

Australia Unveils Southeast Asia Economic Strategy to 2040

On September 6, 2023, the Australian government announced the Australia-ASEAN Economic Strategy 2040, which aims to strengthen economic and trade relations with the region. The strategy aims to strengthen economic and trade ties between the two sides. The strategy identifies six priority areas, including agriculture and food, green energy, infrastructure, health, the digital economy, and education.

Australia is currently a major contributor to the food security needs of Southeast Asia, especially wheat, beef, and live cattle. About half of the country's wheat exports go to Southeast Asia, mainly Indonesia, Vietnam, and Philippines.

Philippines and South Korea Sign Free Trade Agreement

On September 7, 2023, the Philippines and South Korea signed a free trade agreement (FTA) to strengthen relations between the two countries. The FTA includes a variety of provisions, including tariff reductions, capacity building, and technical cooperation.

The two countries have committed to significant tariff reductions, with South Korea eliminating tariffs on approximately 94.8% of Philippine products and the Philippines eliminating tariffs on approximately 96.5% of South Korean products.

Expected impact on the agricultural sector, the FTA opens up better market access for agricultural products of Philippines such as bananas, processed pineapples, and various fruits. Philippines agricultural producers can expect increased exports and enhanced competitiveness in the South Korean market.














Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the ASEAN, Aug-2023

On September 26, 2023, the head of Indonesia's National Food Agency (Bapanas), Arief Prasetyo Adiannounced that President Jokowi instructed the import of one million tons of rice from China to increase the government's rice reserves for 2024 due to declining domestic production because of El Niño, which resulted in a 5% decrease in rice production.

The latest forecast from the Agricultural Economic Office under the Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives of Thailand shows that the country's rice production is expected to decrease by 871,000 tons, or 3.27%, to 25.8 million tons in the 2023-2024 harvest season, mainly due to the El Niño weather phenomenon.

Malaysia is working to increase domestic production. Producers are being asked to increase production by 20% in one year. They are implementing projects to increase productivity to an average of 7 tons per hectare (from 5 tons) in some large-scale fields and increase the number of cropping seasons. The government has introduced a new initiative to increase rice production and income for rice farmers, with the planting of rice five times in two years, aimed at increasing productivity and bringing the national rice self-sufficiency rate to 80% by 2030 (currently at 70%).







According to the Philippines Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), South Korea announced on September 8 that it would allow the import of Hass avocados from the Philippines, following the release of the Official Notice 2023-33 of the South Korean Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs on the import approval process for tropical fruits. Fresh Hass avocados from the Philippines to be exported to South Korea are expected to be harvested and packed by Dole Philippines in Davao, Bukidnon, and South Cotabato.



Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023











According to trade data from Sumatra, Indonesia, Robusta coffee exports from Sumatra in July 2023 fell 10.26% from the same month last year, reaching 252,226 bags. In the first four months of the 2023/24 crop year (from April 2023 to March 2024), export volume fell by 144,271 bags, or 14.54% from last year. The decline was due to falling Robusta coffee prices and lower demand.


The new coffee crop in Indonesia is still providing domestic coffee to meet the rising demand. The estimated production for the 2023/24 coffee year is 10.3 million bags (of which about 8.8 million bags will be Robusta coffee and 1.5 million bags will be Arabica coffee), slightly lower than the average production in the past three years (11.8 million bags).


Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023




Changes in percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023






Structure of exports by products to the ASEAN, Aug-2023








Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the ASEAN , Aug-2023

Cambodia's cashew exports to Vietnam fell sharply in the first 7 months of the year

In the first 7 months of 2023, Cambodia exported 587,160 tons of cashew nuts to Vietnam, down 14% in volume and 23% in value from the same period in 2022. The export turnover reached over USD 802.3 million.

Cambodia remains the largest supplier of cashew nuts to Vietnam, accounting for over 34% in volume and 38% in value in Vietnam's import structure.







Export value and volume to the ASEAN, Aug-2023






Percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023








TOP 5 enterprise by volume to the ASEAN, Aug-2023

In ASEAN, Vietnam is the largest buyer of pepper from Cambodia, accounting for about 70% of Cambodia's total pepper exports. However, despite many regional and bilateral free trade agreements, tariff barriers and plant quarantine issues remain.

The Kampot Pepper Promotion Association said demand for Kampot pepper remains strong, especially from buyers in the European market. However, the high costs of maintaining pepper plantations have forced some farmers to quit, reducing the number of association members from 460 households to just over 350 households... By the end of August 2023, Cambodia's Kampot pepper exports reached about 62 tons, a slight increase over the same period in 2022. The Kampot Pepper Promotion Association (KPPA) expects this number to reach more than 100 tons in 2023. Recently, a company purchased 26 tons of Kampot pepper from farmers and requested import documents. Therefore, Kampot pepper exports could reach about 90 tons in September and more than 100 tons as expected by the end of 2023.

Despite the El Nino phenomenon threatening agricultural production in Southeast Asia, the Kampot Pepper Promotion Association still affirms that this does not affect the cultivation and productivity of Kampot pepper trees. The total area of Kampot pepper in Cambodia is about 24,000 hectares. This year's Kampot pepper harvest has ended.






Export volume and value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023




Changes in the percentage of export value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023










TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the ASEAN, Aug-2023

According to the Malaysian Department of Statistics, the amount of natural rubber exported in July 2023 decreased by 3.7% over the same period to 51,785 tons, an increase of 6% over the previous month. Out of the total export, 42.8% went to China, followed by 9.5% to Germany, 4.4% to Pakistan, 3.3% to the United States, and 2.2% to Brazil.

In the first eight months of 2023, Thailand exported 2.99 million tons of natural and mixed rubber, down
8.5% over the same period last year. Thailand exported natural rubber, reaching 1.759 million tons, down
23% over the same period the previous year.

In the Chinese market, from January to August, Thailand's export volume of natural rubber and mixed rubber reached 1.887 million tons, up 13% over the same period last year. Natural rubber exports to China alone reached 666,000 tons, down 3% over the same period the previous year.


According to the General Department of Customs of Cambodia, from January to August 2023, Cambodia's export value of rubber and rubber products reached 479.396 million USD. In August 2023, Cambodia's rubber export value reached more than 94 million USD, an increase of 139% over the same period in 2022. Cambodia's main rubber export markets are Vietnam, Malaysia, China, and Singapore, Japan, S.Korea, and the European Union.






Change in percentage of export to the ASEAN, Aug-2023









Skipjack tuna prices fall in Thailand.

In August, the average price of frozen whole skipjack tuna delivered in Bangkok was 1,900 USD/ton, which was lower than the previous price of 2,050 USD/ton. In September 2023, the price of raw skipjack tuna is expected to decrease by about 150 USD USD/ton compared to the August price. Meanwhile, in Manta, Ecuador, the cost of tuna delivered on board is still higher than in Bangkok, at 1,900 - 1,950 USD/ton.

Indonesia asked Japan to remove the export tax on canned fish

The Indonesian Ministry of Trade has asked Japan to remove four tax rates on Indonesian canned tuna products as part of the Protocol amending the economic cooperation agreement between Japan and Indonesia. The Indonesian Minister of Trade said that this move was necessary to complete negotiations and was optimistic that both countries would sign the expected protocol at Thursday's ASEAN-Japan 50th Anniversary Summit in Tokyo in December 2023.








Structure of export value by-products to the ASEAN, Aug-2023




Structure of import value by products the ASEAN, Aug-2023

The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has signed a \$43 million financing agreement to enhance livestock health in Cambodia. COMMENTS AND REVIEW

RICE

According to GLE Logistics Company, the opportunity to export rice from now until the end of the year is still tremendous as countries are still increasing rice imports for reserve. In particular, rice production in Malaysia still needs to import up to 30% to ensure domestic consumption and reserve requirements.



COFFEE

According to the Vietnam Coffee-Cocoa Association (VICOFA), Vietnam's coffee output in the 2023 - 2024 crop year is expected to reach about 30 million tons, an increase of 2% compared to the previous crop year. Of which, Robusta coffee output is expected to reach about 26 million tons, an increase of 2.5%, and Arabica coffee output is expected to reach about 4 million tons, an increase of 1.5%.

Coffee exports to the ASEAN market are expected to increase again from November when Vietnam enters the coffee harvest of the 2023 - 2024 crop year (in the fourth quarter of 2023 and the beginning of the first quarter of 2024).



SEAFOOD

According to Vasep, the ASEAN market continues to progress in the last months of the year. However, shrimp, one of the main products, has a sharp decline compared to the beginning of the year and the same period last year, showing that businesses need to continue to improve their ability to compete with cheap shrimp from Ecuador and India.
