


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

Amending some provisions on the origin of goods in the AKFTA Agreement

The Ministry of Industry and Trade has issued Circular No. 04/2024/TT-BCT on amending and supplementing specific regulations on Rules of Origin in the ASEAN – Korea Free Trade Agreement (AKFTA). Specifically, (1) changing name of the amendment to "Trading Goods Agreement under the ASEAN-Korea Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Framework Agreement"; (2) amending the procedures for issuing and verifying self-certification of origin (C/O) accompanying Circular No. 20/2014/TT-BCT on legitimizing the practical choice of electronic C/O.



Japan and ASEAN will integrate QR code payments from 2025

Japan and ASEAN's members will integrate QR code payment systems by 2025. The governments of Singapore, Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia, and the Philippines have signed memoranda of understanding regarding the integration of QR code payments and have applied payment processes in specific sectors. Japan will negotiate with ASEAN countries to apply this service between Japan and ASEAN members.






Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Feb-2024












Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the ASEAN, Feb-2024

According to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), in 2024, Philippines will import 4.1 million metric tons of rice, an increase of 600,000 metric tons compared to 2023 (3.5 million metric tons). This additional quantity of rice is equivalent to the average rice imports in two months. The increase in rice imports in Philippines is due to drought conditions affecting domestic rice production. If the Philippines imports rice as forecasted, it will be a record figure for the country.

In February 2024, the rice imports of the Philippines reached 303,603 metric tons, an increase of 113.6% compared to the same period the previous year. Cumulatively, in the first two months of 2024, the country imported 728,254 metric tons of rice, nearly 85% higher than in 2023. Among these imports, up to 391,000 metric tons of rice, equivalent to 54% of the total, were imported from Vietnam.

On 3 March 2024, Bulog's CEO Mr. Bayu Krishnamurti announced that Indonesia imported 300,000 metric tons of rice from Thailand and Pakistan to provide more rice for the upcoming Ramadan vegetarian month and Eid al-Fitr festival. Bulog currently srotes approximately 1.3 million metric tons of rice.


According to the Indonesian Central Bureau of Statistics (BPS), rice prices in February reached the highest levels in recent years. Price of rice and some essential food items tends to increase before the Ramadan vegetarian month. However, the prices of these commodities are higher than in previous years due to limited supply. In February, prices of high, medium and low-quality rice increased by 22.91%, 25.32%, and 30.53%, respectively, compared to the same period last year.









According to the Chairman of the Malaysian Pineapple Industry Board (MPIB), Malaysia has set a target to increase pineapple cultivation area from 17,000 hectares to 20,000 hectares by 2024; increasing pineapple production from 583,543 metric tons to 700,000 metric tons. MPIB will focus on expanding pineapple cultivation areas in East Malaysia (Sabah and Sarawak), where there is potential agricultural land. MPIB plans to increase exports by an additional 200 containers this year to meet the target of exporting 1,000 containers set by the Minister of Agriculture and Food Security Ministry. *Source: Guojiquoshu.com*

The Federation of Thai Industries (FTI) calls on the government to enhance inspections of imported fruits and vegetables from neighboring countries after some imported agricultural products contain pesticide residues exceeding standards. FTI warned that cheap foreign products has been affecting the competitiveness of domestic small and medium-sized enterprises.


Malaysian durians have been introduced to the market earlier due to the hot and humid weather which has accelerated the maturity of durian fruits. Musang King durians are currently sold at 10 SGD/kg (equivalent to 7.44 USD/kg). Recently, during the 1st-anniversary celebration organized by the Durian Manufacturers Association of Malaysia (DMA), a memorandum of understanding has been signed to implement a dedicated flight to transport durians from Kuala Lumpur to Zhengzhou (China) for exporting fresh durians in May.













Structure of exports by products to the ASEAN, Feb-2024






Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Feb-2024






Indonesia welcomes Chinese investors to support restructure process of domestic wood processing industry. According to Agus Justianto, the Director General of the Department of Sustainable Forest Management under Ministry of Environment and Forestry. The restructuring industrial machinery will increase the value of wood products. This decision has announced in a meeting between Indonesian Furniture and Handicraft Industry Association (HIMKI) and the China National Furniture Association (CNFMA) at the 2024 Indonesia International Furniture Expo (IFEX).


According to the Ministry of Environment and Forestry of Indonesia, the wood processing industry includes 3,485 facilities, of which 391 large-scale facilities (with capacities of 6,000 m3/year) and 3,094 small and medium-sized facilities (with capacities under 6,000 m3/year).

The total designed capacity of the wood processing industry is 9.5 million m3/year for large-scale facilities and 10.5 million m3/year for small and medium-sized facilities.




Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Feb-2024









Thailand's proposal of new Fisheries Law causes concern in Europe.

According to the European Commission, Thailand's proposal of new Fisheries Law may undermine measures to protect fishermen implemented since 2015. The Commission also considers these changes as "relaxing current regulations" and "inconsistent with Thailand's obligations under international law."

The Commission will take necessary action if Thailand does not cooperate in againsting IUU. Products such as tuna, shrimp, and crab from Thailand may be removed from supermarkets in EU market if Thai Land abandons regulations on protecting fishermen.

Skipjeck tuna prices in Bangkok continues to decline

In March 2024, the price of skipjack tuna in Thailand is about 1,300 USD/ton, a decrease of 100 USD/ton compared to February and the lowest level since October 2021. The reason for the decrease of tuna prices in the Thai market is due to an increase in domestic supply.











Structure of export value by-products to the ASEAN, Feb-2024




