



According to Japan's Ministry of Trade, the country's export value decreased by 1.7% year-on-year in May 2025. Notably, exports to the United States dropped by 11.1% compared to the same period last

Japan's exports fell in May 2025, marking largest trading partner - declined by 8.8%. the sharpest drop since September last The Central Bank of Japan warned that year because of new trade policies of the tariffs are likely to slow down global economic growth and reduce the profits of Japanese companies, which could have a negative impact on Japan's overall economic expansion.

According to The Japan Times, on July 1st, U.S. tariff levels on Japanese products. President Donald Trump expressed doubts about the possibility of reaching a trade agreement with Japan. For the third consecutive day, he issued critical statements, trade negotiation with the US. ultimately threatening to impose tariffs of up to 35% on Japanese goods.





# **SPOTLIGHTS**

Imports of wood furniture of Japan in April 2025 showed notable fluctuations. For wooden office furniture (HS 940330), Japan mainly imported from China (83%), Poland (5%), and Malaysia (3%), with the total value falling by 8% compared to the same period in 2024.

Wooden kitchen furniture (HS 940340) was primarily supplied by the Philippines and Vietnam, which together accounted for over 70% of imports. The total value reached 1.889 billion yen (USD 13.03 million), up 22% year-on-year. Germany rose to become the third-largest supplier, while imports from China increased by 7% compared to March.


Wooden bedroom furniture (HS 940350) experienced significant volatility, with China accounting for 56% and Vietnam 36% of imports. Although the total value was nearly equal to that of the same period last year, it dropped 9% from the previous month.

Wooden furniture parts (HS 940391) continued to be mainly imported from China (50%), Indonesia (17%), Vietnam (13%), and Malaysia (7%). While imports from Italy declined, supplies from Finland, Poland, and Austria recorded increases compared to previous months.



Export value to Japan, May-2025




Percentage of export value to Japan, May-2025










TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, May-2025

## Japan aims to reach 7.8 billion USD in seafood exports by 2030

The Japanese government revised its national strategy to promote agricultural, forestry, and fishery exports, with the goal of increasing seafood export value to approximately USD 7.8 billion by 2030 - a significant rise from around USD 2.6 billion in 2024.

Priority export products include scallops, orange roughy, sea bream, and oysters - the latter three being newly added to the strategic list. Japan will continue to diversify its export markets, with a focus on the United States, China, South Korea, and Taiwan, and will enhance exports of farmed scallops and yellowtail fish.

The strategy also focuses on upgrading and increasing the number of seafood processing facilities that meet export standards for key markets such as the United States, Vietnam, China, and the European Union.

By 2030, the Japanese government aims to expand the number of certified processing facilities to meet international retailers' demands for quality and sustainability, while also strengthening trade promotion efforts to support this growth.



Export volume and value to Japan, May-2025




### Percentage of export value to Japan, May-2025












**TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, May-2025**

# **SPOTLIGHTS**





Japan's coffee and tea capsule market is experiencing robust growth and is projected to expand from USD 1.57 billion in 2025 to USD 3.62 billion by 2033, with a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9.7%. This growth is driven by rising consumer demand for convenient, easy-to-brew products that still deliver high quality and flavor. In addition, there is a notable shift in consumer preferences toward premium products such as specialty coffee, organic tea, and a wider variety of flavors, broadening the range of choices for discerning Japanese consumers.

Technological and design advancements in capsules also play a significant role-especially the adoption of biodegradable and recycled materials, as well as improvements in coffee machine functionality that enhance the personalized experience. Growing environmental awareness among Japanese consumers has prompted brands to prioritize sustainability in both product design and manufacturing. Meanwhile, distribution channels are expanding rapidly beyond specialty stores to supermarkets, convenience stores, and especially e-commerce platforms, offering greater convenience and accessibility for consumers.

The market is witnessing strong competition among major international brands such as Nespresso, Keurig, and UCC, along with domestic players. All are heavily investing in product innovation, marketing, and channel development to secure market share. With strong growth potential and rapidly increasing consumer demand, this market presents an attractive opportunity for new entrants and startups-particularly those focused on eco-friendly capsule development and online business models.





# Ultra-Rare Melon Sold for 20,000 Yen (Approx. USD 128) in Ibaraki

At the Hokota Agricultural Market in Ibaraki Prefecture, an ultra-rare melon called Maboroshi-known for its exceptional sweetness exceeding 20 degrees Brix-makes only a limited appearance each season. Each melon is carefully packaged in a premium wooden box and sold for 20,000 yen, approximately USD 128.

Despite the high price, this melon is highly sought after as a luxurious gift or for personal indulgence. Last year, only 10 Maboroshi melons were sold during the entire season. From April 7 to the end of May this year, six melons have been sold-accounting for just 0.001% of the total melons sold at the market.











MIRARTH Agri Tech, headquartered in Kampong Thom Province, Cambodia since 2021, received support from the governments of Australia and Japan to assist smallholder farmers in three key areas: promoting local processing, accessing global markets, and ensuring stable and fair prices for farmers. Japan's support, in particular, has helped MIRARTH improve its supply chain and conduct feasibility studies on cashew processing and waste reduction.

The EU is MIRARTH's second-largest market after Japan. The company also exports to Singapore, Hong Kong, and Thailand.




Export volume and value to Japan, May-2025




Percentage of export value to Japan, May-2025






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, May-2025

# Structure of exports by products to Japan, May-2025




