


Share of AFF product export to Japan in Jan-2025


Changes in the share of AFF product export to Japan in Jan-2025 compared to Dec-2024 and Jan-2024






Japan's economy grows faster than Net external demand (exports minus imports) expected in Q4 2024

On February 17, the Cabinet Office of Japan announced that the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 2.8% in Q4 2024, significantly surpassing the 1% growth forecasted by economists.

In Q4 2024, private sector capital investment Donald Trump could disrupt global trade and increased by 0.5%, lower than the projected 1% negatively impact Japan, a country heavily reliant but reversing the previous quarter's negative on exports to the United States. growth. Private consumption grew by 0.1% in Q4, lower than the 0.7% increase in Q3.

Emissions by 60% by 2035

On February 18, the Japanese government approved a new basic energy plan, emphasizing the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 60% by 2035 and 73% by 2040.

Nuclear energy will account for approximately 20% of Japan's total energy production by 2040, nearly matching the 2030 target of 20-22%. This marks a shift from the government's

Japan will reduce Greenhouse Gas previous commitment to minimizing reliance on nuclear power following the Fukushima nuclear disaster in 2011.

> According to the plan, renewable energy sources will account about 40-50% of total energy production in the fiscal year 2040, nearly double the 22.9% recorded in 2023.







Percentage of export value to Japan, Jan-2025






SPOTLIGHTS

In November 2024, the import value of assembled wooden flooring (HS441871-79) in Japan increased by 30% compared to the previous month, thanks to the strengthening of the Yen, which lowered import prices compared to the first half of the last year. The largest imported product was multilayered wooden flooring (HS441875), accounting for 64% of the total import value. For multilayered wooden flooring (HS441875), China was the main supplier, accounting for 65% of total imports. Vietnam ranked second with 26%, followed by Malaysia and Indonesia.


In November 2024, Japan imported 126,020 m³ of plywood (HS441210-39), a slight increase from 122,810 m³ in October 2024 and almost unchanged compared to the same period in 2023. Malaysia and Indonesia were the two main suppliers of plywood to Japan, accounting for nearly 80% of the total import volume in November 2024, followed by Vietnam and China.










Structure of exports by products to Japan, Jan-2025





Japan's Seafood Exports Decline in 2024

The import ban from China and Hong Kong following the discharge of treated water from the Fukushima nuclear power plant continues to affect Japan's seafood sector. In 2024, the export value of seafood dropped by 6.3% compared to the previous year. However, Japan has made efforts to expand into new markets, particularly in scallop exports, allowing this product to maintain its leading position with a 0.9% increase in export value, reaching 69.5 billion yen (approximately 464 million USD).

Seafood exports to China saw a sharp decline, only 6.1 billion yen (about 41 million USD), less than one-tenth of the 87.1 billion yen (approximately 581 million USD) recorded in 2022. Meanwhile, exports to the United States surged, helping to recover a part of losses from the Chinese market. Japan continues to find alternative markets to maintain sustainable growth in seafood sector despite of trade challenges.
















Cabbage and Vegetable Prices Surge in Japan

Vegetable prices are rising sharply in Japan. Notably, domestically grown cabbage is being sold at 2.5 times the price compared to the same period last year, while cabbage imports in January increased more than 40 times. Lettuce, green onions, and Japanese radishes prices are at approximately 1.5 times their usual rates.

Apples Stored Under Snow to Enhance Sweetness in Aomori

In Aomori Prefecture, Northeastern Japan, a group of tourists gathered to dig up apples that have been preserved in snow by several local fruit companies at an altitude of about 750 meters in the Hakkoda Mountains. Heavy machinery was used to break through the more than 4-meter-thick snow layer. Participants then used shovels to uncover wooden crates containing 30,000 red Sun Fuji apples. These apples were stored under the snow for about two months, where stable temperature and humidity helped enhance their sweetness.

















Structure of exports by products to Japan, Jan-2025





SPOTLIGHTS



In 2024, coffee consumption in Japan declined by 0.4% compared to the previous year, reaching 400,218 tons. The main reasons are a decrease in demand for hot coffee and a increasing raw coffee bean prices over the past 47 years, leading to higher finished product price. Canned coffee sales also dropped, contributing to the overall decline.

However, thanks to increasing demand from foreign tourists and home consumption, bean coffee, decaffeinated coffee and coffee sticks maintained strong sales. To revive consumption, the coffee sector needs to emphasize product value to justify higher prices while also promoting the cold brew coffee market.

Companies are focusing on cold brew coffee and expanding instant coffee stick products to attract younger customers. Japan ranked fourth globally in coffee consumption in 2023, following the United States, Brazil, and Germany, indicating that demand remains high and stable. To develop the market, maintaining quality and diversifying products—especially expanding the cold brew coffee market, which is expected to have strong growth in the future.










Export volume and value to Japan, Jan-2025










Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Japan, Jan-2025








