




# China increases green investment in ASEAN

### The IMF recommends for ASEAN to overcome economic challenges

Kristalina Georgieva-IMF General Director highlights that ASEAN's growth rate is 4.6% in 2023. However, she also warns that ASEAN needs to continue to develop dynamically to overcome current global economic challenges, including inflation pressures and tightening credit .

Ms. Georgieva recommends three steps for ASEAN members to maintain high growth, including (1) maintaining macroeconomic and financial stability to ensure consumers' and investors' confidence, (2) investing more in education and skills training, and (3) investing in digital connectivity and the green economy.

#### China increases green investment in ASEAN

China is increasing investment in green technology in ASEAN to become the largest investor in the region. China is the largest investors for green projects in ASEAN.

According to Pahala Mansury - Indonesian Deputy Foreign Minister, ASEAN are calling for 93 investment projects with 38.2 billion USD for its partner countries. China, the US, the UK, France, and Australia are expected to be key the investors of these projects. China's main investment fields include green infrastructure, digital economy, sustainable finance, and tourism. ASEAN countries have welcomed Chinese investment flows but they have also raised some concerns about the region's economic dependence on China.





#### Changes in the percentage of export value the ASEAN, Sep-2023












#### Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the ASEAN, Sep-2023

### **SPOTLIGHT**

Vietnam's rice exports to ASEAN in September 2023 decreased sharply compared to the previous month because Philippines reduced imports after setting a domestic rice celling price. Philippines is the largest consumer of Vietnamese rice in ASEAN. On August 31, the government set a rice ceiling price at 41 pesos/kg (about 0.72 USD/kg) for normal milled rice and 45 pesos/kg (about 0.79 USD/kg) for carefully milled rice, equivalent to 720-800 USD/ton.

Imposing a celling price much lower than the world rice price means it is difficult for countries to export to this market due to price differences. However, at the 6th International Rice Conference in Philippines, the Philippine's Ministry of Agriculture affirmed that the celling price is a short-term measure and the Ministry will apply other solutions. On 20 October, the Philippine's Ministry of Agriculture announced that the rice celling price will not be applied in November.

According to the Indonesian Bureau of Statistics, the prolonged drought caused by El Nino has negative impact on planting and harvesting rice in many areas, leading to the country's rice output decreases by 2% to 30.90 million tons in 2023. Indonesia's 2023 rice harvest area is estimated to about 10.2 million hectares, down from 10.45 million hectares a year ago. This forecast is based on production data in August and estimated harvest output from September to December. Source: Congthuong.vn



The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development forecasts that Vietnam will harvest 10 million tons of paddy in the last three months of 2023, which is equivalent to 5 million tons of rice. This rice output is enough to domestic demand, and about 1.5 million tons for export. Vietnam has many opportunities to export rice when other countries increase imports. For example, Malaysia needs to import up to 30% of total import volume to ensure domestic consumption and reserve requirements.







#### Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Sep-2023









### **SPOTLIGHT**

O1 Malaysia's Ministry of Agriculture is requesting to export fresh durian to the Chinese market and hopes to receive China's approval next year on the 50th anniversary of establishing diplomatic relations between Malaysia and China. Currently, Malaysia is allowed to export frozen durian, pulp, and powder to China. The Malaysian Ministry of Agriculture recommends that domestic durian farmers should prepare to ensure their opportunities to export fresh durian to China, thereby increasing export value and market.

The Philippine starts exporting avocados to Korea from 30 September, 2023. Exported avocados are sourced from DA-BPI's certification and Dole Philippines packers in Davao, Bukidnon, and South Cotabato.

In an effort to encourage domestic garlic production, the Indonesian Ministry of Agriculture plans to reduce garlic imports by about 40% by 2024. The maximum import volume is 650,000 tons to meet domestic demand from 600,000 to 620,000 tons. The Ministry of Agriculture has issued a RIPH license to import 1.1 million tons of garlic this year, and hopes that the Ministry of Commerce will also limit garlic imports through import approval letters.





#### Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Sep-2023










#### Structure of exports by products to Aug-2023








TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Sep-2023

## COFFEE

### **SPOTLIGHT**

Climate insurance company-Blue Marble and Nestlé have cooperated pilot weather insurance program in Indonesia. The program aims to provide financial protection to more than 800 small coffee farmers in Indonesia against unpredictable fluctuations of rainfall and drought.

Weather insurance uses climate data from satellites to determine when coffee yields are affected by weather. Payments under the parametric insurance scheme will be automatically paid for registered and affected coffee farmers, depending on the severity of the weather.


The program is part of the Nescafé 2030 Plan, which aims to support the long-term sustainability of coffee and improve the livelihood of farmers. If the program is successful, Nestlé will expand the program to other coffee material areas of Nescafé.


According to the Import-Export Department - Ministry of Industry and Trade, Vietnam's coffee exports will increase again in the fourth quarter of 2023 due to production cycle and abundant domestic supply. The largest 2023/2024 coffee harvest season will be in the fourth quarter of 2023 and the first quarter of 2024. ASEAN continues to remain Vietnam's second-largest coffee import market in 2023.








#### Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Sep-2023




#### Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Sep-2023










#### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the ASEAN , Sep-2023

According to Cambodia Cashew Association, in the first 8 months of the year, the country exported 634,000 tons of cashew nuts, down 16% compared to the same period in 2022. Of which, 95%, equivalent to 613,000 tons, was exported to Vietnam with a value of 829 million USD.








#### Value ratio TOP 5 export enterprise to the ASEAN, Sep-2023

In the first seven months of 2023, Indonesia's pepper exports decreased by 27.4% in volume and 28.8% in value compared to same period last year due to unsatisfied crop season and low purchase demand. China, Vietnam, and the US are the main import markets of Indonesian pepper, accounting for 20.2%, 15.5% and 15% respectively.








Structure of export by-product to the ASEAN, Sep-2023



### **SPOTLIGHT**

According to the Malaysian Department of Statistics, the exported volume of natural rubber in August 2023 was 57.5 thousand tons, decreased by 4.5% over the same period of last year but increased 11% over the previous month. Of which, 47.9% were exported to China, followed by Germany at 8.7%, Iran at 4%, Pakistan at 4.4%, the United States at 2.9%, and Pakistan at 2.7%. *Source:* Department of Statistics Malaysia

✤ In the first three quarters of 2023, Thailand exports 1.99 million tons of natural rubber, down 23% over the same period in 2022. Of which, Thailand exported 0.77 million tons of natural rubber to China, down 3% over the same period last year.

In the first eight months of 2023, Indonesia exported 1.21 million tons of natural rubber, down 18% over the same period last year. Of which, natural rubber exports to China was 0.15 million tons, up 40% over the same period the previous year.

In the first nine months of 2023, Cambodia exported 242.3 thousand tons of rubber, with a value of 355.6 million USD, increasing 3.5% of volume but decreasing 9.8% of value over the same period last year. Cambodia's main export markets are Malaysia, Vietnam, Singapore and China.











TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023

## The target market of Thai tuna products in the first half of this year has changed.

Thailand's tuna exports to the Middle East grew strongly, reaching nearly 49 thousand tons in first haft year of 2023, surpassing the US to become the top export market. Meanwhile, exports to the US decreased by 19%, reaching 45,245 tons. Other markets also recorded declines, including Africa (down 54%), Oceania (down 22%), and Japan (up 22%). Regarding value, the US is still Thailand's largest export market, with revenue reaching 227 million USD.

## The Indonesian government is considering to export lobster larvae after 7 years of ban.

The new draft decree will allow exporters to buy wild-caught larvae lobster from local fishermen. Exporters must sign cooperation agreements with local fishermen and commit to release 2% of their harvest into the sea.

The new policy is expected to promote Indonesia's lobster farming sector while protecting natural resources.


Structure of import value by products the ASEAN, Sep-2023


