






Key AFF product export value to Korea, Jan-2025

Korea's GDP per capita exceeds 36,000 USD/year

According to the Ministry of Finance, the Bank of Korea, and the National Statistical Office, South Korea's per capita GDP in 2024 is about \$36,024, an increase of \$454 (1.28%) compared to 2023.

Data from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) shows that this GDP level surpassed Japan's (\$32,859) and Taiwan's (\$33,234).

The South Korean government forecasts that if the current economic growth momentum is maintained, GDP per capita of South Korea will reach \$37,000 in 2025.

The Bank of Korea (BOK) cuts interest rates to 2.75%

The Bank of Korea (BOK) reduced interest rates by 25 basis points, from 3% to 2.75%—the lowest level since August 2022— to encourage the economic growth.

BOK acknowledges that concerns about the foreign exchange market still exsist, but inflation has stabilized while household debt growth has slowed.

BOK maintains its 2025 inflation forecast at 1.9%, while core inflation has been revised down to 1.8% from the previous forecast of 1.9% in November 2024.


This decision is made in the context of political instability in South Korea related to the impeachment trial of President Yoon Suk Yeol.








Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Jan-2025









South Korea's seafood output declines in 2024

In 2024, South Korea's seafood production reached 3.61 million tons, a 2.2% decline from the previous year due to rising seawater temperatures caused by climate change.

Offshore fishing recorded a 16.7% increase thanks to abundant catches of skipjack tuna, squid, and cuttlefish. However, coastal fishing output dropped by 11.6% due to declines in mackerel, anchovy, and hairtail catches. In the aquaculture sector, production decreased by 1.6% to 2.25 million tons, mainly due to declines in clam, abalone, and kelp farming. Inland freshwater fishing also saw a 5.4% drop, as salmon, freshwater snails, and estuarine clams declined.


Despite these challenges, the production value of the fisheries sector increased by 6.9% year-on-year, reaching 10.09 trillion won (\$7 billion), driven by higher selling prices in the aquaculture sector.





Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Jan-2025






Structure of exports by products to Korea, Jan-2025





SPOTLIGHT



The coffee market in South Korea includes two main segments: at-home consumption (revenue from supermarkets and convenience stores) and out-of-home consumption (revenue from restaurants and bars).

Revenue from at-home coffee consumption will reach \$2.18 billion in 2025, while revenue from out-of-home coffee consumption will be \$13.16 billion. The total market revenue is estimated to reach \$15.34 billion in 2025. The compound annual growth rate (CAGR) for at-home coffee consumption revenue from 2025 to 2029 is forecasted at 2.42%.









TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Jan-2025







South Korea's Fruit Imports Achieve New Record in 2024

According to the Korea Rural Economic Institute (KREI), the imports of 12 types of fresh fruits (including bananas, mangoes, pineapples, oranges, cherries, and kiwis) reached a total value of \$1.45 billion in 2024, marking a 20.1% increase from the previous year. This is the highest figure on record, surpassing the previous peak of \$1.33 billion in 2018.

The surge in fruit imports is attributed to supply shortages caused by poor harvests due to unfavorable weather conditions, leading to rising fruit prices. Additionally, South Korea has reduced import tariffs on fruits to meet increasing domestic demand and curb inflation.

Fruit imports into South Korea are expected to continue rising, as domestic production will decline in the long term due to adverse weather conditions and reducing cultivation areas. The total volume of fruit imports, including frozen fruit, will increase by 6.8% year-on-year to 817,000 tons this year.












The Korea Forest Service recently held a conference with the participation of more than 80 representatives from 24 timber sector associations to emphasize the sector's role in achieving carbon neutrality.

Currently, South Korea's timber sector generates annual revenue of 48 trillion KRW (33.1 billion USD) and provides employment for approximately 170,000 workers. To promote sustainable development, the Korea Forest Service plans to expand wood construction projects by adding 12 new sites in 2025. Over the next four years, total investment in these projects is expected to reach 156 billion KRW (107.6 million USD).


Im Sang-seob, Director of the Korea Forest Service, reaffirmed the agency's commitment to advancing supportive policies to enhance the competitiveness of the domestic timber industry. He also emphasized that utilizing domestically produced wood products is a key solution to realizing the goal of carbon neutrality.





Changes in percentage of export value to Korea, Jan-2025






Structure of exports by products to Korea, Jan-2025






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Jan-2025




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Korea, Jan-2025

Tire prices may increase in 2025

The cost of raw materials for producing tire, particularly natural rubber in South Korea, surged by nearly 40% over the past year due to the effects of climate change, supply chain disruptions, and rising demand.

The supply and demand of natural rubber remain imbalanced: in 2024, consumption is 13.9 million tons, while production is only 12.7 million tons, driving prices up by more than 30%.

Major brands such as Michelin, Bridgestone, and Goodyear have all raised their prices, leading to a global increase in tire prices. Additionally, rising logistics and labor costs have effects on increasing price trend in this year.


Meanwhile, South Korea's major tire manufacturers, including Nexen Tire, Trelleborg, and Mitas increased tire prices in the European market last year. This trend is expected to continue into 2025 if global brands like Michelin, Dunlop, and Sumitomo persist in raising their prices.








Changes in percentage of export value to Korea, Jan-2025










