






## **ASEAN: Promoting cross-border electricity trade**

The 4th ASEAN Online Sales Day (AOSD) 2023 takes place in two weeks, from August 8 to August 22, 2023, organized by the ASEAN Coordinating Committee on E-commerce. This is the largest online shopping event in Southeast Asia, bringing together the best goods and services from across the region on a single e-commerce platform at onlineasean.com. AOSD has two levels:

- Level for domestic transactions: Reputable businesses and e-commerce platforms in 10
   ASEAN countries deploy a series of special discount shopping programs for consumers
   in that country.
- The level of cross-border transactions, businesses, and platforms will coordinate the implementation of cross-border online shopping programs among ASEAN countries

ASEAN and the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau Greater Bay Area of China have signed seven economic cooperation agreements worth 1.7 billion USD. These agreements include industrial park construction projects, digital economy, and agricultural cooperation. The signing was completed within the framework of the 2023 ASEAN-China Greater Bay Economic Cooperation (Qianhai) Forum, taking place from July 29-30 in Shenzhen, Southern China.

This year's forum marks the establishment of the Greater Bay Area - ASEAN International Chamber of Commerce Alliance and the China-ASEAN Partnership Think Tank. The parties agreed to promote an initiative to develop the Greater Bay Area - ASEAN economic partnership more closely.






#### Export volume and value of rice to the ASEAN, Jul-2023








#### Structure of exports by products to the ASEAN






#### TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023




#### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the ASEAN, Jul-2023

The Philippines wants India to export rice on humanitarian grounds. This will allow the Philippines to import an additional 300,000 tons to 500,000 tons of rice this year.

According to the Myanmar Rice Federation, this country exported 58,334 tons of rice and broken rice in July 2023. Myanmar has exported rice to 20 countries, including the Philippines, Spain, Poland, China, Belgium and the Netherlands. 







#### Percentage of import value from the ASEAN, Jul-2023





According to a report from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Cambodia, in the first half of 2023, Cambodia's total fresh banana exports reached 165.6 thousand tons, down 24.4% compared to the same period in 2022. The reason for the decrease is due to the market. Unstable exports and climate change affect product quality.

According to Thailand's National Bureau of Food and Agricultural Commodities Standards, Japan has exempted steam heat treatment regulations for mangosteens imported from Thailand. The exemption was approved under the Japan-Thailand Economic Partnership Agreement (JTEPA). The first batch of mangosteen without steam heat treatment will be inspected and certified by Japanese officials in the third week of August. This exemption will help Thai mangosteen exporters reduce costs and help fruit stay fresh longer.







#### Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023






#### Structure of exports by products to the ASEAN








**TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Jul 2023**

#### Indonesian coffee faces El Nino shock.


The Indonesian weather agency (BMKG) said the El Nino phenomenon usually brings prolonged hot and dry weather and has affected more than two-thirds of the country, including Java and parts of Sumatra, which are also two regions—Indonesia's important coffee-producing sector.

In 2023/24, Indonesia's coffee production is forecast at 9.7 million bags (60 kg), down 2.15 million bags from 11.85 million bags a year earlier and the lowest since 2011/12.








#### Structure of exports by products to the ASEAN, Jul-2023





According to the president of the Cambodia Cashew Association, more than 90% of Cambodia's raw cashew nuts are exported to neighboring countries for processing into final products. Cambodia currently has about 30 small-scale cashew processing factories and three medium-scale factories in the provinces of Kampong Thom, Kampong Cham, and Preah Vihear. The Cambodian government set a target of building a minimum of 50 moderately regulated grain manufacturers by 2027 to enhance domestic transformation efficiency.

02

From January to July 2023, Vietnam experienced a decline in its import of cashew nuts from Cambodia. The volume of imports decreased by 14.5%, and the value decreased by 23.47% compared to the same period in the previous year. Cambodia supplied a total of 587,160 tons of cashew nuts, generating a turnover of 802.3 million USD. In contrast, Indonesia saw a significant increase in cashew nut imports, with a volume of 3,881 tons and a turnover of 4.7 million USD. This represents a 109.2% increase in volume and a 69.6% increase in value compared to the same period in the previous year.












#### Average export price to the ASEAN, Jun-2023




#### **TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023**




#### **TOP 5 enterprise by volume to the ASEAN, Jul-2023**





## **PEPPER**



### **SPOTLIGHTS**

According to the International Pepper Association (IPC), Indonesia produced 83,000 tons of pepper in 2021, but this figure decreased to 65,000 tons in 2022. Experts predict that the trend will continue in 2023, with projected production dropping to 55,000 tons. This decline is attributed to a lack of interest in pepper trees due to higher coffee prices and a shift towards palm trees. This shift has also impacted the country's export volumes. According to the Indonesian Central Bureau of Statistics (BPS), pepper exports in the first five months of this year only amounted to 10,545 tons, representing a 31.2% decrease compared to the same period last year.

According to Cambodia's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, in the first half of 2023, this country's pepper exports reached 4,300 tons, a decrease of more than 31% compared to the same period last year. The main reason is the global economic recession leading to a reduction in orders for goods, including pepper. Market uncertainty and climate change have affected crop productivity and quality. In addition, illegal exports through corridors of Vietnam and Thailand are other factors contributing to the impact on the market.






### Changes in the percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023








#### **TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Jun-2023**

## **SPOTLIGHTS**

• The Statistics Departments of Malaysia have reported that in June 2023, the country's natural rubber exports decreased by 16.7% compared to the same period in 2022, totaling 48,857 tons. However, there was an increase of 31.8% from the previous month. China remained the largest export market with 50.6%, followed by Germany (7.8%), the United States (4.9%), Pakistan (3.1%), and Iran (2.5%). The natural rubber output in Malaysia for the second guarter of 2023 decreased by 7.6% compared to the first guarter of 2023, reaching 77,453 tons. Despite this decline, there was still a 3.8% increase compared to the same period in 2022.




#### Change in percentage of export to the ASEAN, Jul-2023









#### Thai Union announces a \$200 million sustainability initiative.

Thai Union, the company, arranged a 6.9 billion THB (200 million USD) investment account with the SeaChange 2030 sustainable architecture, ensuring that by 2030, 100% of the company's seafood comes from responsible sources. SeaChange 2030 is set to expand Thai Union's snail fish sustainability efforts to other wild-caught species, such as mackerel, herring, salmon, blue crab, and shrimp. Currently, 88% of the company's fish come from responsible sources.

#### Indonesia's white-leg shrimp exports decreased in the first half of this year

The export value to Indonesia's main market, the United States, decreased by 41% in the first five months of the year. Indonesia's total shrimp export output in the first two quarters of this year reached 87,638 tons, down 19% over the same period in 2022 and the lowest volume since 2019.

# Indonesia calls on Singapore to cooperate more closely in combating smuggling of lobster larvae

Indonesia calls on Singapore to commit to closing its borders to illegal exports of lobster larvae. Indonesia has banned the export of wild-caught lobster larvae from 2021, but Singapore still allows imports. The most recent case was reported in early July when customs officers in Batam seized a shipment of nearly 50,000 lobster larvae being transported to Singapore. The illegal export of larvae and baby lobsters causes the country to lose billions of rupiah in revenue and threatens the dwindling number of wild lobsters.



#### Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023




#### Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Jul-2023




Changes in the percentage of import value from the ASEAN, Jul-2023












#### **TOP 5 import enterprises by value to the ASEAN**, Jul 2023

### RICE

The Vietnam Food Association predicts that the demand for Vietnamese rice will rise by over 1 million tons in 2023, compared to the yearly average. This means that the market outlook is favorable for the rest of the year. The Vietnam Commodity News Center reports that global rice prices are expected to remain high due to the current supply situation.

## **PEPPER**

The Cambodian Pepper and Spice Federation (CPSF) reports that the decrease in pepper exports is due to a drop in pepper prices in the market. Despite this, pepper output remains steady. As a result, some farmers have decided to temporarily halt sales and dry their pepper until prices improve. Unfavorable weather conditions have also caused some farmers to abandon planting, which may result in a decrease in pepper production in the upcoming year.

## **SEAFOOD**

VASEP forecasts that in 2023, Vietnam's seafood exports to some ASEAN markets, such as Thailand, will decrease by 11-23% compared to 2022. This market has shown more positive signs as it has increased compared to the previous year. Last month, on the export value of key products such as shrimp, pangasius, squid, and octopus.
