







### AFF product import-export turnover between Vietnam and China, Sep-2023




### Key AFF product export value to China, Sep-2023

# **China's Growth Beats Forecasts**

According to National Bureau of Statistics of China, China's GDP in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter increased by 4.9% compared to the same period of the last year. This growth rate is higher than the forecast's rate of economists in Reuters survey of 4.6%.

Industrial output in September increased 4.5% and retail sales increased 5.5% in comparison to same period of last year.

The unemployment rate was 5% at the

end of September, showing the improvement compared to August.

The National Bureau of Statistics of China noted that the economic recovery has been more evident in the third quarter. This agency predicts that if the growth rate in fourth-quarter is above 4.4%, China can achieve its annual growth target.

However, analysts state that the real estate sector could negatively impact on Chinese economy in this year. Furthermore, the International Monetary

Fund (IMF) has revised downward China's growth rate in 2023 and 2024 due to the potential downturn in the real estate market.

# Launching a train carrying refrigerated goods from China to Vietnam and Laos

On 16 October, China officially launched a cold storage train from Kunming city (Yunnan) to Vientine (Laos) and Lao Cai (Vietnam).

According to the assessment of the operation unit, this railway has advantages of safety, stability, short time and good transport capacity with cold chain equipment. Thanks to that, ensuring the freshness of goods such as vegetables and fruits from Yunnan to Vietnam, Laos and vice versa.

Currently, these two international railway routes enjoy a 50%


discount on transportation cost and other support policies, in order to reduce logistics costs for businesses, promote regional economic and trade development along the route.














### **TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to China, Sep-2023**

According to the General Department of Customs, in September 2023, China's total rice imports were 130,000 tons, an increase of 20,000 tons compared to the previous month. Accumulated from January to September, rice imports reached 2.15 million tons, decrease 57.5% over the same period last year.






### Changes in percentage of export value to China, Sep-2023









# **SPOTLIGHTS**

### Consumption of white leg shrimp in Chinese market decreased after National Day:

The white leg shrimp consumption in China has been decreasing sharply after the National Day holiday. This continuous decline has had a direct impact on seafood sales. Consumption volume during the Chinese National Day holiday fell below average volume, affecting to reduce white-leg shrimp price. Most importers are being careful and waiting for market signal before deciding to place new orders.

### China's fresh seafood imports increased

Statistics from China's Department of Customs show that in the first 8 months of 2023, the country imported over 85,000 tons of fresh seafood, an increase of 16% over the same period in 2022. The average import price also increased by 15% compared to the same period of the last year. Of which, the largest proportion is salmon with nearly 56,000 tons, accounting for 65% of total import volume. Norway is the largest provider of fresh and chilled salmon for China.

China's domestic consumption of fresh seafood products has clearly recovered after the Chinese Government lifted restrictions related to the Covid 19 epidemic. However, Vietnam only accounts for a very modest market share, 0.2% of China's total fresh/live seafood import volume in the first 8 months of this year.

# **SPOTLIGHTS**

### China's imports of squid and cuttlefish increased by more than 50%

In August 2023, China imported 31,500 tons of squid and cuttlefish, with value of 700 million yuan (97 million USD), up 7% and 14% in volume and value respectively over the same period last year. By the end of August 2023, China imported 339,200 tons of squid and cuttlefish, with value of 6.225 billion yuan (851 million USD), an increase of 51% in both volume and value over the same period last year. Frozen squid and cuttlefish account for 85% of China's import value. These products are processed into high-value products (accounting for 52% of total export value) for re-export abroad.

In September, a many key products of Viet Nam export to Chinese market had grown compared to the previous month. Both Vietnam and many other exporting countries are also looking forward to a stable recovery of market demand after Covid-19, especially after the Fall Holidays - a time of increasing consumption volume in China. China is still a potential destination for Vietnamese exporters, especially after China banned seafood imports from Japan.





### Percentage of import value from China, Sep-2023





# **SPOTLIGHTS**



The fruit import and export value between China and ASEAN in the first eight months of 2023 reached 70.26 billion CNY (about 9.6 billion USD), an increase of 22.8% over the same period last year. Of which, the fruit export value was 12.16 billion CNY (1.67 billion USD), an increase of 11.0% over the same period last year; The value of imported fruit was 58.10 billion CNY (7.96 billion USD), up 25.6% over the same period last year. Currently, there are more than 20 types of fruits from 9 ASEAN countries, including Vietnam, Thailand, Philippines, and Cambodia, that are allowed to be imported into China.




### Changes in percentage of export value to China, Sep-2023












### Average export price to China, Sep-2023





### The Chinese coffee market is growing strongly.

According to China's General Administration of Customs, China imported 79,980 tons of coffee in the first eight months of 2023, with value of 452.1 mil. USD, up 7.7% in volume and 5.6% in value compared to the same month of 2022.


In China, instant coffee accounts for 63% of total coffee consumption, and mainly be imported. Brazil is the largest coffee supplier for China's market, accounting for 31.82% of total imports in the first 8 months of 2023.

The Chinese coffee market is growing strongly with a steady growth rate of 9.63% per year in 2022-2025 period, much higher than the international coffee consumption growth rate of 2%.




### Changes in percentage of export value to China, Sep-2023











### **TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to China, Sep-2023**












### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to China, Sep-2023



According to the General Administration of Customs of China, imports of round yellow maple wood in the first eight months of 2023 was estimated to reach 971,231 m3 with a value of 130.73 mil. USD, decrease 33% in volume and 36% in value compared to the same month of 2022. The average import price of round yellow maple wood reached 135 USD/m3, down 5% compared to the same month of 2022.


Imports of sawn yellow maple wood in the first eight months of 2023 are estimated to reach 475,863 m3 with a value of 98.79 mil. USD, up 10% in volume and 3% in value compared to the same month of 2022. The average import price of sawn yellow maple wood reached 208 USD/m3, decrease 6% compared to the same month of 2022.


TOP 2 import enterprises by value from China, Sep-2023

According to China's National Bureau of Statistics, in the first nine months of 2023, China's pork production increased by 3.6%; while China's pig head was 442.29 million, decrease 0.4%; about 537.23 million pigs were slaughtered in the first 9 months of 2023, up 3.3% compared to the same month of 2022.

Also in the first 9 months of 2023, China imported 2.03 million tons of buffalo and cattle meat (HS 0201; 0202), with a value of 10.81 billion USD, an increase of 4.8% in volume, but a decrease of 17.2% in value compared to same period in 2022. China mainly imported from Brazil, Argentina, Uruguay, Australia, New Zealand, United States... of which, imports from Uruguay, New Zealand, and the United States decreased while imports from the remaining markets increased significantly compared to the same month of 2022.

According to the USDA, China's pork consumption in 2024 is expected to decrease 1% compared to 2023, to 58.15 million tons due to lower domestic production. In 2023, higher consumption is mainly due to higher domestic supply, but the slowing economy has caused weaker demand and a pork oversupply in the first half of 2023. In 2024, China is expected to continue to prioritize stabilizing pork prices. China's pork imports in 2024 are expected to increase slightly to 2.32 million tons due to lower domestic production. In 2023, pork imports are estimated to be 2.3 million tons with a growth of 8% over the previous year.





### Changes in percentage of export value to China, Sep-2023






### Structure of export value by products to China, Sep-2023






### Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to




### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to

In September 2023, China's imported volume and value of dried cassava chips were 352.2 ths. tons and 99.36 mil. USD, respectively, increased by 39.29% and 30.70% respectively over the same period last year. From January to September, China's imported volume and value of dried cassava chips were 5.11 million tons and 1.41 billion USD, down 17.56% and 20.87% respectively compared to same period last year.



In September 2023, China's cassava starch imports were 318 ths tons, an increase of 35.95% compared to the previous month; down 10.45% over the same period last year. Accumulated in the first 9 months of 2023, the country's total cassava starch imports reached 2.24 million tons, down 30.03% over the same period last year.

The Vietnam Cassava Association reported that a limited trade in both domestic and export cassava chips and prices have been due to very low corn prices. The Association predicts that the supply of cassava chips in the 2023/24 crop will be more abundant than the 2022/23 crop, while demand from the Chinese market is not high.
