drawer boxes manufactured in Vietnam.

DOC will send a notice to the US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to instruct the application of the Certificate Regime to Vietnamese wooden

cabinets. The mechanism will allow local firms that do not fall into the above three cases to be exempted from anti-dumping or countervailing duties, when exporting items to the US market.

## US DOC announces the second administrative review of the anti-dumping of Vietnamese honey

The US Department of Commerce (DOC) announced that it will review the second anti-dumping duty order on Vietnamese honey from June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2024.

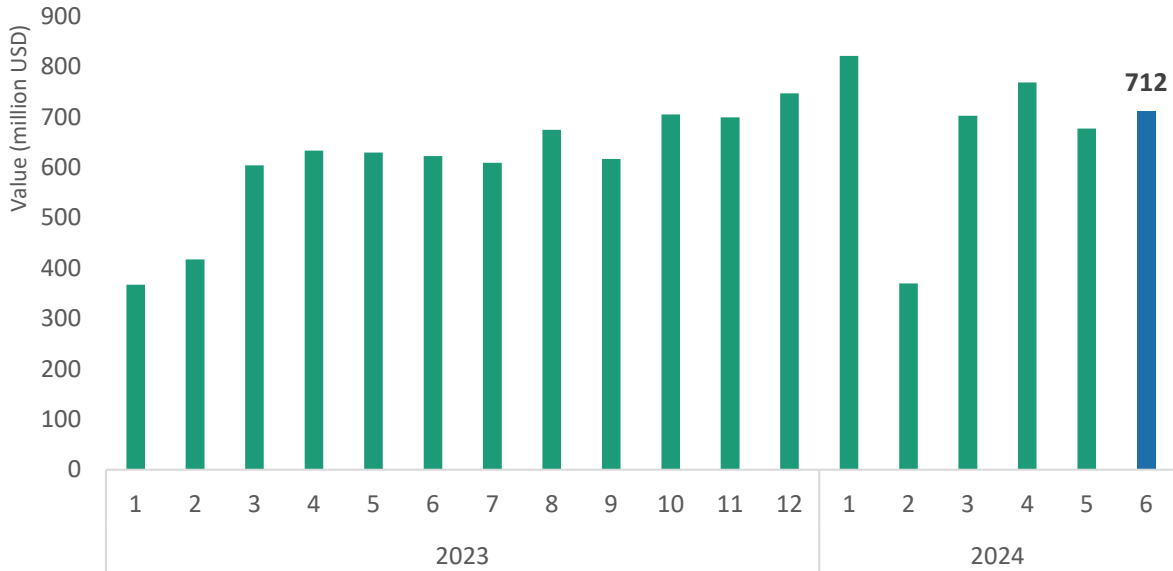

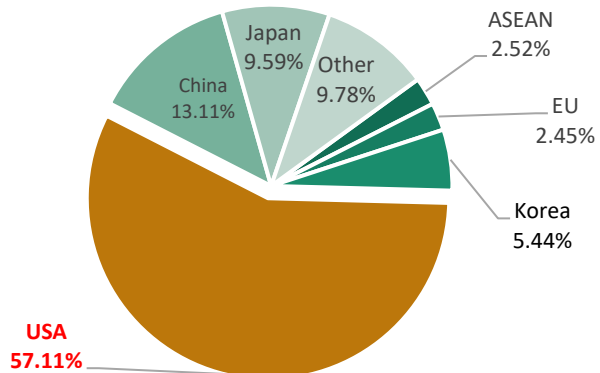

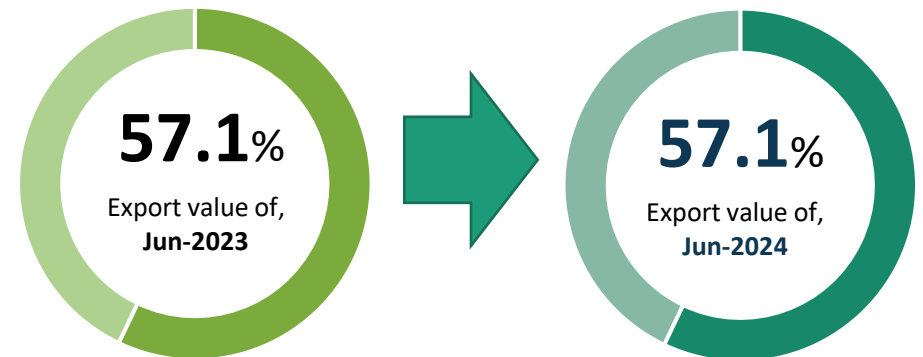

## Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



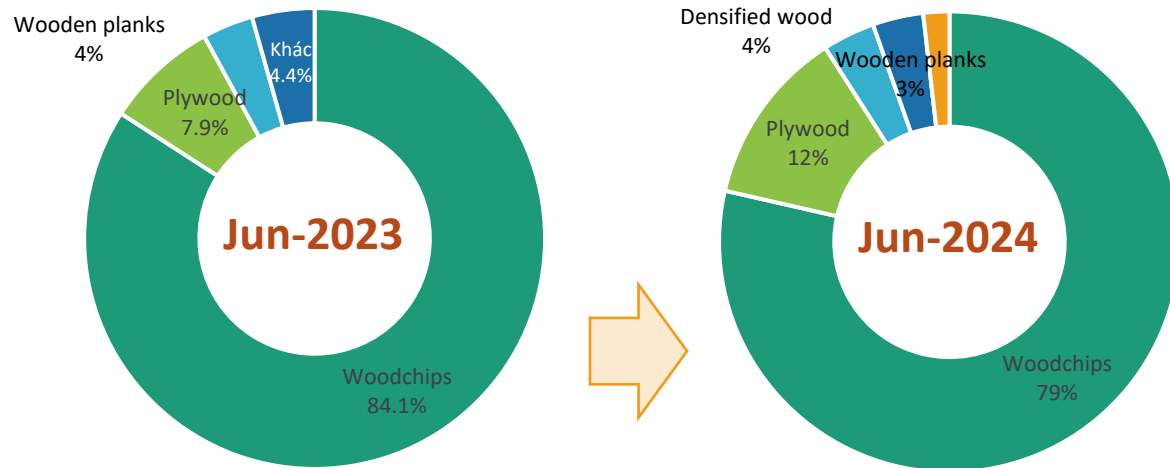
## Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024

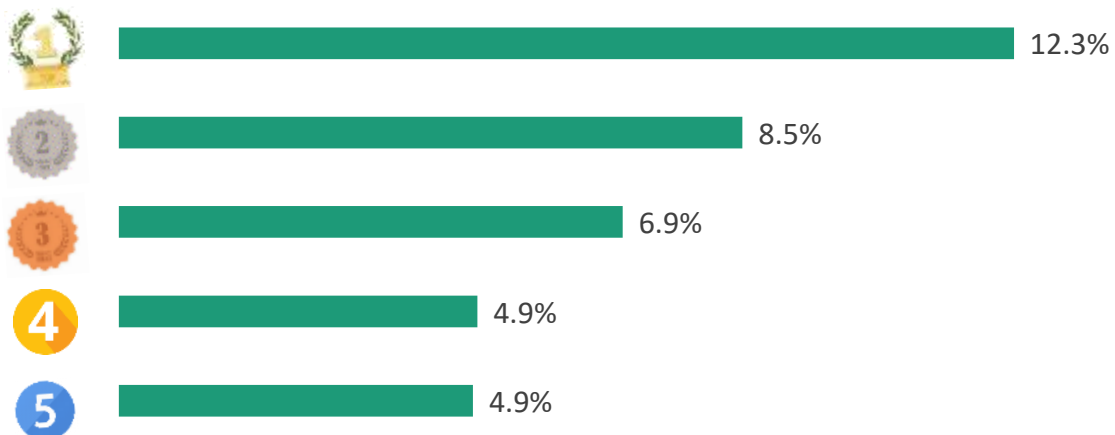

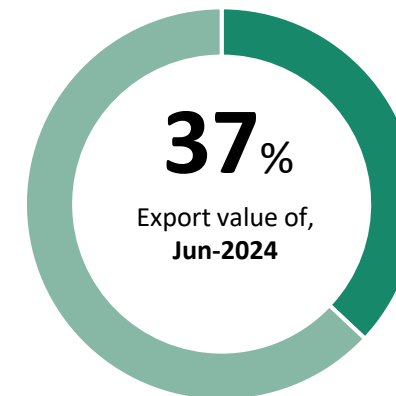

## SPOTLIGHTS

US hardwood plywood imports in May 2024 is about 242,285 m<sup>3</sup>, rising up 1% month-on-month and 50% year-on-year. Imports from Vietnam and Malaysia increase by more than 140% in the first five months of 2024 compared to the same period in 2023.

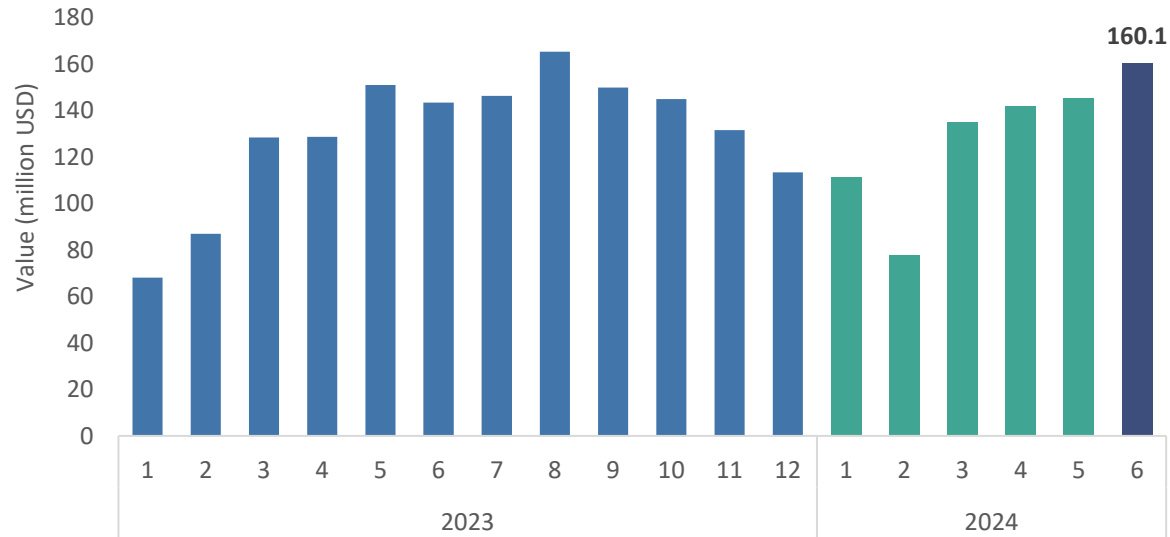
US imports of tropical hardwood lumber in May 2024 is about 13,474 m<sup>3</sup>, reducing 15% from the previous month and 14% from the same period last year. Imports from Brazil and Cameroon fall by more than a third, while imports from Ghana falls by more than a half from the previous month.

US imports \$1.8 billion of interior and exterior wooden furniture in May 2024, increasing 15% month-on-month and 3% year-on-year. Imports from Vietnam increases 32% month-on-month to their highest level since July 2022, while imports from China increases 23%.



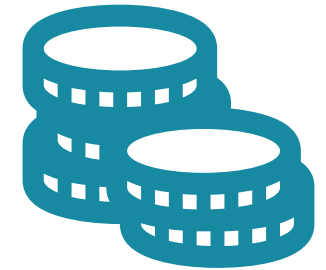

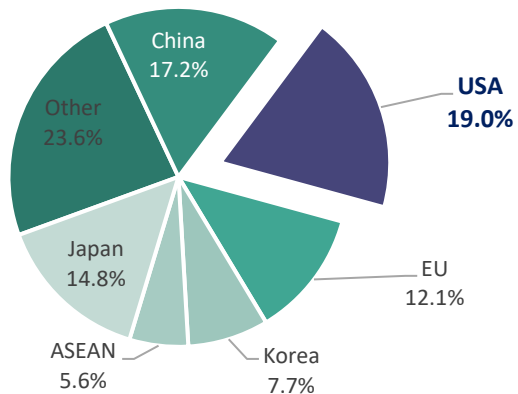

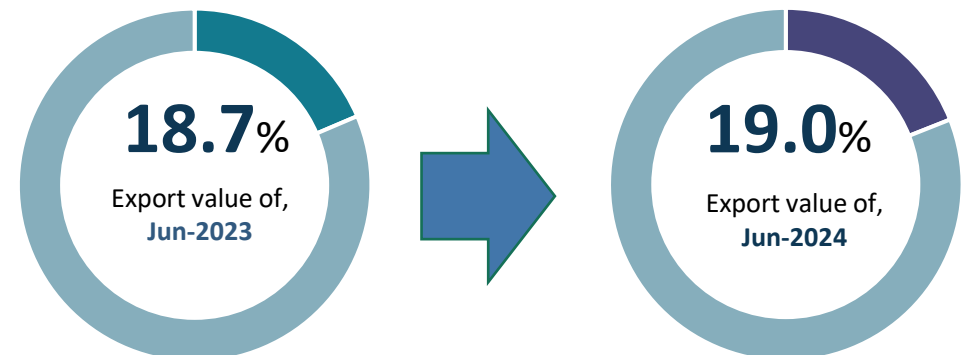

## Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



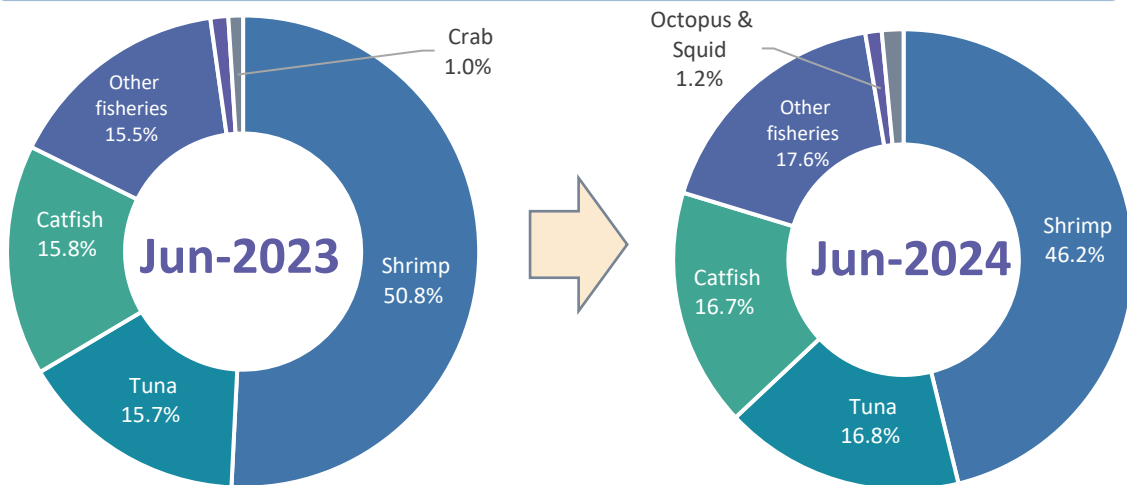
## Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



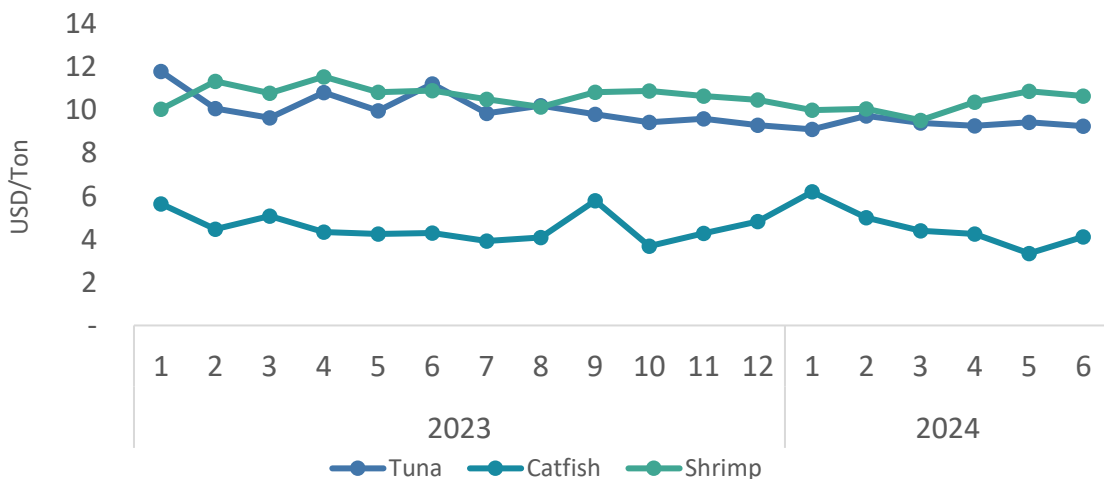

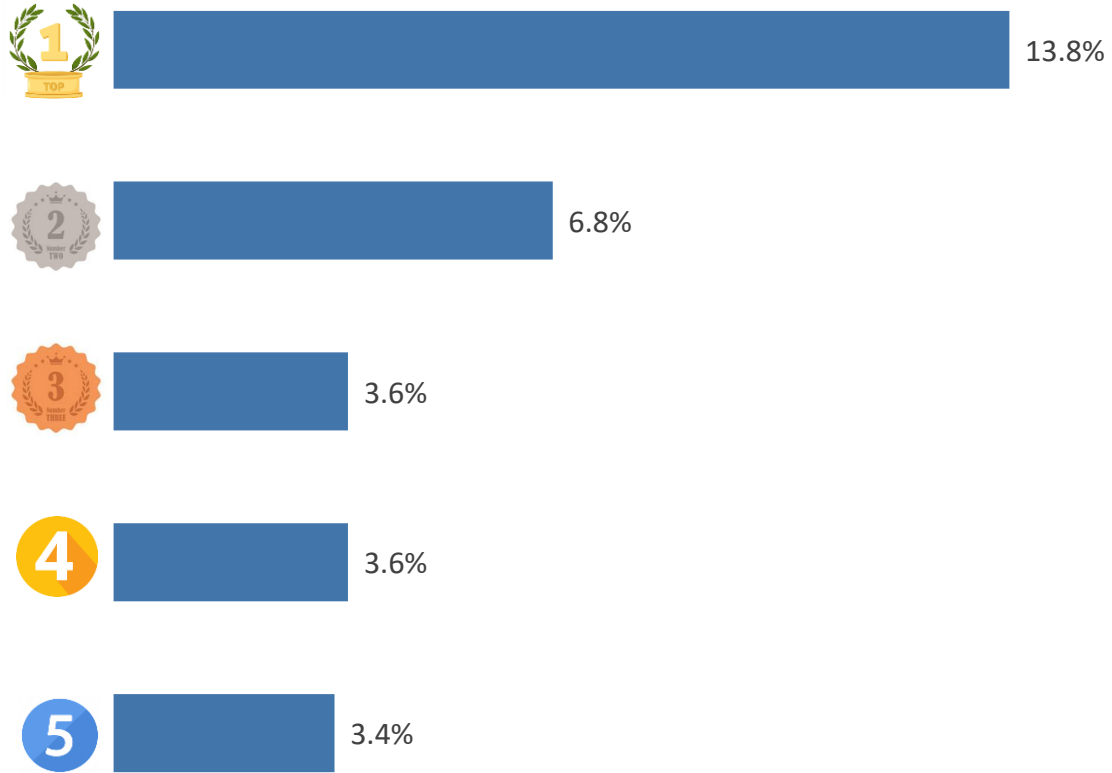

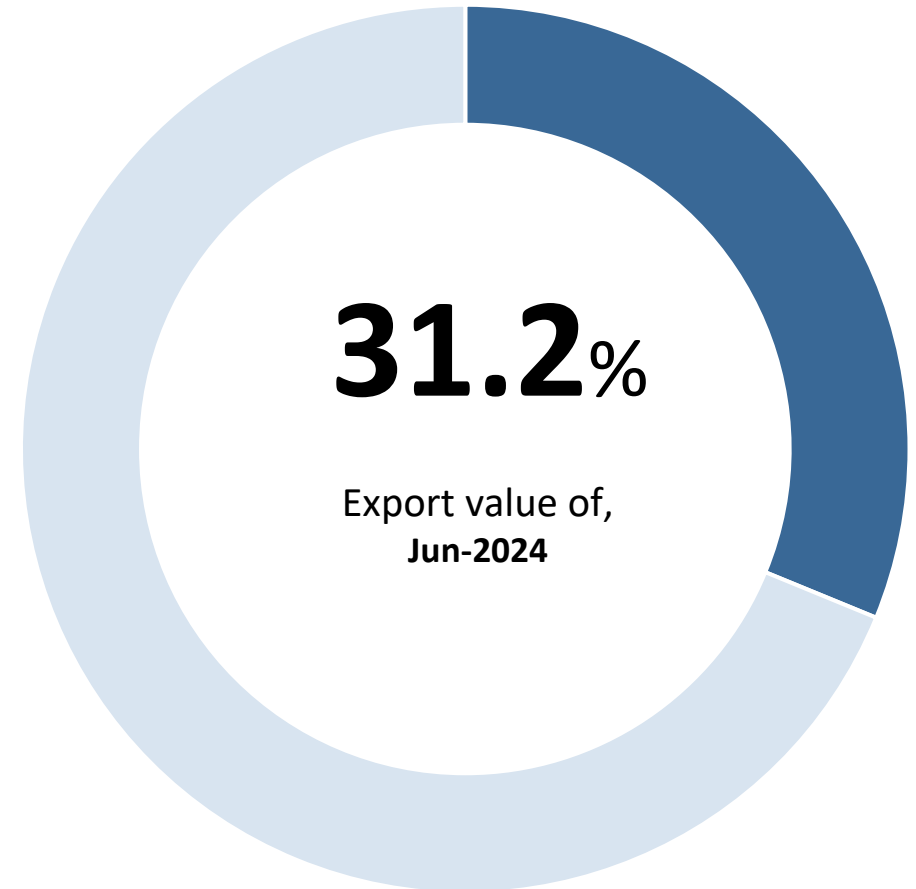

### US seafood sales flat despite retail price discounts

According to 210 Analytics' June report, in June 2024, despite many seafood retail channels cutdown price, seafood sales remained flat. Fresh seafood sales reduce 3% year-over-year to \$666 million, while frozen seafood sales reduce 3.8% to \$606 million. Processed seafood sales increases 3% to \$275 million.

The average retail price of fresh seafood is \$9.57 per pound, higher than other protein products such as chicken (\$3.05), pork (\$3.26), and beef (\$6.86). Fresh salmon remains the top seller, bringing in \$306 million, but sales reduces 0.2% year-over-year, despite a slight 0.5% increase in volume.

The top-selling frozen items in June include Shrimp (\$292 million in sales, down 5.6%), Salmon (\$77 million, down 6.9%), and Pollock (\$42 million, up 7.7% in sales and 8.2% in volume).

### US invests \$240 million in salmon hatcheries in the Pacific Northwest

On July 25, 2024, the U.S. government announced plans to invest \$240 million in salmon hatcheries in the Pacific Northwest. The investment is to boost salmon populations and support fishing rights of Native tribes in the region.

Of that, \$54 million will be used to maintain and modernize hatcheries, support 27 tribes in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Alaska to restore salmon populations, and address issues with severely degraded hatchery infrastructure.

### US House Committee Proposes to Cut NOAA Fisheries Budget by 22% in 2025

The U.S. House of Representatives has proposed to cut off 22% of NOAA Fisheries' budget, the agency that manages the fisheries sector, in 2025. According to new proposal Law, the government provides \$865 million for NOAA operations, \$248 million less than in 2024 and \$239 million less than the agency requested for 2025.

The cuts will negatively effect on fisheries conservation efforts, especially salmon restoration projects in the Columbia River Basin. Still, the committee asked NOAA to increase spending in areas such as the fisheries information network and support for climate change regulations..

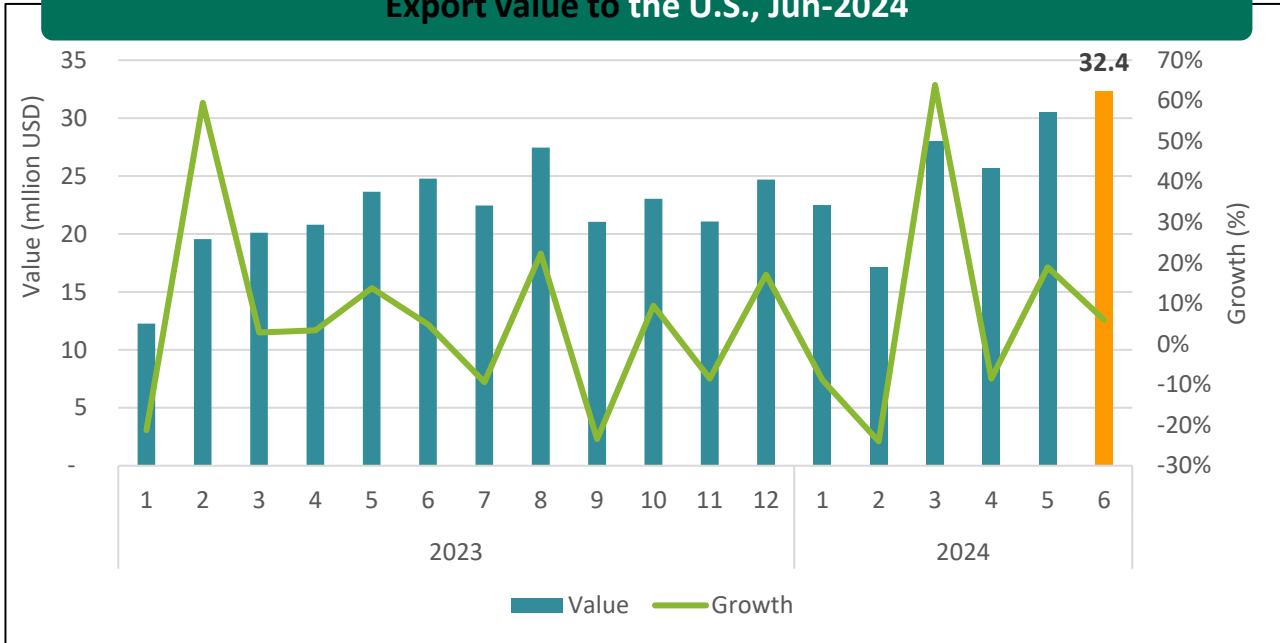

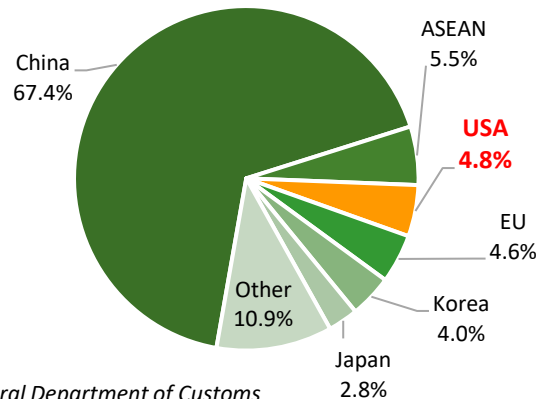

## Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



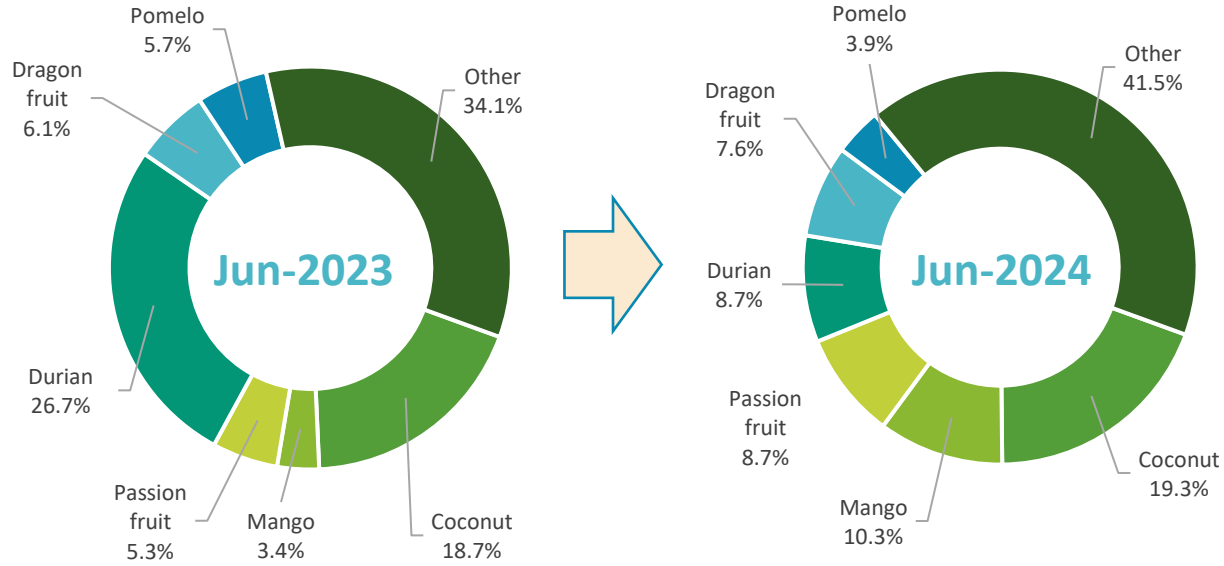

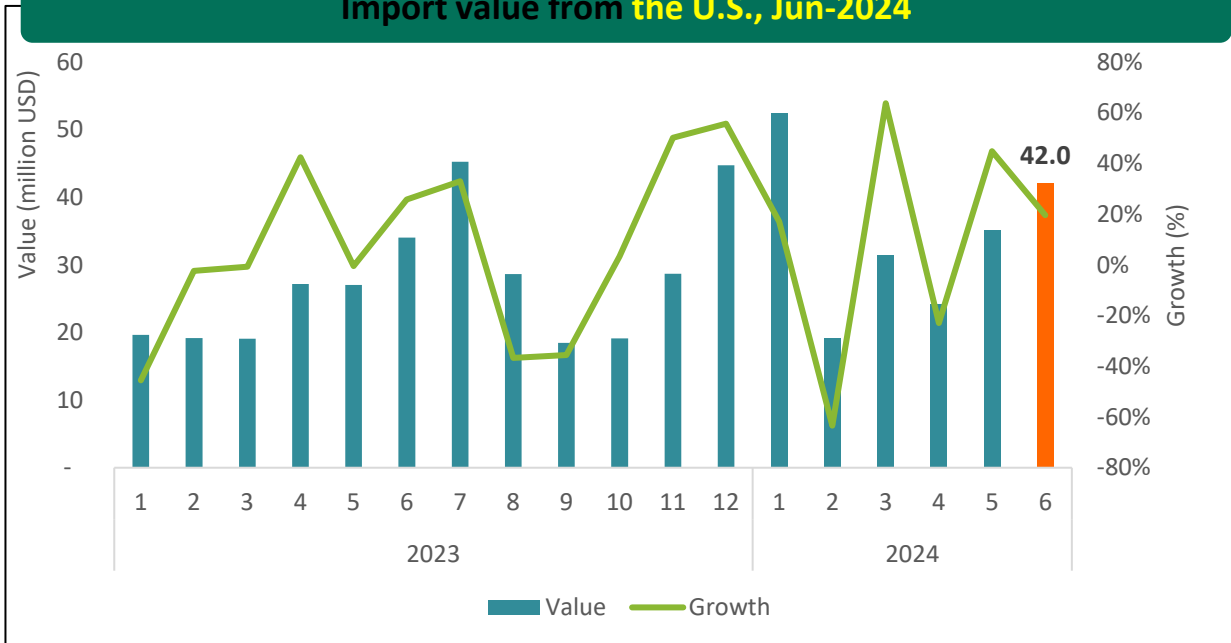

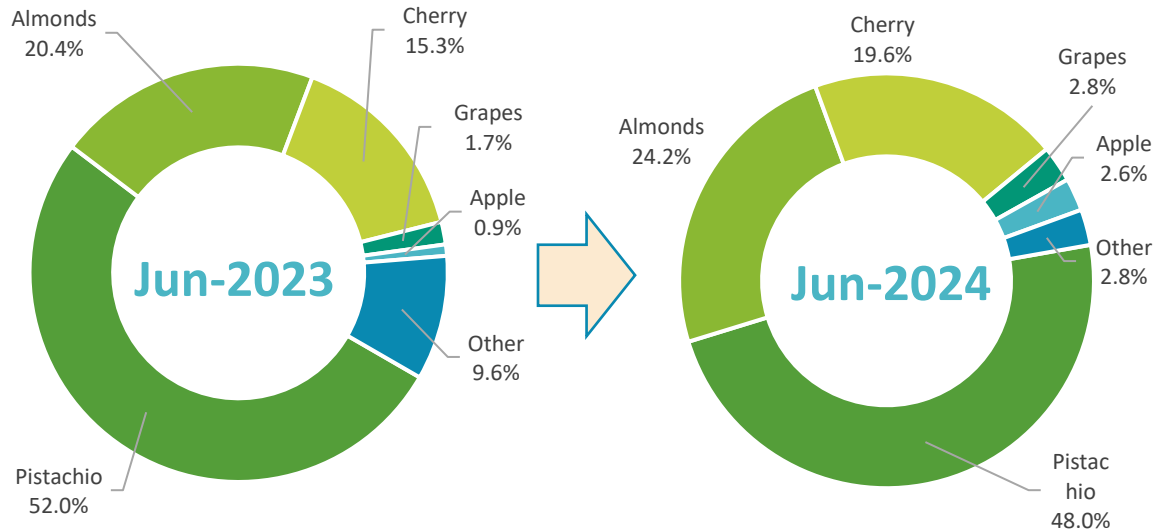

### **USDA updates new requirements for importing grapes from Chile**

The U.S. Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) has authorized the importation of some grapes from Chile into the United States. Specifically, it allows to import edible grapes from certain regions that are free or low in the presence of the European grape moth (*Lobesia botrana*), the Chilean red mite (*Brevipalpus chilensis*), etc. These requirements will be updated in the APHIS Agricultural Commodity Import Requirements (ACIR) database that are effective July 19, 2024.

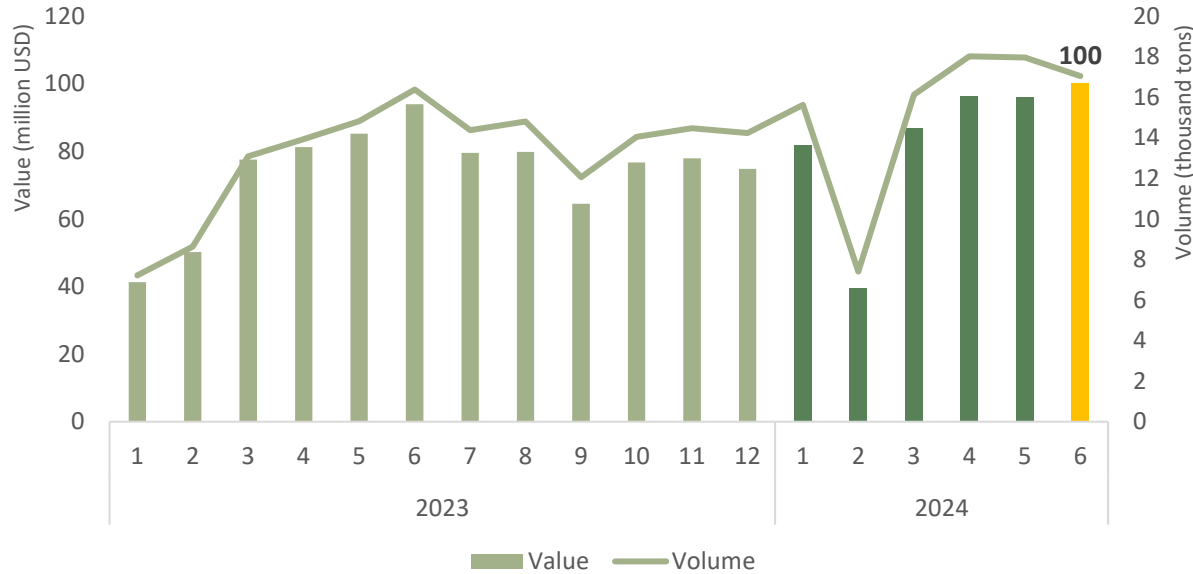

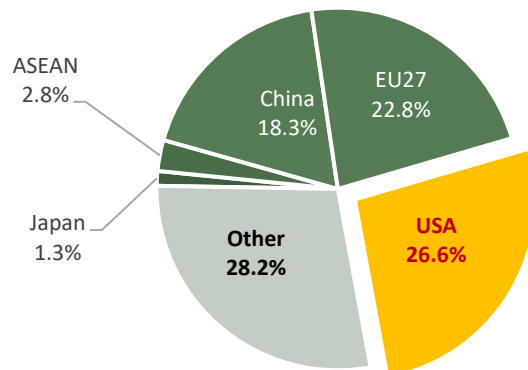

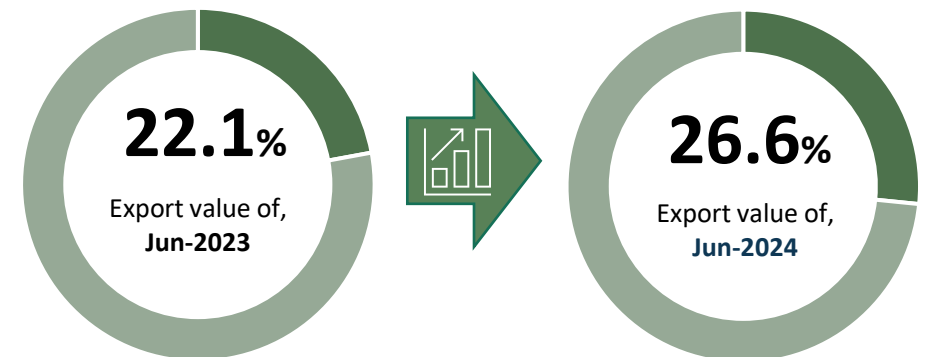

## Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



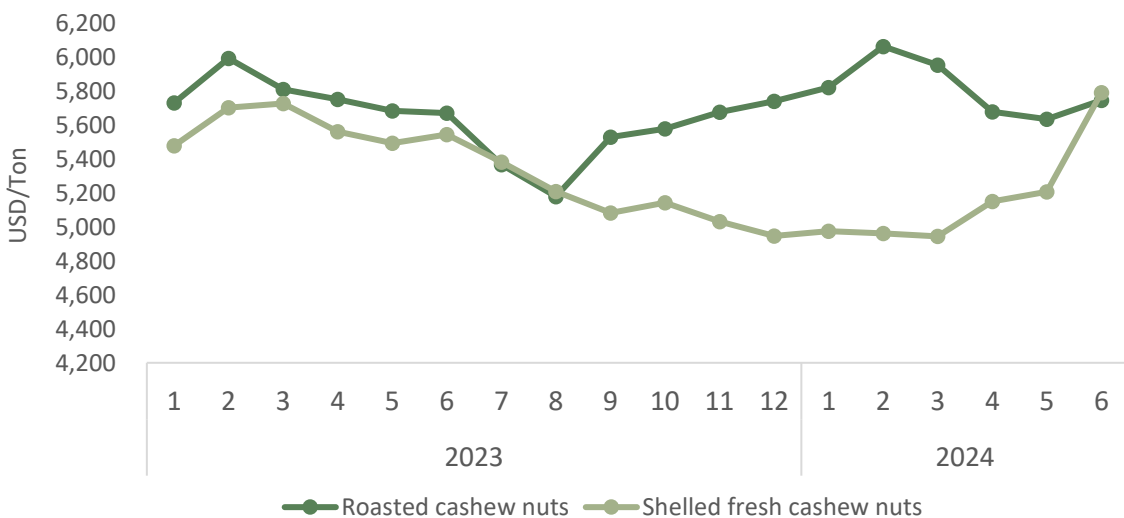

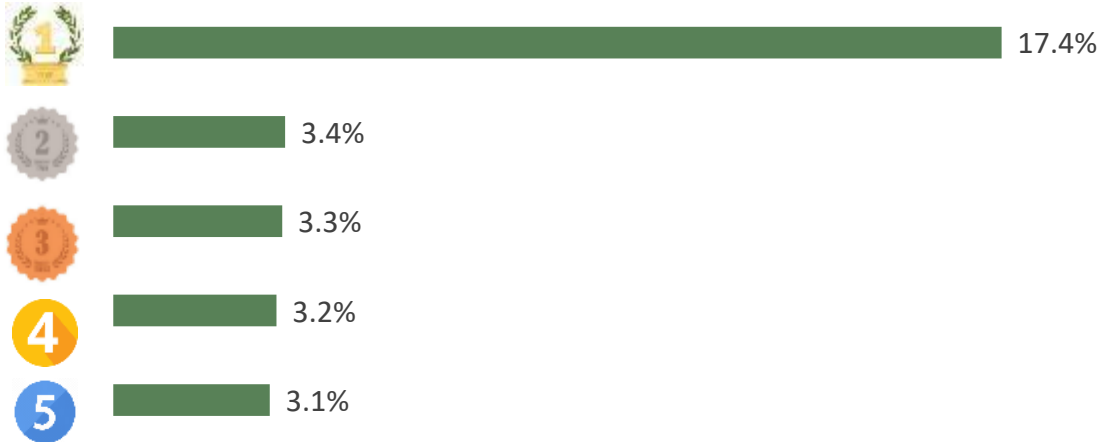

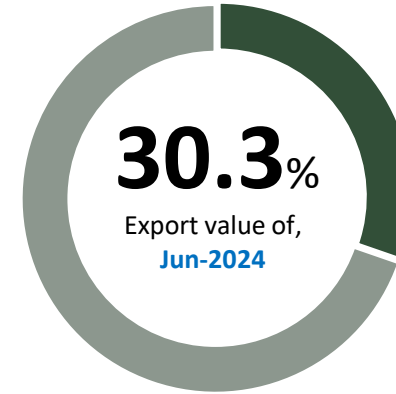

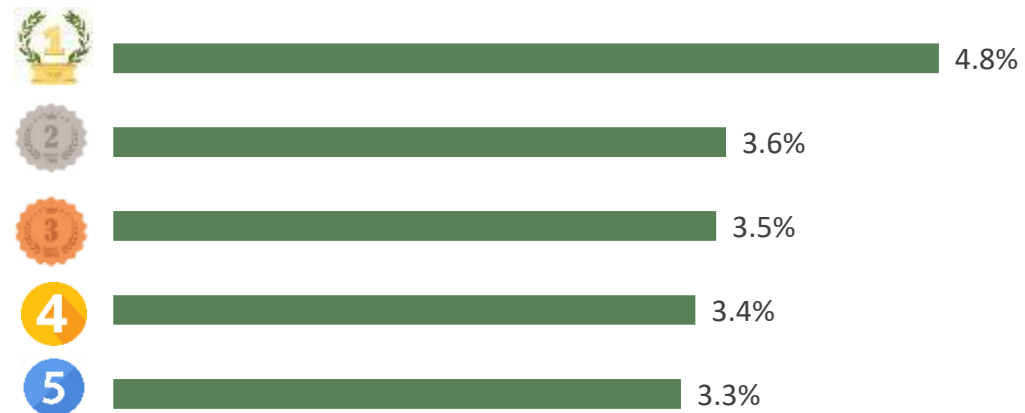
## TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Jun-2024



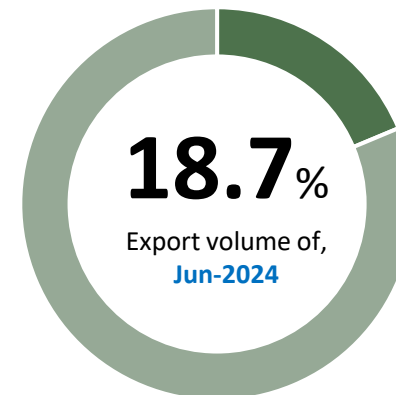
## Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Jun-2024

# CASHEW NUTS



## SPOTLIGHTS

In May 2024, the United States imported 14.91 thousand tons of cashew nuts (HS 080131 and 080132), with value of 82.8 million USD, up 30% in volume and 23.1% in value over the same period last year. The United States increased to import cashew nut from most markets, excepting Brazil, Thailand, Germany and Nigeria.

In the first 5 months of 2024, the United States imported 62.64 thousand tons of cashew nuts, with value of 343.12 million USD, up 21% in volume and 11.3% in value over the same period last year. The United States imported cashew nuts from Vietnam (accounting for 87.2% of total imports), Ivory Coast (accounting for 4.4%), Benin (accounting for 2.0%), Brazil (accounting for 1.9%), Ghana (accounting for 1.1%).

The average import price of cashew nuts in the US in the first 5 months of 2024 is about 5,478 USD/ton, down 8.0% over the same period last year.

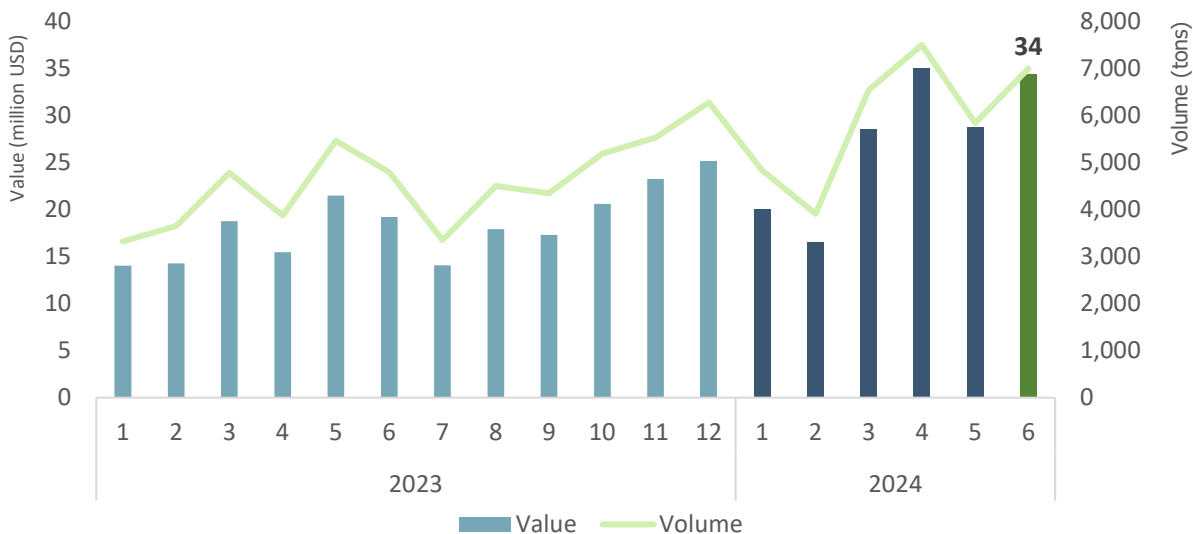

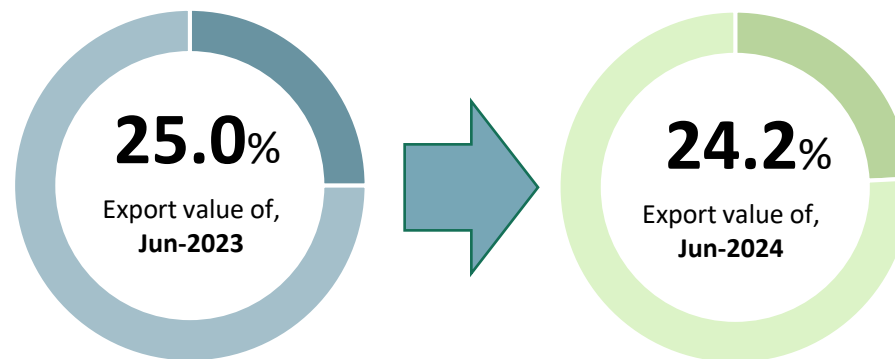

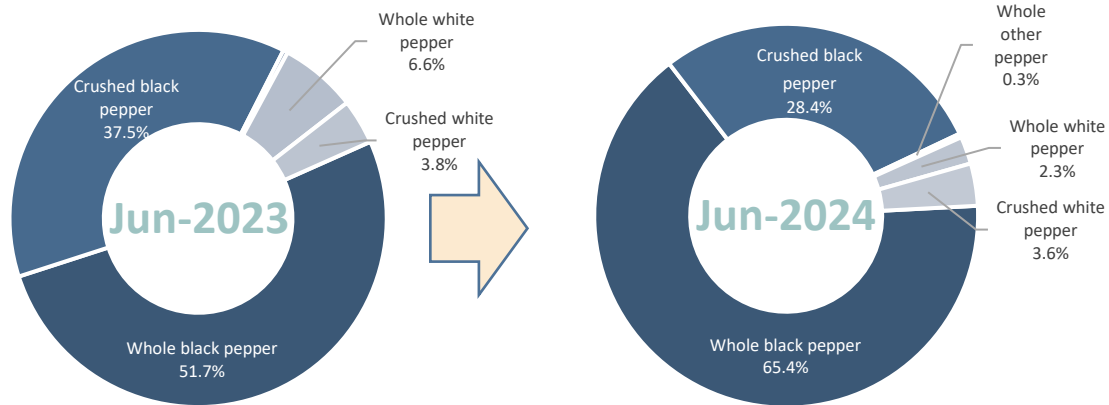

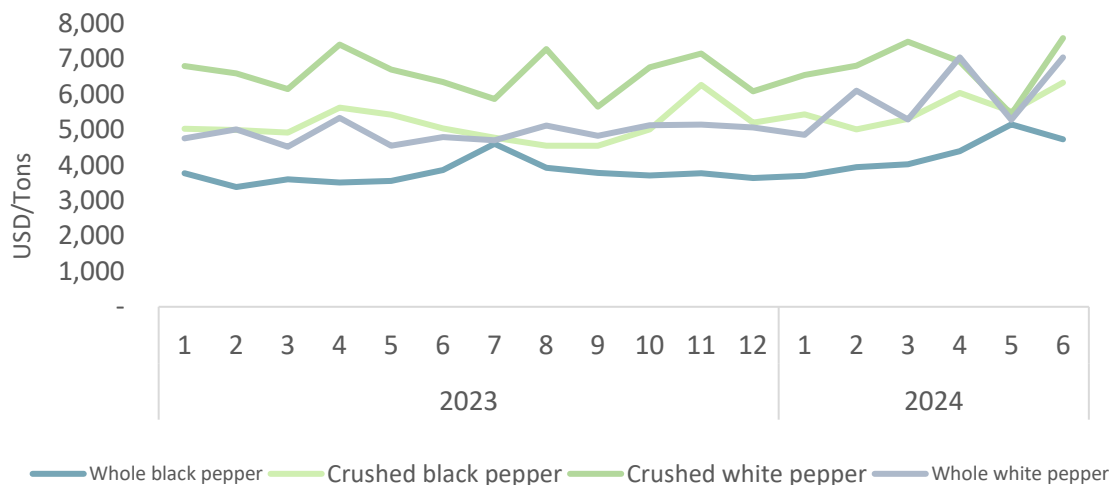

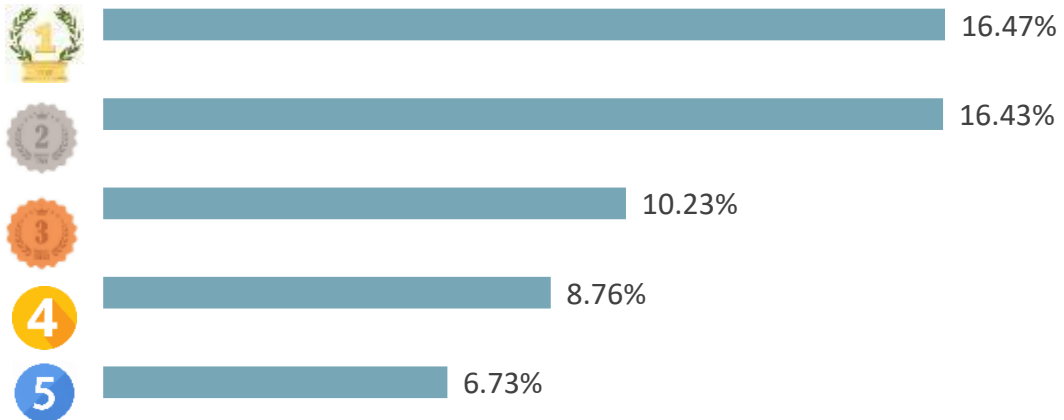

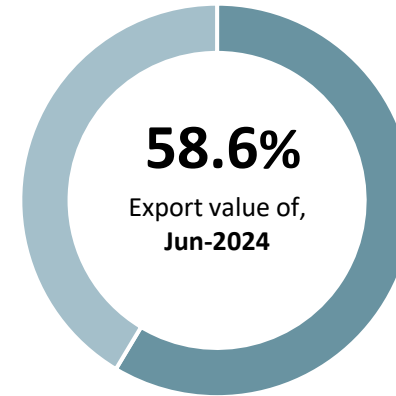

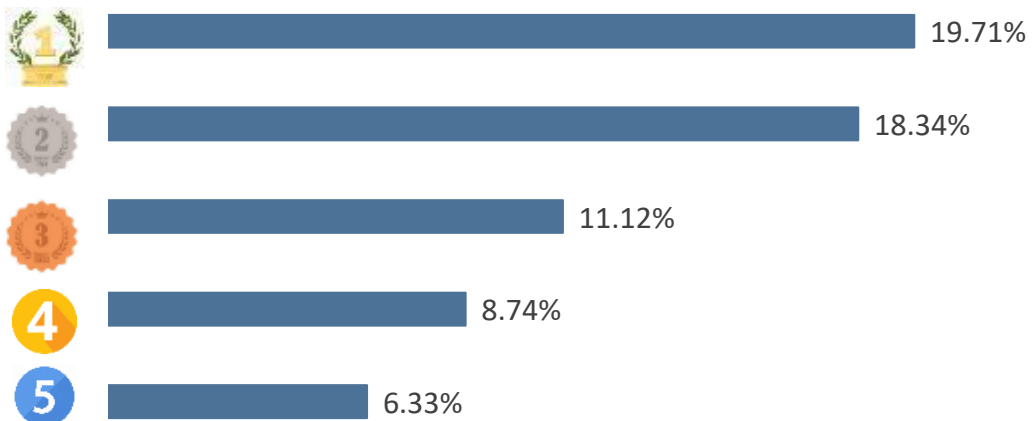
## TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Jun-2024



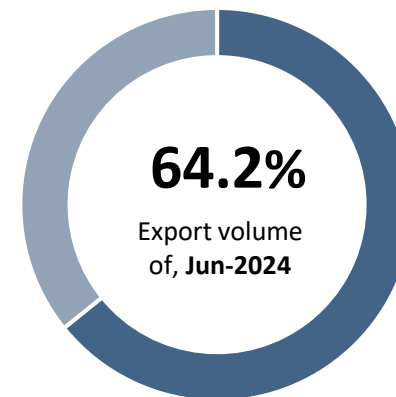
## Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Jun-2024

# PEPPER



## SPOTLIGHTS

According to the United States International Trade Commission (USITC), in May, the United States imports 9,613 tons of pepper, up 20.1% from the previous month and 59.5% from the same period last year. Total pepper imports into the United States in the first five months of 2024 reached 37,936 tons, with value of 178.3 million USD, up 30.7% in volume and 32.5% in value over the same period last year.

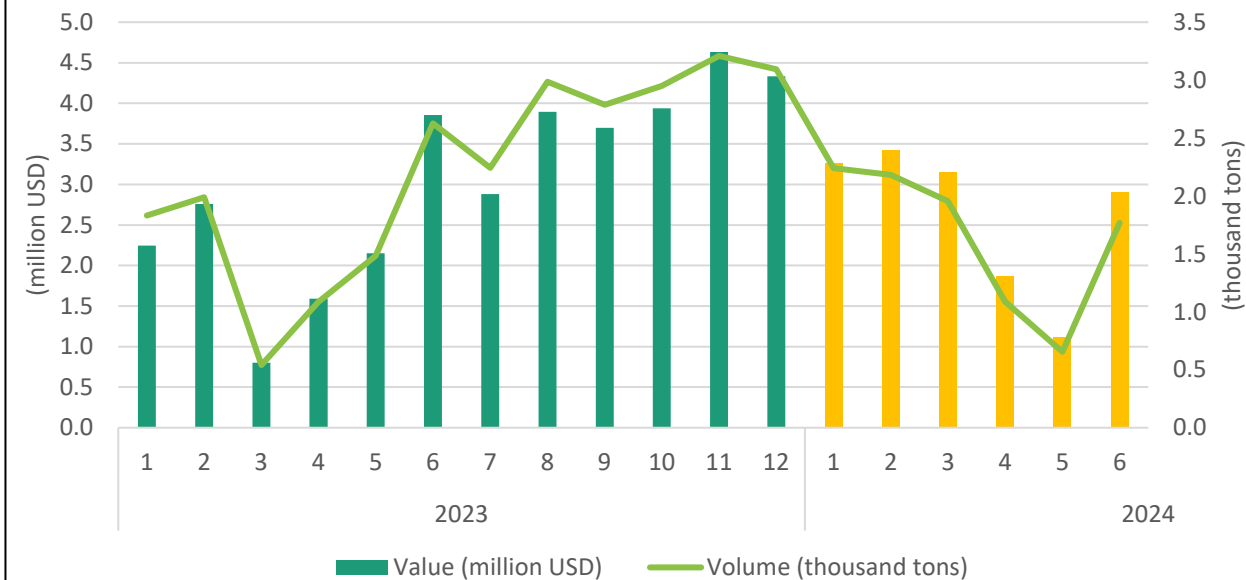
After two consecutive years of declining imports, US spice importers are now increasing pepper imports to replenish inventories. In the first 6 months of 2024, Vietnam is the largest pepper supplier to the US with a volume of 37,435 tons, up 44.6% over the same period last year.

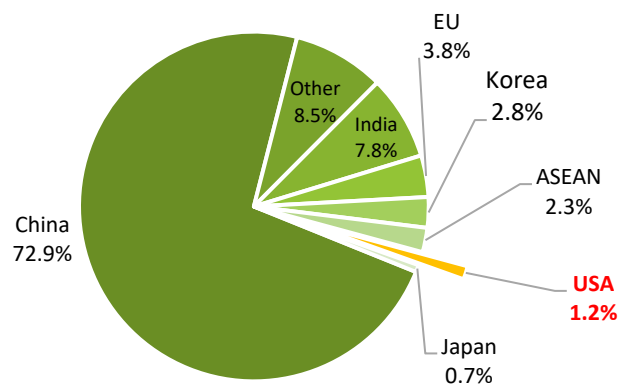

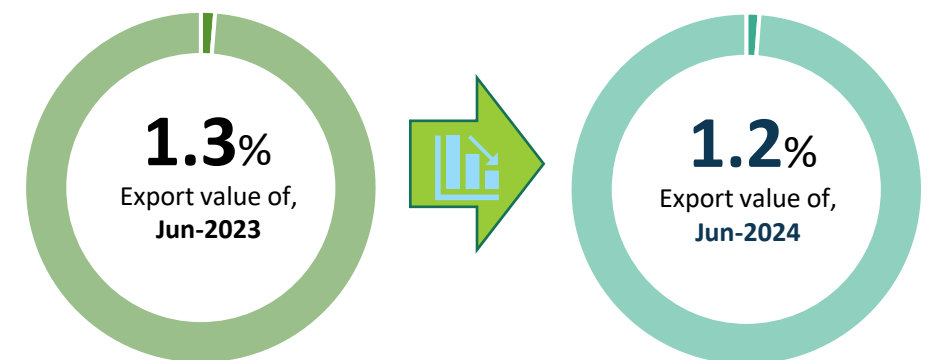

## Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jun-2024



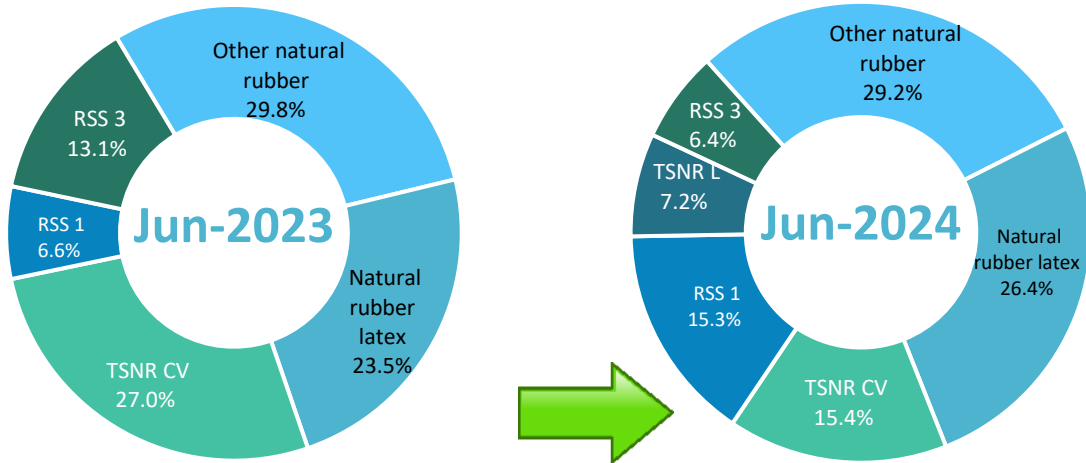

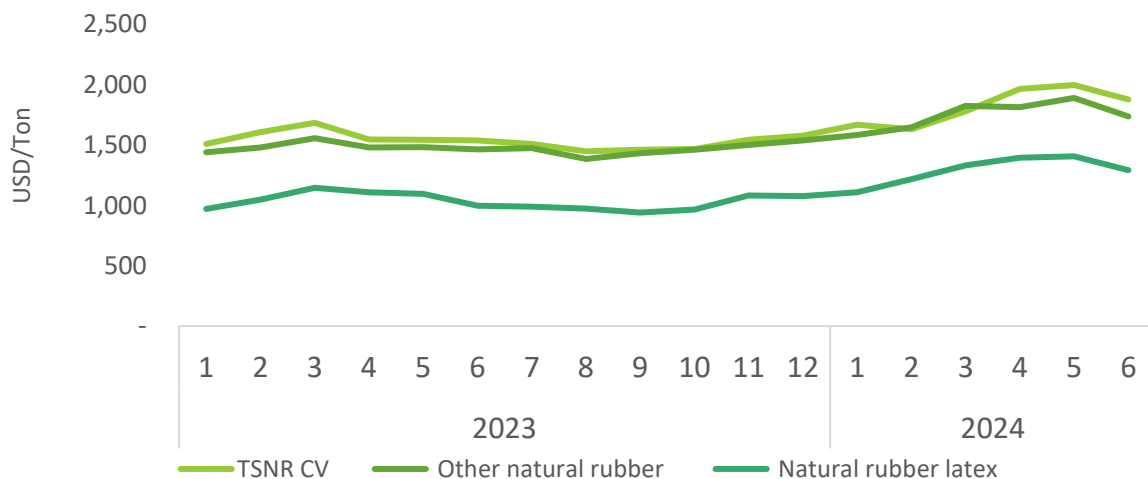

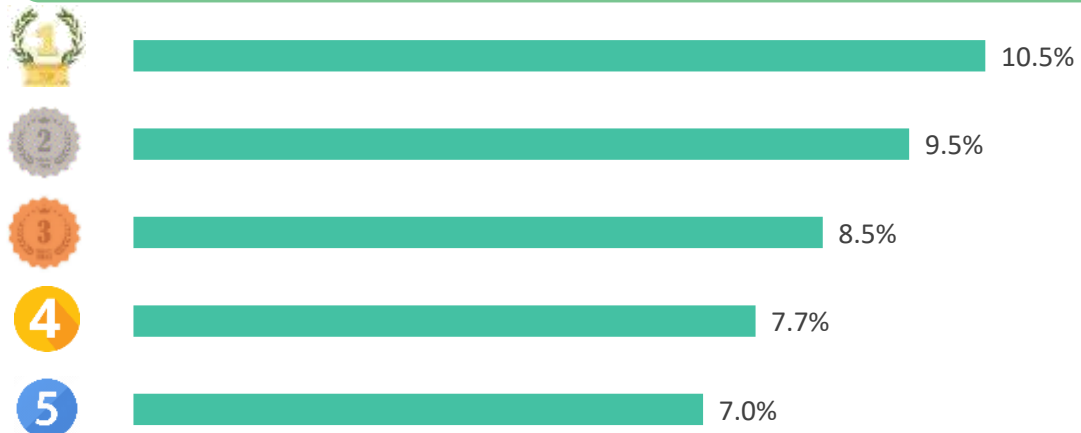

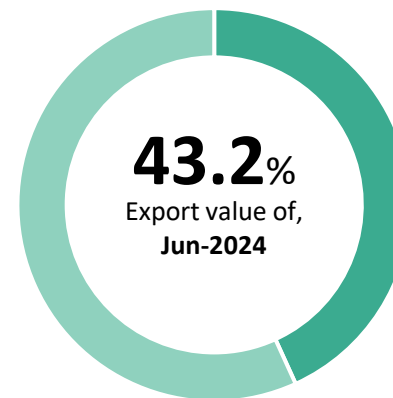
## TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Jun-2024



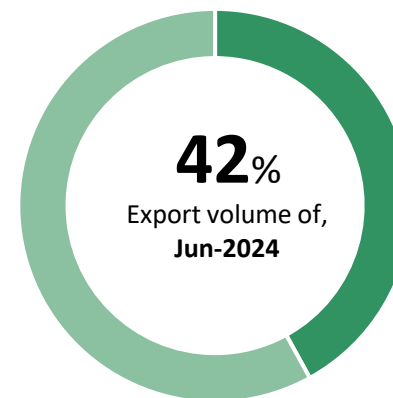
## TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the U.S., Jun-2024

## SPOTLIGHTS

In May 2024, the United States imported 84.42 thousand tons of natural rubber (HS4001), with value of 165.07 million USD, up 46.4% in volume and down 57% in value compared to the same period in 2023. Indonesia, Thailand, Ivory Coast, Vietnam and Liberia are the 5 biggest suppliers of natural rubber to the United States.

In the first 5 months of 2024, the United States imported 380.3 thousand tons of natural rubber (HS4001), with value of 697.46 million USD, up 4.8% in volume and 5.7% in value over the same period in 2023. The amount of natural rubber imported by the United States increased from most markets, excepting Thailand, Liberia, Guatemala, Guinea, ...

Vietnam is the 4th largest natural rubber supplier to the United States in the first 5 months of 2024, accounting for 3.2% of the total natural rubber imports of the United States, up 35.2% over the same period in 2023.

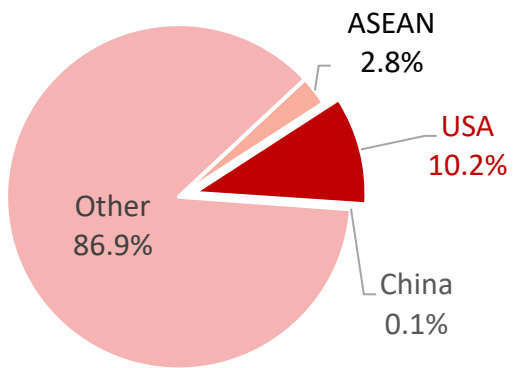

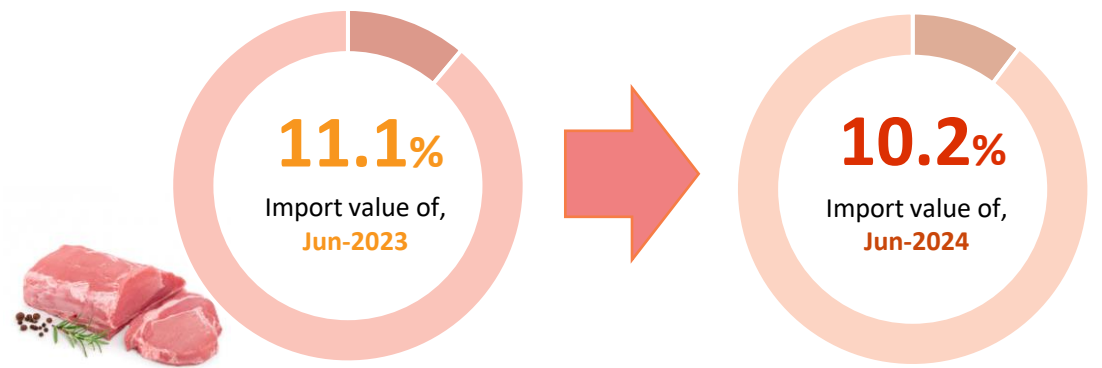

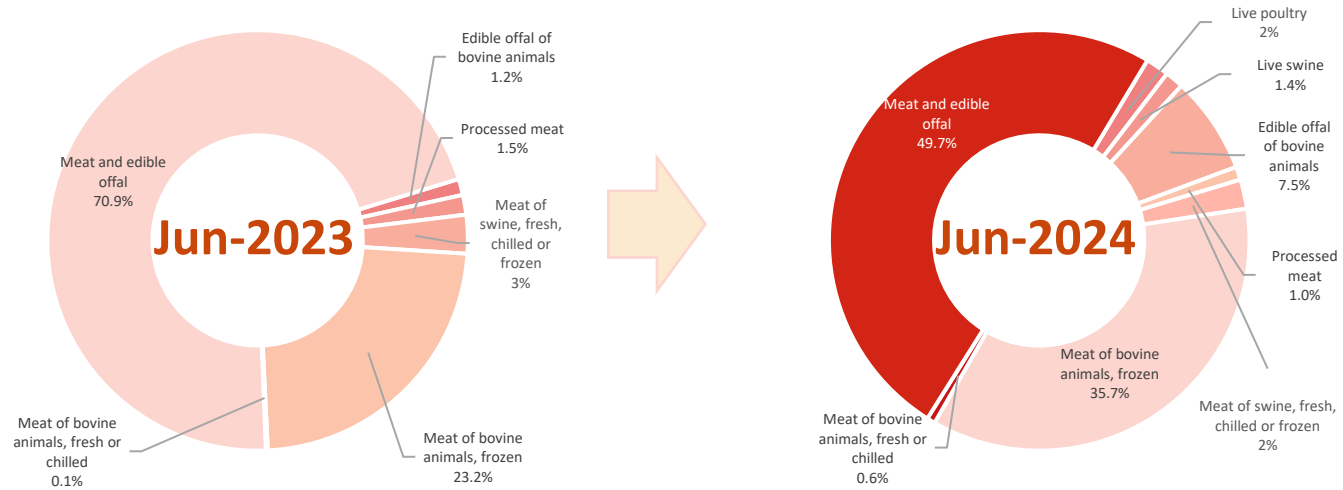

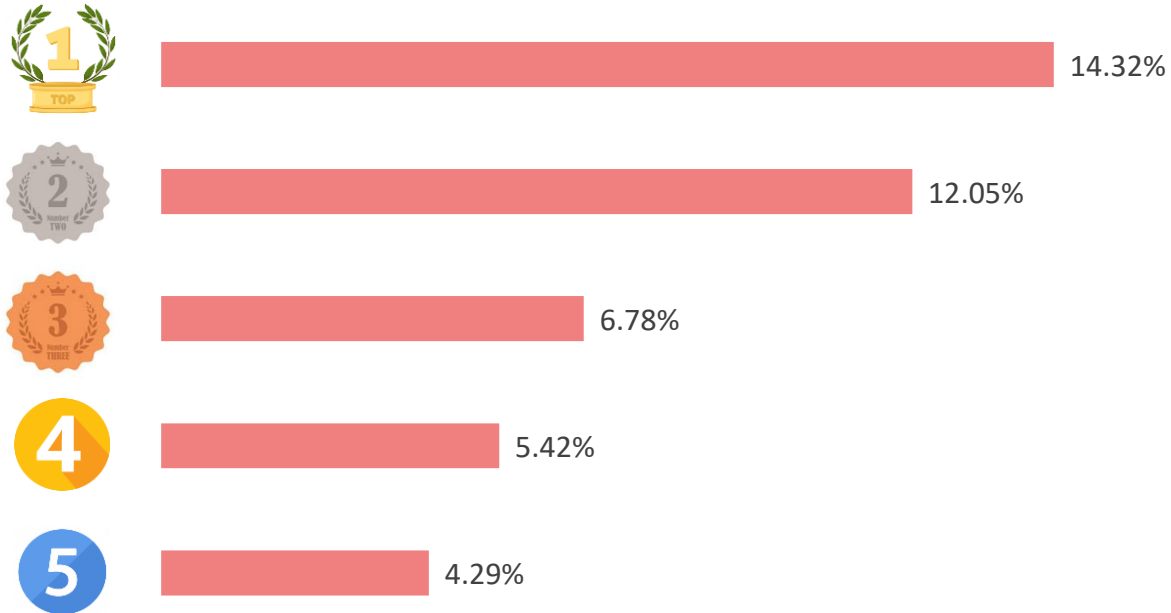

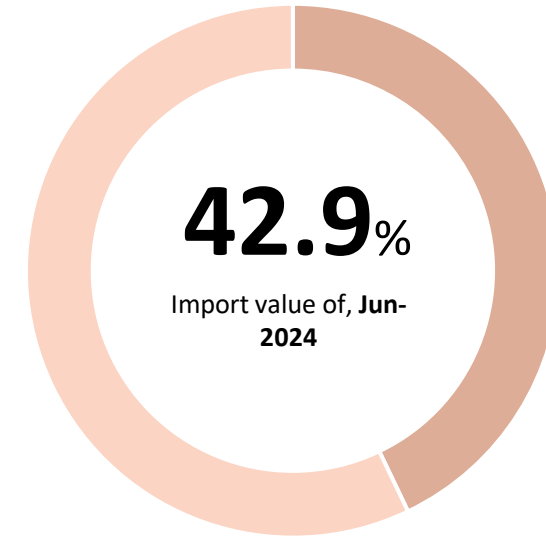

## SPOTLIGHTS



As of June 1, 2024, U.S. farms has 74.5 million pig heads, up 1% from June 2023; including 68.5 million hogs and 6.01 million breeding sows.

From March to May 2024, U.S. farms has 34 million weaned piglets, up 2% from the same period last year. The average litter size is 11.56 piglets.

U.S. pig producers are expected to have 2.96 million breeding sows from June to August and 2.94 million from September to November 2024.

Iowa has the largest hog herd of any state with 24.6 million, followed by Minnesota with 9.2 million and North Carolina with 7.6 million.
