EU economy still faces the risk of a new recession

The governments of the European Union (EU) members avoided an economic recession earlier this year, but now, the threat of a new recession is looming,

Bloomberg news agency reported on March 8.

This is due to the overwhelming cost of European governments to combat their significant dependence on Russian gas supplies. EU inflation hit a record high of 5.6% in February.



Low economic growth

According to the EC's forecast in November 2022, the GDP growth of the EU in general and the Eurozone in particular in 2023 will reach a low level but still have a positive sign of 0.3%.

In 2024, GDP growth is expected to recover to a modest 1.6% for the EU and 1.5% for the Eurozone.

Rapidly falling inflation and rising wages will be the driving forces behind the increase of real disposable income of households, leading to a recovery in private consumption. The tightening of monetary policy is expected to have a stronger impact in 2024.


As for the labor market, the Eurozone unemployment rate is forecast to rise to 7.2% in 2023, before falling to 7% in 2024.


Public debt in the EU is expected to be 89% of GDP by the end of 2023. Over the long term, EU public debt is projected to around 87% of GDP in 2024 and 85% of GDP in 2025.


Changes in percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023










TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the EU, Feb-2023




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the EU, Feb-2023


On 8 March 2023, the European Commission issued Regulation (EU) 2023/507 decreasing the import duty applicable to certain husked rice (excluding basmati rice) classified under HS code 1006.20.

According to the new legislation, the import tariff was decreased from EUR 65 (USD 68.5) per tonne to EUR 30 (USD 31.6) per tonne.





TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the EU, Feb-2023







Accordingly, this garlic from China is not really frozen, it's refrigerated. It is transported at temperatures of -4 °C, while the frozen product must be transported at temperatures of -20 °C. These products belong to different tariff classifications, so this alleged fraudulent garlic is introduced out of quota and with very low tariffs.








Export volume and value to the EU, Feb-2023





Changes in percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023






Structure of exports by products to the EU, Feb-2023











TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the EU, Feb-2023




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the EU, Feb-2023

Asia, the US and Europe account for nearly 85% of the world's total pepper consumption. Germany is the largest pepper importer in Europe. Recently, Brazil's pepper exports to Europe have not been favorable due to quality problems. Statistics from Eurostat show that in the 11 months of 2022, the EU imported 89.92 thousand tons pepper, worth 471.6 million EUR (equivalent to 498.2 mil. USD), decreasing 5.0% in volume but increasing 27.6% in value over the same period in 2021. EU imports from from Brazil, Indonesia, India decreased but increased from Vietnam and Cambodia.


Under the impact of climate change, the EU recently enacted the Anti-Deforestation Law. Accordingly, all agricultural products entering the EU must meet the requirements of not destroying forests and not causing deforestation. Currently, Vietnamese products such as coffee and cocoa have been targeted by the EU. Although the EU has not targeted pepper, in future, it can be concerned as pepper have common characteristics with coffee and cocoa.










Percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023








TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the EU, Feb-2023




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the EU, Feb-2023

According to the European Statistics Agency, in 2022, Germany imported 59.95 thousand tons of cashew nuts, worth 408 million EUR (equivalent to 435.52 mil. USD), up 1.1% in volume and 13.4% in volume compared to 2021. With non-EU markets, in 2022, imports of cashew nuts from Vietnam and Ivory Coast increased, while imports from India, Indonesia and Brazil decreased.






Changes in percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023









Percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023







In 2022 the EU27 imported 1.94 million tonnes of tropical wood and wooden furniture products with a total value of US\$4.37 bil. respectively 10% and 18% more than the previous year. Compared to the pre-pandemic level of imports in 2019, imports last year increased 36% in value terms but only 6% in quantity terms

After two slow years during the global pandemic, EU27 imports of tropical sawnwood recovered ground last year. Imports of 1,014,000 cubic metres last year were 18% higher than in 2021 and 30% more than in 2020.

Sawnwood imports increased last year from all the largest tropical suppliers to the EU27 including Cameroon (+16% to 360,700 cubic metres), Brazil (+42% to 166,200 cubic metres), Gabon (+19% to 164,500 cubic metres), Malaysia (+8% to 85,800 cubic metres).






Changes in percentage of export value to the EU, Feb-2023








Structure of exports by countries, Feb-2023






TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the EU, Feb-2023

Since the EVFTA Agreement took into effect from August 2020, according to the commitment of the EVFTA, the EU gives Vietnam a quota of 80,000 tons of rice per year, including 30,000 tons of milled rice, 20,000 tons of unmilled rice and 30,000 tons of fragrant rice. The EU will completely liberalize broken rice, helping Vietnam to export about 100,000 tons to this market each year.

Exporting rubber to the EU market has faced many obstacles in recent months due to fluctuations in the dollar. In the coming time, fuel prices and energy demand in the EU are expected to decrease, especially transport costs. This is an optimistic signal for Vietnam's rubber exports to the EU in the coming months.

The UK is the world's third largest import market of wooden furniture, the average import value of British wooden furniture in the period 2018 - 2022, reaching \$4.4 billion, an average growth of 7.4%/year during this period. Imports from Vietnam increased slightly, but the proportion was still low compared to the market demand, accounting for only 7.14% of the total value of British wooden furniture imports. Therefore, there are still many opportunities to promote the export of wooden furniture to the UK market in the near future.
