

#### AFF product import-export turnover between Vietnam and Korea, Dec-2022




#### Key AFF product export value to Korea, Dec-2022

# Korean exports continued to decrease for the third consecutive month

South Korea's Ministry of Commerce data also found that in December, exports fell 9.5% year-on-year, marking the third consecutive month of decline, storming exports to China and Southeast Asia. not enough to offset modest export growth to the US and European Union.



# The Central Bank of Korea (BoK) raised the basic interest rate to 3.5% to control inflation



Korea's domestic economy is under great pressure due to high inflation and rising interest rates. The country's consumer price index in December increased by 5% over the same period in 2021. To restrain prices, the Central Bank of Korea (BoK) increased its policy interest rate by 275 basis points from January August 2021 and is expected to carry out another interest rate increase early this year. High interest rates may cause households in Korea to cut their spending budgets. The Korean economy faces concerns about the risk of an economic recession that could affect demand for Korean goods. The outlook for the economy remains bleak as exports are expected to remain sluggish and corporate consumption and investment are likely to decline.











In October 2022, Korea's wood imports increased by 8.5% over the same period last year, but were 0.9% lower than the previous month.

In October 2022, Korea's roundwood imports decreased by 13.6%, sawn timber decreased by 14.1% over the same period last year.












TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Dec-2022

#### Import value of frozen herring increased by 146%

In the first 11 months of 2022, Korea imported 1,076,966 tons of seafood, of which frozen herring accounted for 2.50% with 26,977 tons, compared to 15,619 tons out of a total of 989,014 tons imported in the previous year, accounting for 1.58%. The average import unit price in November was 0.74 USD/kg, up 28% compared to 0.58 USD/kg the previous year.

#### Korea's seafood imports increase in 2022


According to statistics from the Korean Customs Agency, in 2022 the country spent 6.47 billion USD to import 1.595 million tons of seafood from 109 markets, an increase of 3.9% in volume and an increase of 12.7%. in value compared to 2021. In 2022, Korea sharply increased seafood imports from the Russian and Vietnamese markets, while reducing seafood imports from Norway, the United States, and Peru.




**Export volume and value to Korea**, Dec-2022






Percentage of export value to Korea, Dec-2022






#### Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Dec-2022





According to data from Statista, the revenue of the Korean coffee market in 2023 is estimated to reach 16.08 billion USD. The Korean coffee market in the period 2023 - 2025 is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 5.57%.

The National Council of Korean Consumer Organizations, said the daily coffee consumption and monthly coffee costs of 70% of Korean adults average at least one cup and 103,978 won (80,000,000 won). 54 USD).










#### Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Dec-2022










#### Changes in percentage of import value from Korea, Dec-2022








South Korea imported record quantities of kimchi last year as inflation increased the price of cabbage and other key ingredients used to make kimchi, according to data from the Korea Customs Service. The volume of imported kimchi in 2022 will reach 263,434 tons, the import value will reach 169.4 million USD, an increase of 9% in volume and more than 20% in value compared to the previous year.






#### Percentage of export value to Korea, Dec-2022






Export volume and value to Korea, Dec-2022






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Dec-2022








TOP export enterprises by volume to Korea, Dec-2022













#### Structure of import by products from Korea, Dec-2022









On January 5, the wholesale price of Korean beef was only 17.4 thousand won/kg, down 12.8% over the same period last year. At distribution points, meat consumption is also sluggish.







The average export price in Dec-2022 is **353** USD/tons; decrease **2.5%** compared to the previous month; and decrease **3.2%** compared to the same month of 2021.

#### **Tapioca starch**

The average export price in Dec-2022 is **403** USD/tons; increase **0.7%** compared to the previous month; and increase **36.4%** compared to the same month of 2021.







### SPOTLIGHT



In the first 11 months of 2022, cassava exports to Korea increased sharply, reaching 138 thousand tons and 49 million USD (up 56.9% in volume and 66.7% in value compared to the same period in 2021). Not only cassava chips, cassava starch exports to Korea in 2022 will also grow very strongly. In May 11, 2022, Vietnam is the second largest market supplying cassava starch to the Korean market, with 3.48 thousand tons, worth 2 million USD, an increase of 39.6% in volume and an increase of 53.6% % in value compared to the same period in 2021.

Cassava exports to Korea also grew very impressively. In the first 11 months of 2022, Vietnam is the second largest market supplying cassava to Korea, with 118.15 thousand tons, worth 49.84 million USD, an increase of 42.6% in volume and an increase of 62.9% in value. value compared to the same period in 2021. Vietnam's cassava market share accounts for 42.8% of Korea's total cassava imports.

Regarding cassava, in the first 11 months of 2022, Korea imported 276.1 thousand tons, worth 92.84 million USD, up 49.1% in volume and 73.9% in value compared to the same period in 2021.

### **COMMENTS AND REVIEW**



Korea is a very potential market for Vietnam's cassava industry as the demand for imported cassava and cassava products increases. Despite strong growth and being the second largest source of supply, the export value as well as the market share of Vietnam's cassava starch in Korea is still quite modest when compared to the largest source, Thailand.
