





Share of AFF product export to Japan in Apr-2025

Japan's economy has growth

Preliminary data released by the Japanese government on May 16 showed that the country's GDP reduces by 0.2% in the first quarter compared to the previous quarter. On an annualized basis, GDP contracted by 0.7%-a higher decline than the previously forecast of 0.2%. Japan has just emerged from a year-long period of negative growth. The GDP's negative growth is due to sluggish

negative consumer spending and declining exports, introduce a new economic stimulus package. highlighting that the economy has already lost momentum from external demand even before the United States announced its retaliatory tariff measures on April 2.

> Although the U.S. - China trade tensions have eased, it remains unclear whether Japan will be able to negotiate a tariff reduction deal with the U.S. The bleak GDP figures have also increased pressure on Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba's administration to consider tax cuts or

Food Items

According to official data released on May 22, Japan's core inflation rose by 3.5% in April compared to the same month last year, marking the fastest increase in over two years and exceeding market expectations. This is the 37th consecutive months that core inflation has remained above the Bank of Japan's (BoJ) target of 2%, leading to the expectations of another

Data from Japan's Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications showed that this was the fifth consecutive month with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) rising above 3%, and the 44th straight month of positive CPI growth. Notably, rice prices surged by 98.4% compared to last summer-the sharpest increase since statistics began in 1971. In addition, chocolate prices rose by 31.0%, coffee beans by 24.8%, rice balls by 18.2%, and sushi by 5.0%.













WOOD AND WOODEN PRODUCTS

SPOTLIGHTS

In April 2025, Japan imported over 71,700 cubic meters of wood from Russia's Far East, marking a 43% increase compared to the same period last year. As a result, Russia surpassed Sweden, Canada, and Finland to become the Japan's largest supplier of wood. Japan's total wood imports for the month reached 343,700 cubic meters, a sharp 73% year-on-year increase.


According to data from Japan's Ministry of Finance, the majority of imported wood came from Russia, followed by Sweden (71,700 m³), Canada (67,800 m³), and Finland (62,100 m³). Despite international pressure, Japan has not imposed sanctions on wood, pulp, or laminated timber products from Russia. Along with the United States and Australia, Japan continues to maintain relatively soft restrictions on Russian wood imports.


Meanwhile, more than 130 environmental and trade organizations, as well as Ukraine's parliament, called on allied nations to impose sanctions on Russian timber. European industry associations are also urging the European Union to pressure Japan into fully banning wood imports from Russia.




Export value to Japan, Apr-2025








Changes in percentage of export value to Japan, Apr-2025












TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Apr-2025

China is going to import seafood from Japan after nearly 2 years

On May 30, the Japanese government announced that China agreed to the process of resuming imports of Japanese seafood, ending a nearly two years of banning due to the discharge of treated wastewater from the Fukushima nuclear power plant in 2023.

According to Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, the two countries reached an agreement during a meeting in Beijing on May 29. China will continue to carry out the necessary procedures before imports are resumed. The agreement includes Japan's register its seafood processing facility with the Chinese government, and accompanying a certificate of non-radioactive contamination for export shipments. However, the ban still applies to products from 10 provinces, including Fukushima and Tokyo.

The Chinese government said the talks made "significant progress", while Japan saw this as an "important turning point" in improving bilateral trade relations.



Export volume and value to Japan, Apr-2025







Changes in percentage of export value to Japan, Apr-2025













Structure of exports by products to Japan, Apr-2025








TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Apr-2025

COFFEE

SPOTLIGHTS



Ishizuka Glass Company in Aichi province, Japan is piloting a model of growing coffee in a greenhouse by reusing industrial waste heat from a glass kiln. With a heat exchange system, the temperature in the greenhouse is maintained at an optimal level (~20°C), which is suitable for coffee plants that are sensitive to cold.

The project is currently experimentally planting 60 plants of 10 Arabica and Robusta coffee varieties, which are monitored and controlled by a team of technical staff from many departments. The goal is to develop a cost-effective coffee cultivation model, stable yield, independent of external climatic conditions.

The project not only contributes to the development of sustainable production in the direction of the SDGs, but also expects to commercialize within 3 years, making the product a local specialty and gift (furusato nozei).







This is part of Kagome's food education initiative that started with gardening education, which aims to encourage love of fruits and vegetables among young children.







Percentage of export value to Japan, Apr-2025
















TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Apr-2025





Cambodian government visits Japanese cashew nut processing facility in Kampong Thom

On May 10, 2025, Mr. Vongsey Vissoth, Permanent Deputy Prime Minister and Minister in charge of the Office of the Council of Ministers, called on Japanese companies to participate in signing cashew nut purchase agreements with local communities and farmers. The goal of this initiative is to promote the development of Cambodia's cashew industry and create more jobs for the people.

The Deputy Prime Minister of Cambodia highly appreciated the decision to invest in cashew nut processing activities in Kampong Thom province of MIRARTH Agritech (Japan), one of Cambodia's key cashew growing regions.

The Cambodian Cashew Nut Association (CAC) said that Cambodia produced 850,000 tons of cashew nuts last year, an increase of 26.8% compared to 2023, and exported 815,000 tons, an increase of 31%.




Export volume and value to Japan, Apr-2025





Percentage of export value to Japan, Apr-2025








Structure of exports by products to Japan, Apr-2025






Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Japan, Apr-2025

Structure of exports by products to Japan, Apr-2025





It is this change in lifestyle that has contributed to the growth of the industry.

According to forecasts, Japan's processed meat market will grow from \$25.8 billion in 2024 to \$32.5 billion in 2033, with a steady compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 2.4% during 2025-2033.
