





#### Vietnam and the US solve cooperate to global fertilizer challenge

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) will work with governments and local organizations worldwide, aims to advance fertilizer efficiency and nutrient management, starting with Brazil, Colombia, Pakistan and Vietnam. Among these countries, the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI) is lending its support to the initiative in Vietnam right from the onset. IRRI has surveyed exchanged with relevant partners to consult and develop relevant documents for the project.

The project "Fertilizer Right in Vietnam" is expected to last 4 years with a total budget of about 4 million USD funded by the US side.

To achieve these goals, the project focuses on three main aspects: Increasing fertilizer use efficiency; fertilizer efficiency; improve alternatives developing traditionally produced chemical fertilizers to improve soil health and fertility, environmental quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

The United States officially opens the receipt of applications for administrative review antidumping and countervailing duties on various Vietnamese products

The Trade Remedies Authority of Vietnam and Tube, Utility Wind Towers. (TRAV) has recommended that, the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) published a notice regarding the acceptance of applications for administrative review of certain Vietnamese export products subject to anti-dumping or countervailing duties in the US market. The listed products include: Basa Fish (Frozen Fish Fillets), Seamless Refined Copper Pipe

As per the U.S. trade remedy laws, the deadline to submit applications for administrative review of anti-dumping and countervailing duties on the mentioned products is before August 31, 2023. Within 90 days from the date the DOC announces the initiation of the review, parties have the right to withdraw their review request.






#### Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Jul-2023








#### Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to

According to the US Department of Agriculture (USDA), US rice production in the 2023/24 crop year is estimated to reach 9.2 million tons, an increase of 2.0 million tons over the same period last year.





#### Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jul-2023









### **SPOTLIGHTS**



US imports of tropical hardwood lumber reached 17,832 m3 in June 2023, up 14% over the previous month and down 25% over the same period last year. Imports from Malaysia doubled in June 2023 compared to the previous month, imports from Congo increased by 64%, Cameroon increased by 60%, and Ecuador increased by 44%.

US imports of wooden furniture in June 2023 decreased by 3% compared to the previous month due to relatively stable imports from countries. Except, imports from Indonesia have decreased by 30%, Mexico decreased by 8%.



#### Percentage of export value to the U.S., Jul-2023












#### Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Jul-2023






#### NOAA releases the United States's first national fisheries strategy

The first national fisheries strategy of the United States includes four main goals: maintaining or increasing sustainable wild fishing yields, increasing sustainable aquaculture production, and promoting access to both domestic and global markets for the U.S. seafood industry. The US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) hopes to achieve these three goals within the next five years. The fourth goal is to strengthen the entire U.S. seafood industry, recognizing seafood as a vital part of the blue economy, collaborating across federal agencies to modernize and maintain aquatic infrastructure American assets, promoting workforce development and advancement, equity and environmental justice.

#### Seafood inflation in the United States improved but retail sales did not increase

Similar to the trend in previous months, inflation in the US retail seafood industry was lower than food and beverage inflation. Specifically, the retail price of fresh seafood decreased by 2%, the price of shellfish decreased by 7.6%, and the price of frozen seafood decreased by 4.3%. Although inflation has decreased, it has not yet caused consumers to increase their purchases at stores, so total sales and retail volume of seafood have not increased.

#### The United States is increasingly dependent on shrimp imported from Ecuador



The United States imported about 16,000 tons of shrimp from Ecuador in May with an import value of about 116 million USD. Ecuador surpassed Indonesia to become the second largest shrimp source after India in the United States during the month. Ecuadorian shrimp production is noted to be more efficient than other Asian producers, with fewer diseases, more reliability and better yields.

#### Percentage of import value from the U.S., Jul-2023





On August 8 (local time), Department of Animal and Plant Health Quarantine (APHIS) (USDA) sent a letter to the Plant Protection Department (MARD) informing about allowing Vietnam to "immediately" export coconut to this market. According to APHIS, Vietnamese producers can start exporting skullcaps to the US "immediately". Since the U.S. Department of Animal and Plant Health has classified partially dehulled coconut as a processed product, the only phytosanitary requirements for consignments will occur only at ports in the US.









#### US coffee imports decreased by 10.2%

According to the US International Trade Commission (USITC), in the first 5 months of 2023, US coffee imports decreased by 10.2% in volume and 9.5% in value compared to the same period last year, reaching 617.1 thousand tons, worth 3.46 billion USD.

#### US coffee imports are forecast to decrease by 100 million USD in 2023


According to the US Agricultural Trade Outlook report in August 2023, the forecast for coffee imports in FY 2023 is reduced by \$100 million to \$9.5 billion due to falling prices. It is notable that coffee import values are expected to decline by 3 percent from FY 2022. However, FY 2024 imports are expected to increase 2 percent from the FY 2023 forecast to \$9.7 billion on improving production prospects in South America.






#### Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Jul-2023





According to the International Trade Commission (ITC), in the first 6 months of 2023, the total import of cashew nuts in the United States reached over 64 thousand tons, worth 335.99 million USD, down 18.8% in volume and down 34.6% in value compared to the same period last year. In particular, the United States reduced imports of cashew nuts from Vietnam, a decrease of 22.7% in volume and a decrease of 31.8% in value, reaching 55.83 thousand tons, worth 317.85 million USD. Vietnam's cashew market share in total US imports decreased from 91.61% in the first 6 months of 2022 to 87.17% in the first 6 months of 2023.






#### Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Jul-2023





### Wood & products



Although the US market still poses its challenges, there have been some positive developments. The country's GDP has reached 2%, which is 0.3% higher than projected, as reported by the United States Department of Commerce (DOC). Additionally, in mid-July, the DOC made a preliminary decision to investigate anti-dumping and anti-subsidy claims on Vietnamese hard plywood products that are exported to the US market. As a result, the Chairman of the Vietnam Timber and Forest Products Association (Viforest) believes that there is potential for growth in the export of these products to the US market.

### Seafood



According to the Vietnam Association of Seafood Exporters and Producers (Vapsep), seafood demand from the US market will recover clearly from the end of the third quarter of 2023. Inventories of small catfish (pangasius) in the United States in July 2023 decreased by 8% over the same period last year, down 22% compared to the beginning of this year. Besides, cooling inflation in the United States supports increased consumer demand. However, inflation in the United States will not end this year. Therefore, Vasep forecasts that seafood exports to this market in 2023 will be 24-25% lower than in 2022.

### Pepper



According to the Agency of Foreign Trade, the world's leading economy, the United States, is forecast to have a positive outlook at the end of the year. This will have a positive impact on purchasing power of goods, including pepper and spices. In the general trend of concern about the possible shortage of world food, India has imposed restrictions on rice exports, Russia announced its withdrawal from the Black Sea agreement, which is also a signal of support for the market. agricultural products in general and world spices in particular.

### **Cashew nuts**



According to the Agency of Foreign Trade, Vietnam's cashew nut exports will increase thanks to cyclical factors and increased import demand from the United States in the third quarter of 2023. Currently, domestic factories have signed many new orders and demand for this product has begun to increase again. Production activities are vibrant, many units have to increase processing capacity to keep up with signed orders for the last 2 quarters of the year.
