




SPOTLGHTS

Japan Raises Interest Rates to Highest Level in 17 Years:

The Bank of Japan (BOJ) increased interest rates from 0.25% to 0.5% on January 24, 2025, marking the highest level since 2008, reflecting their confidence in the economic recovery. This is the first adjustment since July 2024 in the context of changing the USA's trade policy following the inauguration of President Donald Trump.

Japan experienced a "lost decade" characterized by slow growth, prolonged deflation, and weak consumer demand. However, after the COVID-19 pandemic, inflationary pressures have resurged due to rising prices and labor shortages. BOJ estimates that the inflation rate is about 2.7% in the 2024 fiscal year, will be 2.4% in 2025, and 2.0% in 2026.

Market has reacted positively to this decision, with the strengthen of Japanese Yen and government bond profit margin. BOJ commits to continuously adjust its monetary policy basing on economic developments to ensure a sustainable growth cycle.

Prime Minister Proposes Japan's Support for Next-Generation ODA in Major Infrastructure Projects

Prime Minister – Mr Phạm Minh Chính met with Japan's Minister of Finance, Mr Kato Katsunobu, in Hanoi on January 8, emphasizing the strong development of Vietnam-Japan cooperation. He proposed that Japan continues to provide financial support to Vietnam, particularly new-generation Official Development Assistance (ODA) with preferential interest rates and flexible procedures to implement strategic infrastructure projects such as the North-South high-speed railway, nuclear power, and metro systems in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City.

The Prime Minister also suggested that Japan facilitates the restructuring Nghi Son oil refinery project and support to climate change adaptation and developing clean energy under the Just Energy Transition Partnership (JETP) and the Asia Zero Emission Community (AZEC). Additionally, he expressed a desire to enhance cooperation in technology transfer, human resource training, innovation, and bilateral trade.

Minister Kato highly appreciates Vietnam's economic growth and commits to strengthen cooperation between two countries, particularly in strategic infrastructure projects. He also reports Vietnam's suggestions to Japanese government, including support for the Vietnamese community in Japan. The two countriess also exchange official invitations for high-level visits between their leaders.










Export value to Japan, Dec-2024



Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Dec-2024














TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Dec-2020

Japan's Scallop Exports Continue to Strongly Grow

Japan's scallop exports maintained the strong growth due to high demand from the U.S. and Southeast Asia and the global supply shortage. According to Japanese customs, in November 2024, Japan exported 3,365 tons of scallops (+85%), with a value of 7.18 billion Yen (+91%). Of which, frozen scallop exports was 1,831 tons (+26%), with value of 6.57 billion yen (+79%).

Scallop exports to the U.S. in November reached 786 tons (+42%), valued at 3.24 billion Yen (+116%), with the average price of 4,128 yen/kg (26.2 USD/kg) (+52%). Exports to Taiwan declined by 18% in volume but increased by 19% in value. Meanwhile, exports to Thailand and Vietnam increased by 91% and 3,600%, respectively.

Exports of whole-shell scallops soared by 313% to 1,535 tons; Vietnam and Thailand are the largest markets. Exports to China remained at zero due to the China's import ban from September 2023.









Vietnamese Fruits and Vegetables Have Potential Export to Japan

According to the Vietnam Trade Office in Osaka, Japanese businesses are seeking Vietnamese partners to export onions, scallions, and spinach. These companies currently import mainly from China but they are looking for alternative suppliers in Vietnam.

Japan has a modern agriculture sector with strong advantages in hightechnology application in agriculture production. Currently domestic production meets only about 45% of Japan's consumption demand. This is a potential market for Vietnam to expand exporting agricultural products to Japanese market.






Export value and volume to Japan, Dec-2024







Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Dec-2024














TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Dec-2024

Japan's Coffee Market in 2025

Japan's coffee market will reach a total revenue of USD 33.05 billion in 2025, including USD5.59 billion from at-home consumption (primarily through supermarkets and convenience stores) and USD27.45 billion from out-of-home consumption (restaurants and bars). However, revenue from at-home coffee consumption will decline by an average of 3.34% annually from 2025 to 2029. On average, each consumer will spend approximately USD 45.87 on at-home coffee in 2025.

In terms of volume, at-home coffee consumption is forecasted to be 184.90 million kg, while out-of-home consumption is about 38.86 million kg; and total consumption is about 223.70 million kg in 2025. However, at-home coffee consumption volume may decline by 4.4% in 2026. On average, each person will consume approximately 1.52 kg of coffee at home in 2025.






Percentage of export value to Japan, Dec-2024







Cambodia's Ministry of Commerce and Japanese Enterprises Discuss Cashew Nut Exports to Japan







After peaking in March 2024, Japan's import value of engineered wood flooring saw a sharp decline until June and showed no signs of recovery from July to October. In October 2024, the import value of engineered wood flooring (HS codes 441871-79) decreased by 14% year-on-year and 10% compared to the previous month.

The largest import category remained multi-layer engineered wood flooring (HS441875), accounting for 74% of total import value, following by bamboo-engineered flooring (HS441873) and other engineered wood flooring (HS441879). The remaining portion belonged to HS441974 (mosaic flooring panels).


For multi-layer engineered wood flooring (HS441875), China was the leading supplier, accounting for 61% of total imports, a significant increase from the previous month. Vietnam ranked second with 26%, following by Malaysia, Thailand, and Indonesia.









