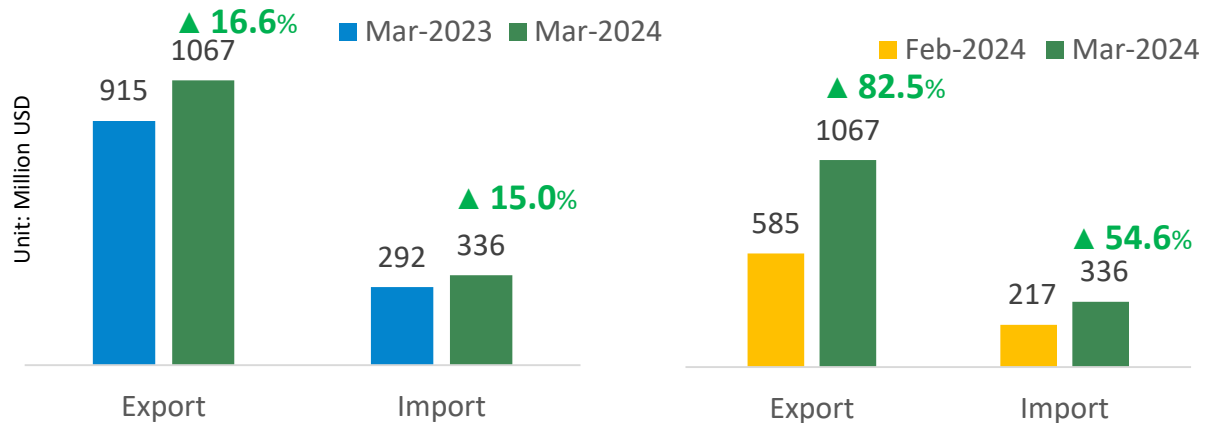

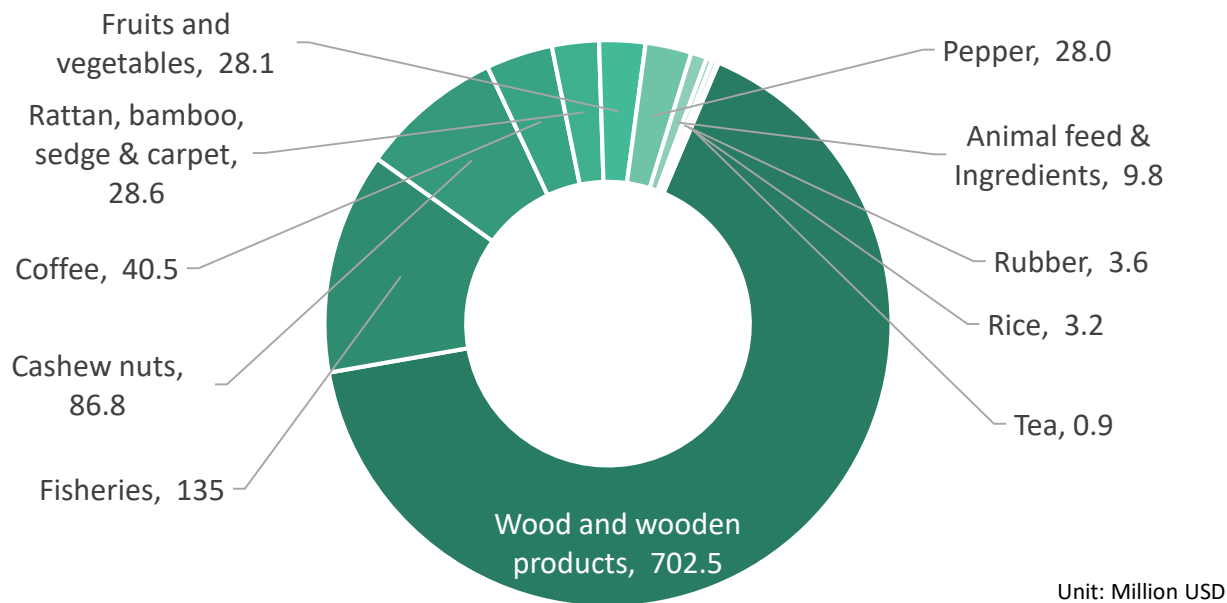

AFF product import-export turnover between Viet Nam and the U.S., Mar-2024



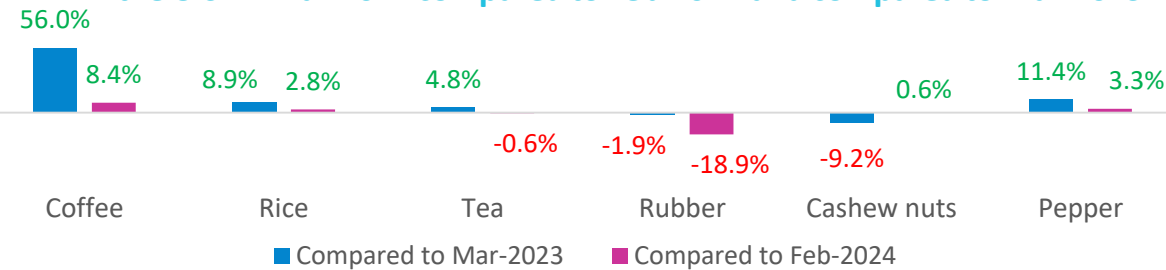
Key AFF product export value to the U.S., Mar-2024

Launching Fertilizer Right Project launched in Viet Nam for proper fertilization

On April 9th, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, in coordination with the US Department of Agriculture, inaugurates the Fertilizer Right Project. The MARD's Plant Protection Department is the project's owner while the Philippines-based International Rice Research Institute

(IRRI) is in charge of implementation.

This project will help improve the efficiency and effectiveness of fertilizer use, increase income for farmers, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions in rice farming thanks to using fertilizer correctly. The project will be executed over four years starting this year in three provinces in the Hong (Red) River Delta in northern Viet Nam, namely Hai Duong, Thai

Binh, and Nam Dinh, and three others in the Mekong Delta region, including Can Tho, Dong Thap, and Soc Trang.

Recently, Viet Nam also had a successful business exporting entire wooden houses to the United States. Specifically, 30 of these wooden houses have been successfully exported to the United States. This initial success opens up many

opportunities for businesses to have more export orders. To do this, the business must expand the factory to 12 hectares to store goods and research each product line suitable for each time.

This year, the wood industry reset its target of 17.5 billion USD in the context of an improving market. Especially the US market - which accounts for more than half of the turnover, is showing signs of

recovery and has a strong increase in orders.

coastal city of Miami, Florida (USA).

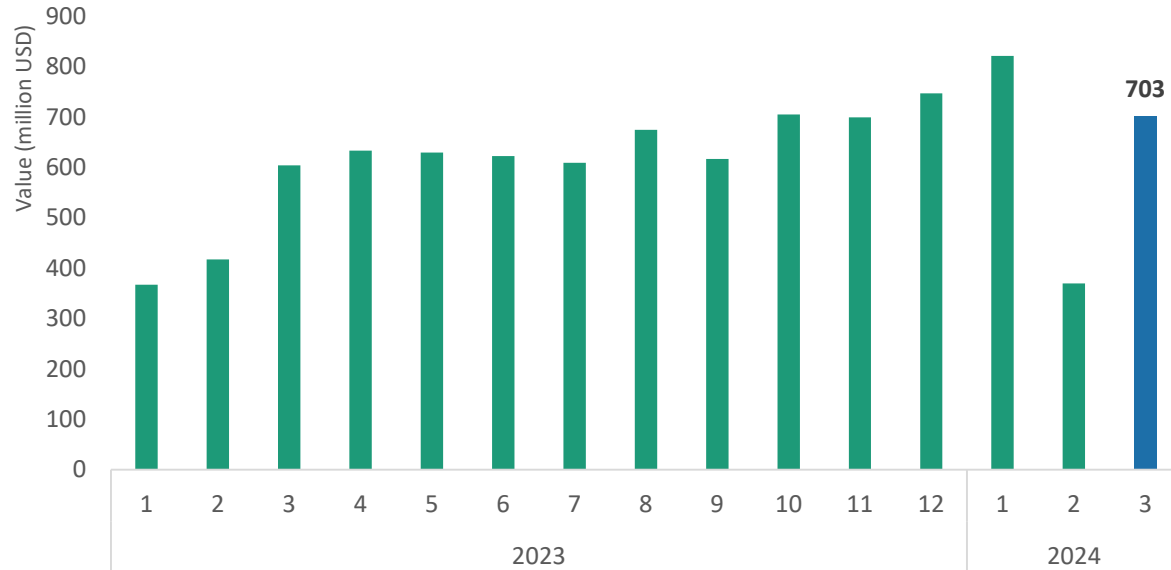

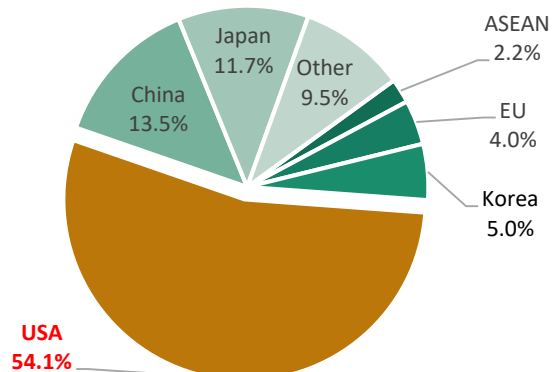

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



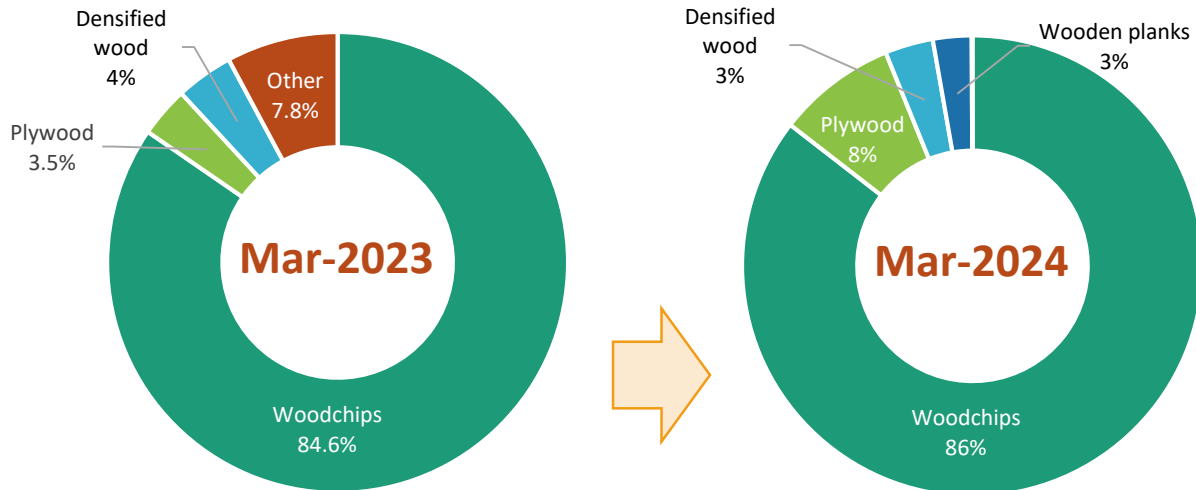
Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024

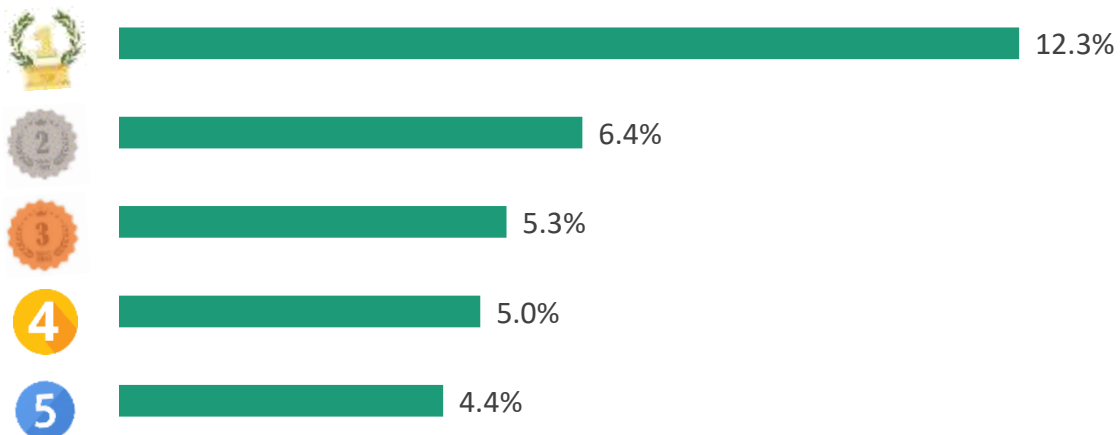

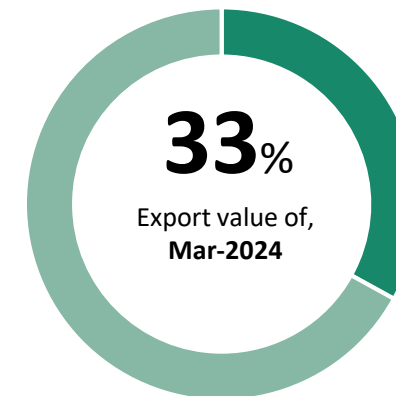

In February 2024, US plywood imports are estimated to reach 195,963 m³, which is a 32% decrease from the previous month and a 51% increase from the same period last year. Imports from Viet Nam and Malaysia in the first 2 months of 2024 increased by 198% and 187% respectively over the same period last year.

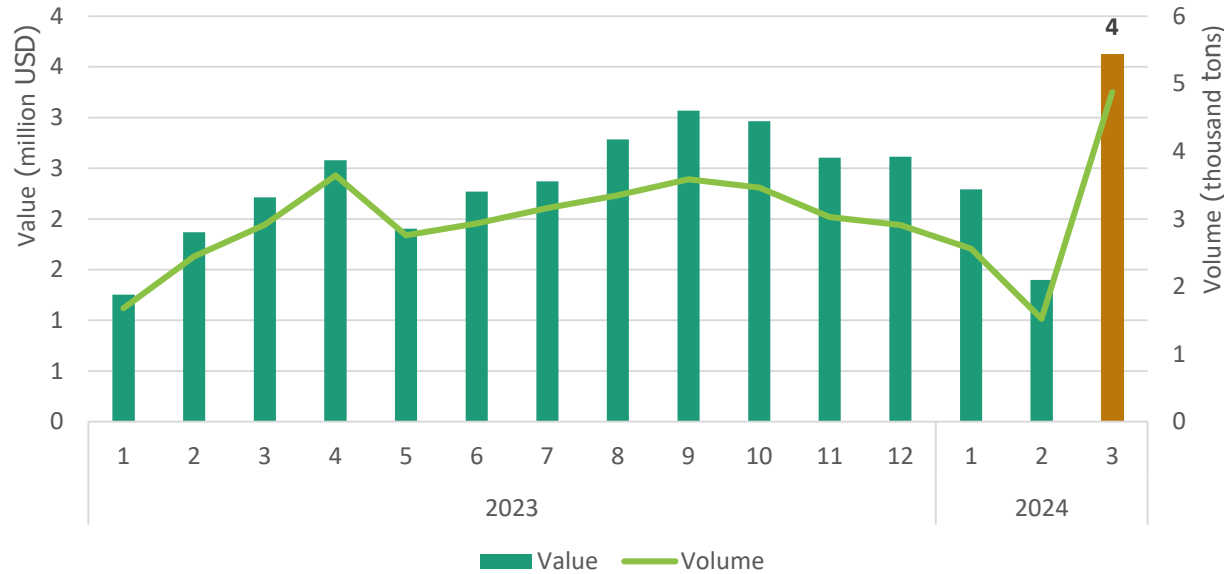
US imports of tropical lumber in February 2024 are estimated to reach 16,266 m³, up 1% over the previous month and up 24% over the same period last year. In particular, imports from the Brazilian market, currently the main supply market for the United States, increased sharply compared to the previous month.

US imports of interior and exterior wooden furniture in February 2024 are estimated to reach 1.745 billion USD, up 1% over the previous month and up 20% over the same period last year. Imports from Viet Nam, Malaysia and Mexico increased by 12%, 10% and 10% respectively over the previous month.

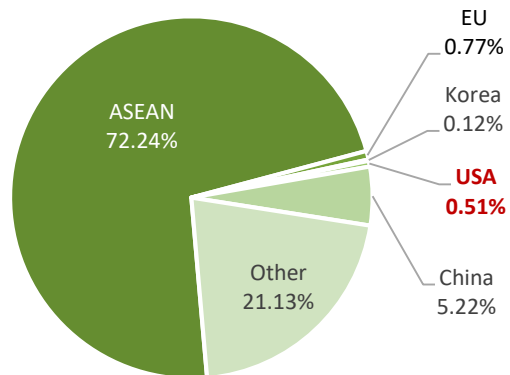

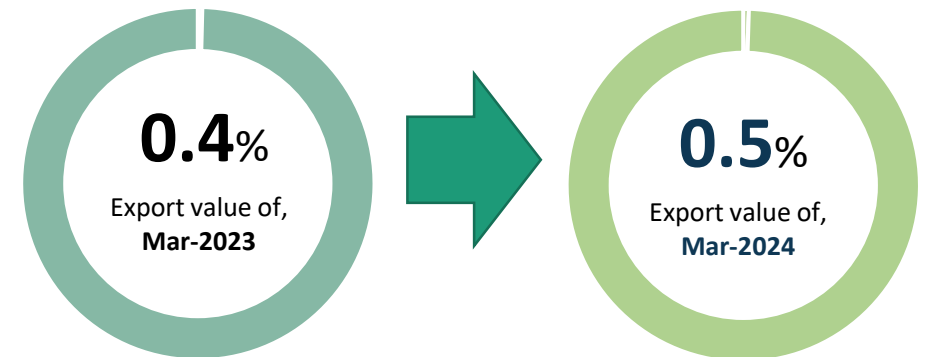

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



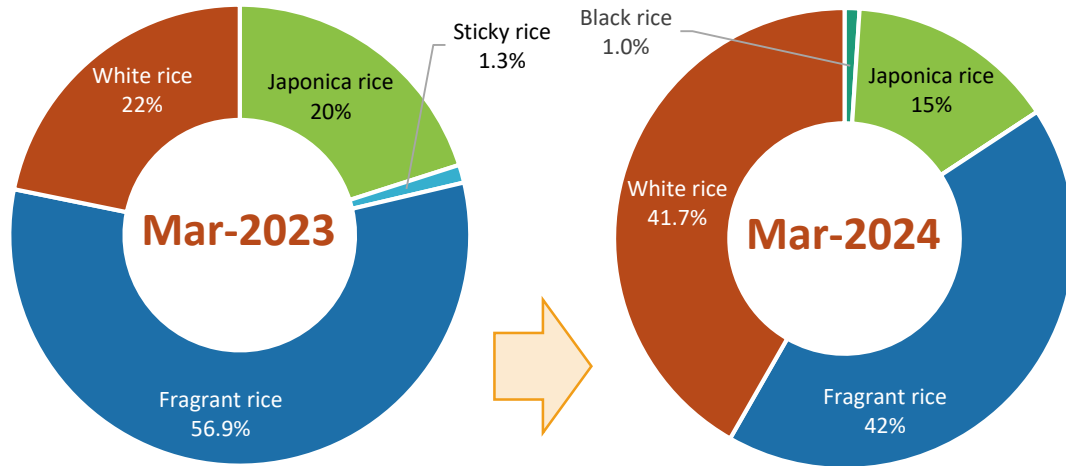

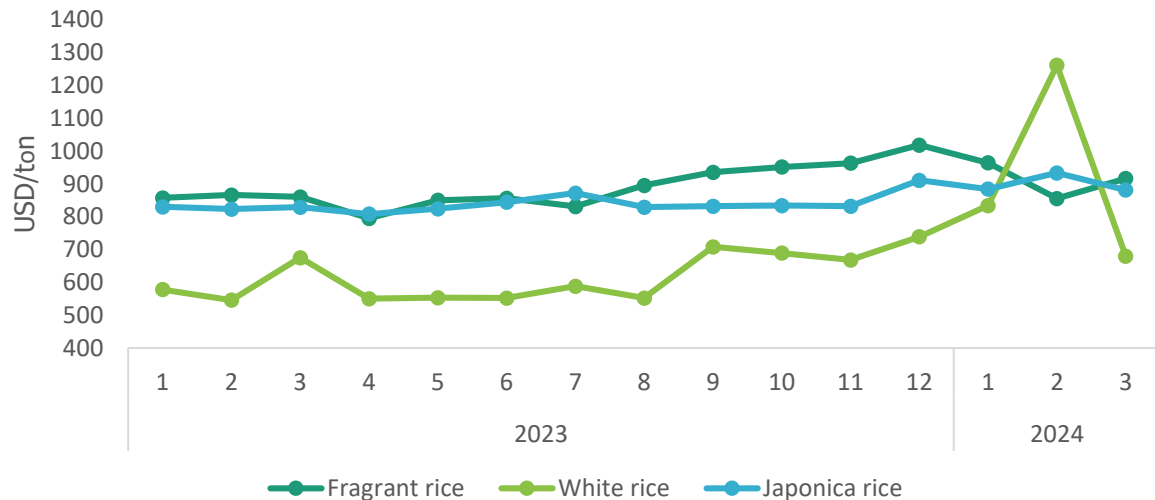

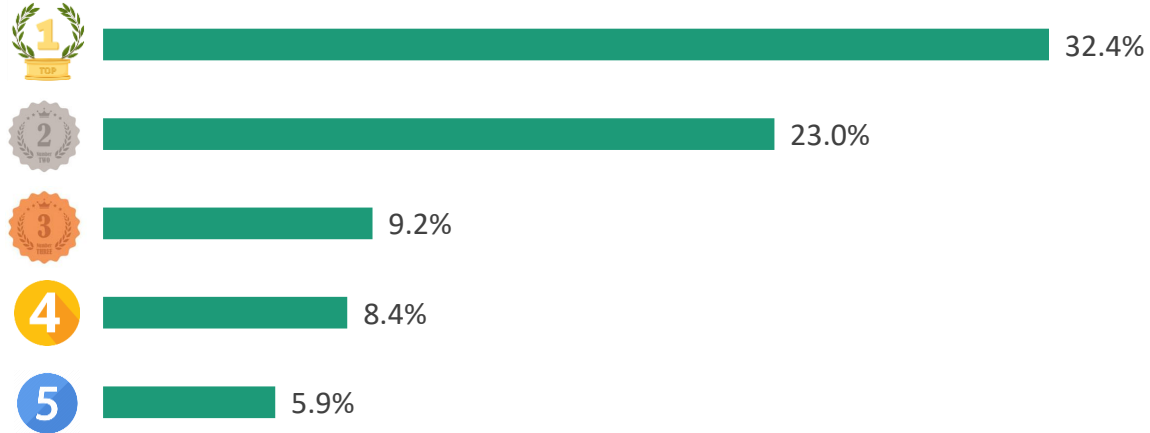

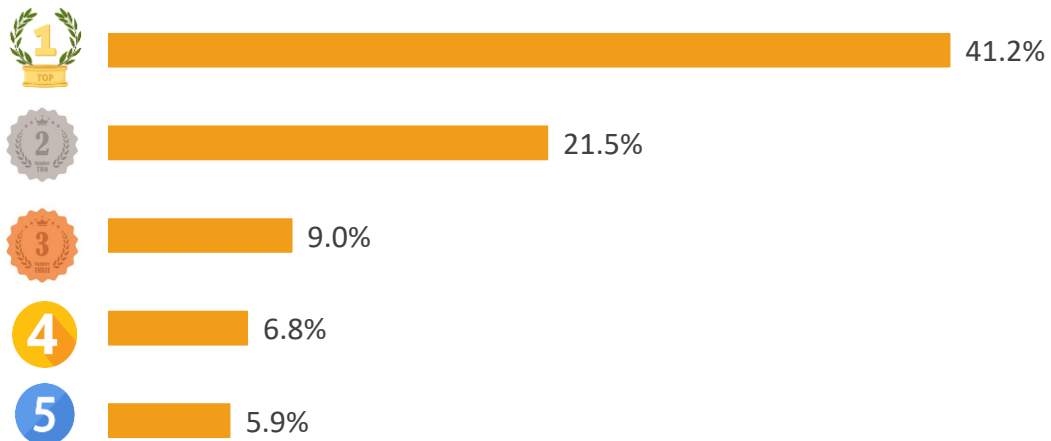
TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Mar-2024



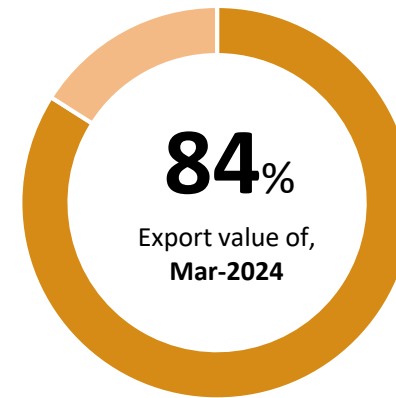
Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Mar-2024



TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to the U.S., Mar-2024



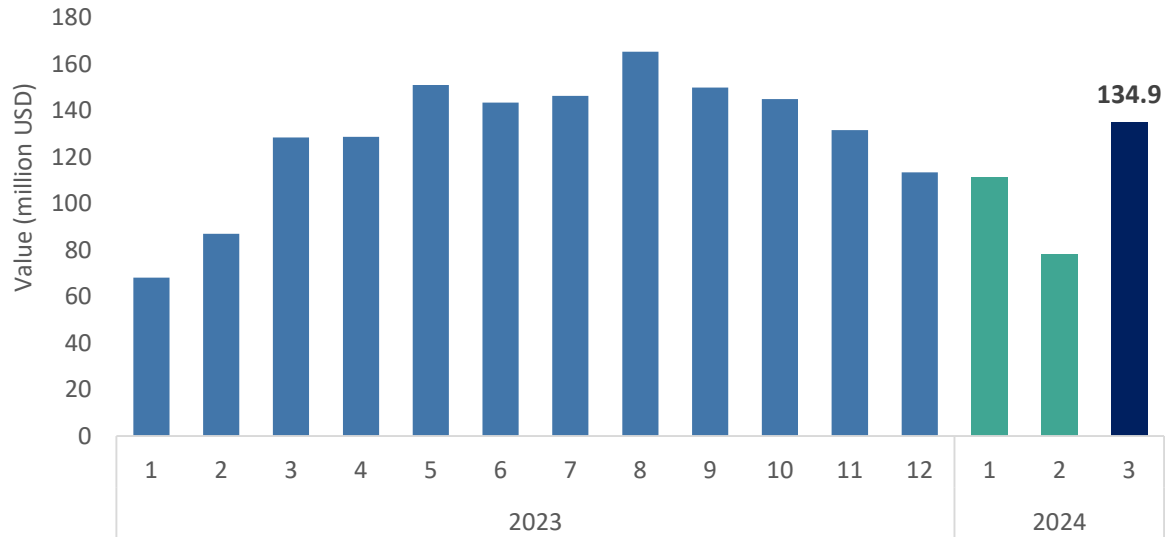
Volume ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Mar-2024





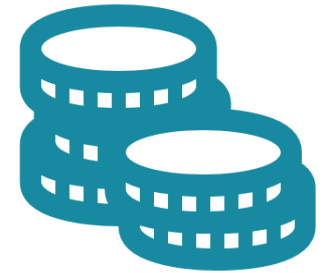

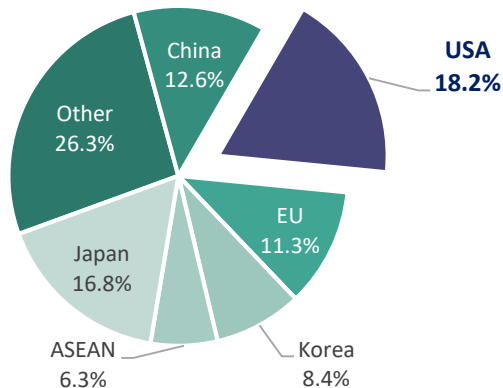

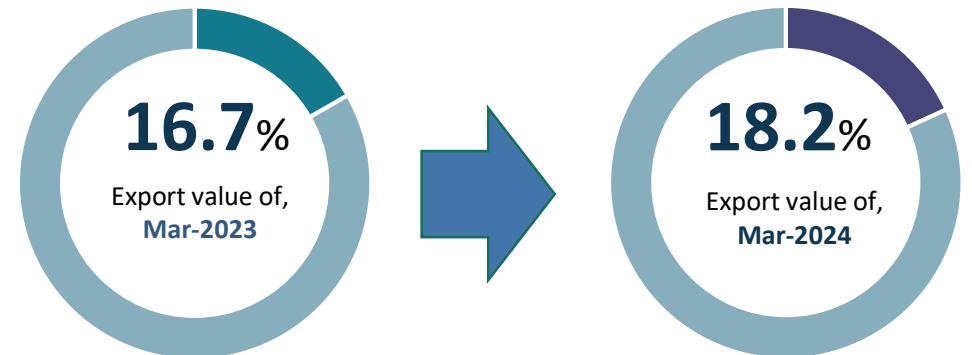

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



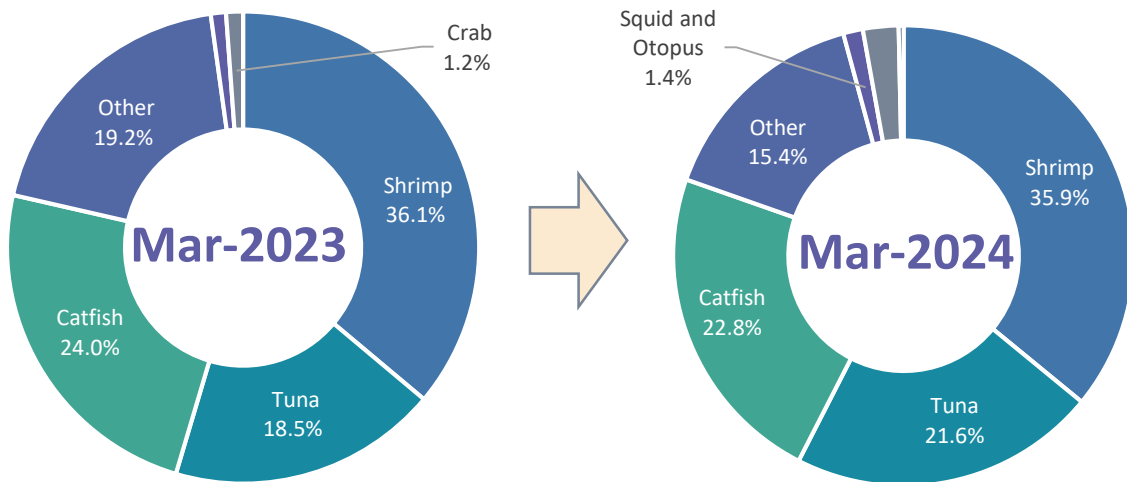
Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



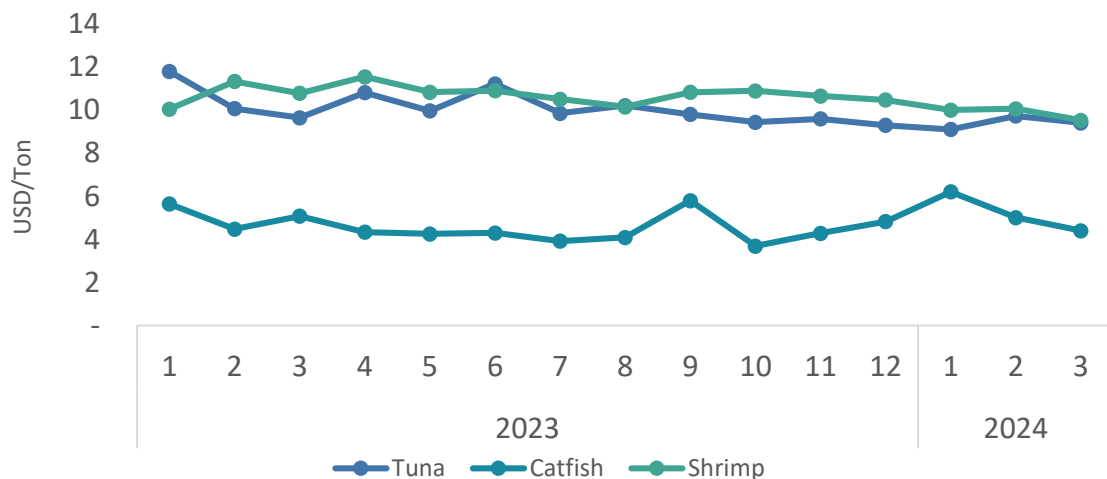

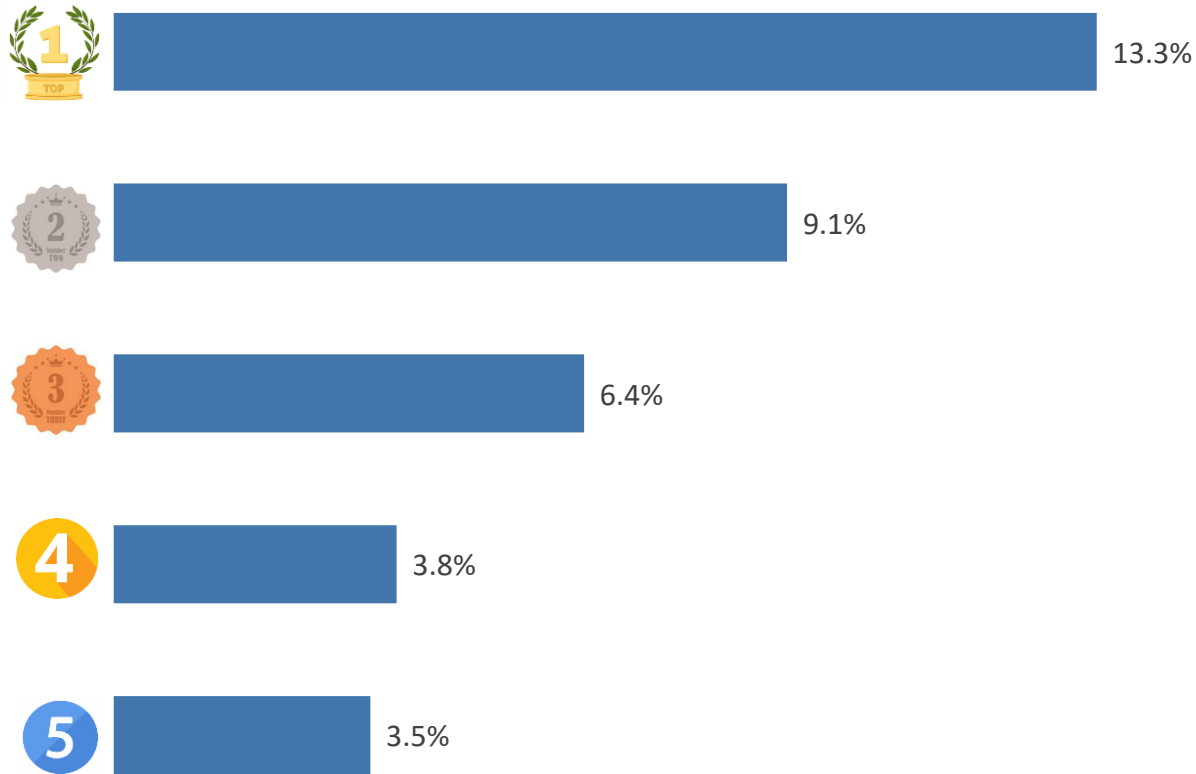

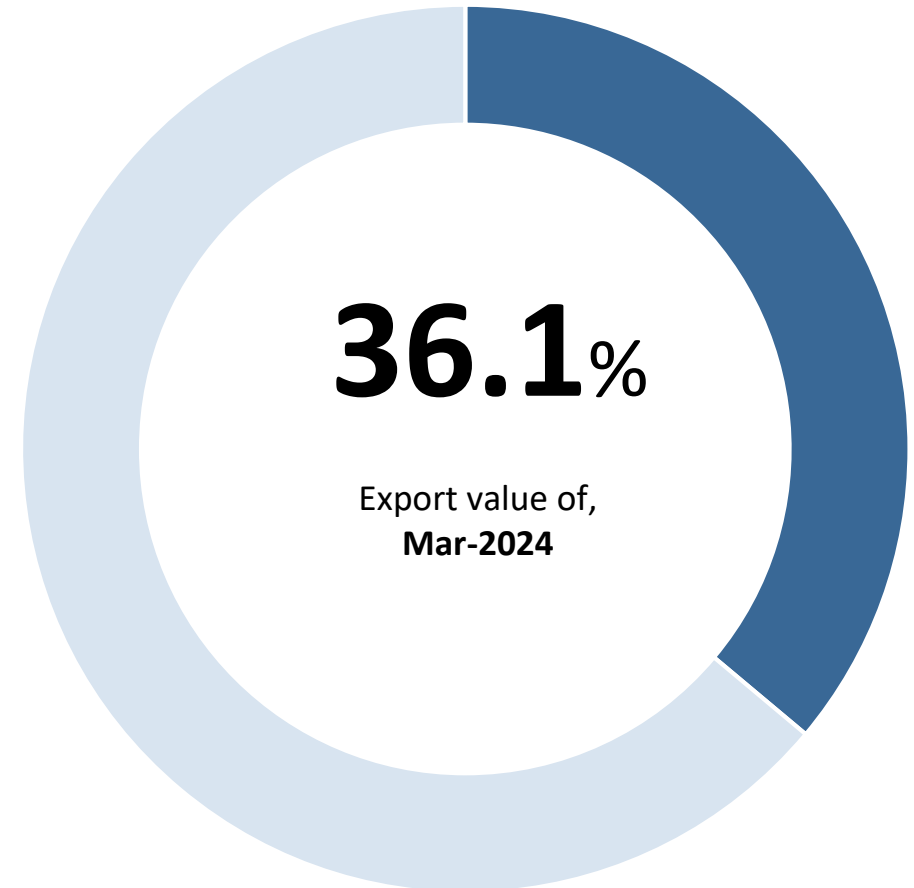

USDA forecasts seafood prices to decrease by 1.7% by 2024

According to the 2024 food price forecast recently released by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), inflation in the United States is forecast to be milder in most categories, with food prices overall expected to increase by 2.5%. % but the price of fish and other seafood will decrease. Specifically, according to USDA, the price of fish and other seafood is forecast to decrease by 1.7% in 2024, after increasing by 5.4% in 2021, increasing by 9.1% in 2022 and increasing by 0.3% in 2023.

The US increased shrimp imports

US shrimp imports continued to increase year-over-year, especially thanks to a surge from leading trading partners. The total import volume of March 2024 is about 63.29 thousand tons, down 7.76% compared to the same period in 2023. The top 5 largest shrimp exporting countries to the United States are India, Ecuador and Viet Nam. There was significant growth, in which India increased by 24.6%, Ecuador increased by 24.6% and Viet Nam increased by 39.0% in volume over the same period. In contrast, US shrimp imports from Indonesia decreased by 30% and Thailand decreased by 25.7%. On April 4, 2024, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announced that from the beginning of 2024 until now, 60 seafood shipments into the US have been refused. Among them were shrimp from Bangladesh and Thailand, which were rejected due to contamination with banned antibiotics.

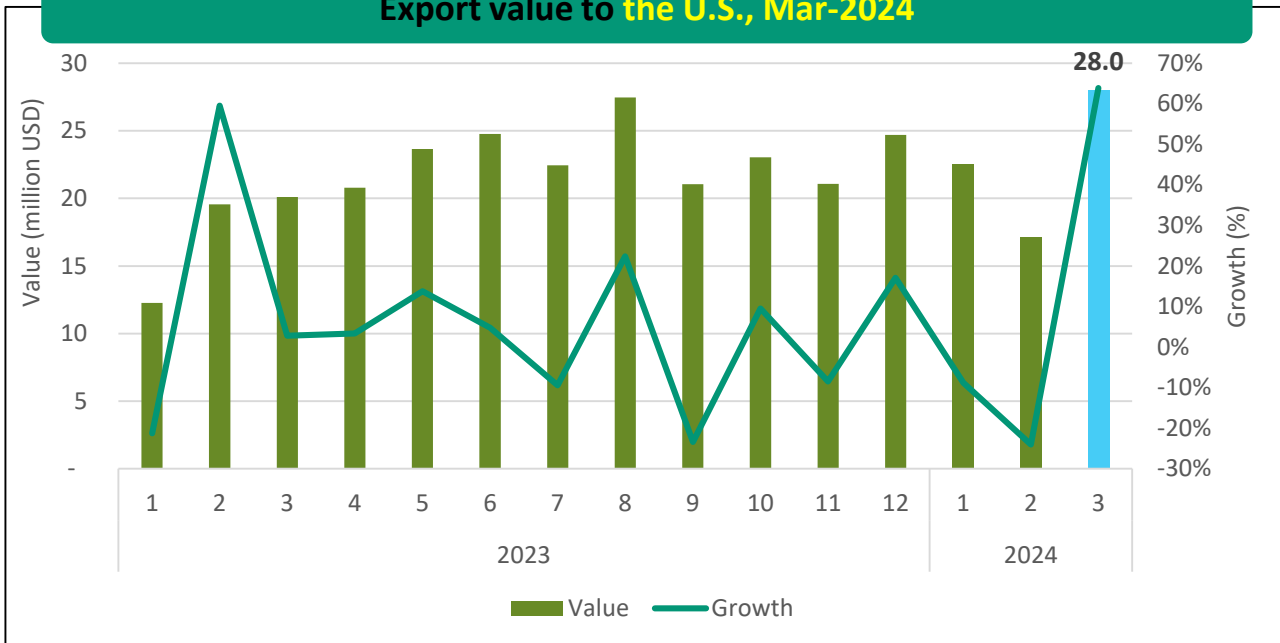

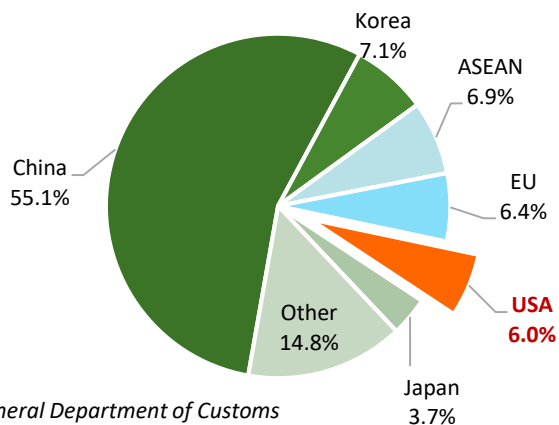

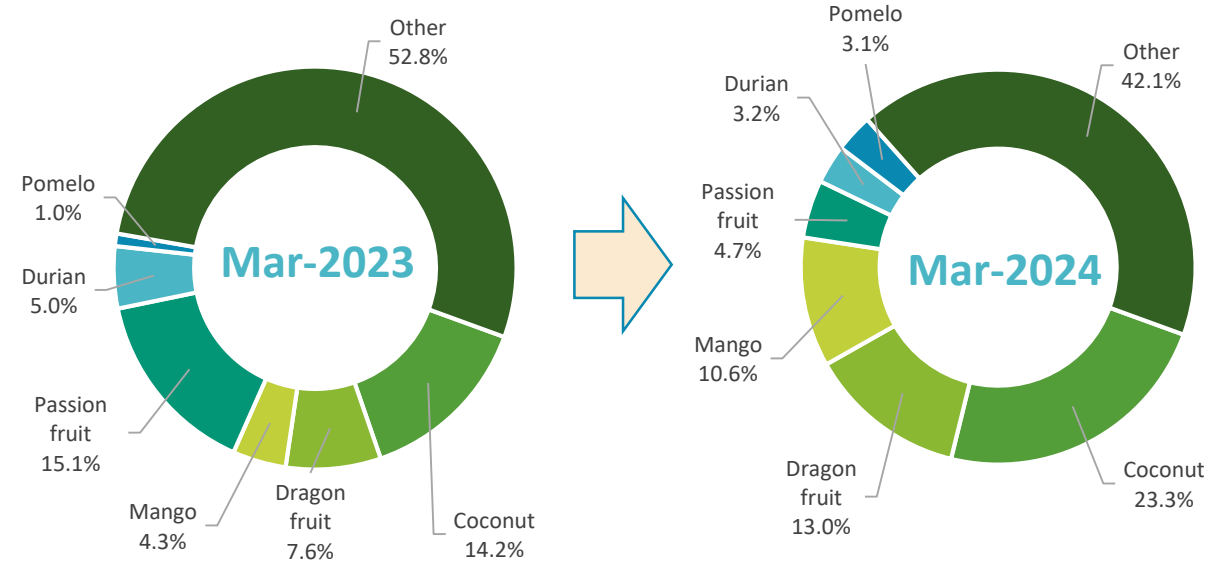


Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024

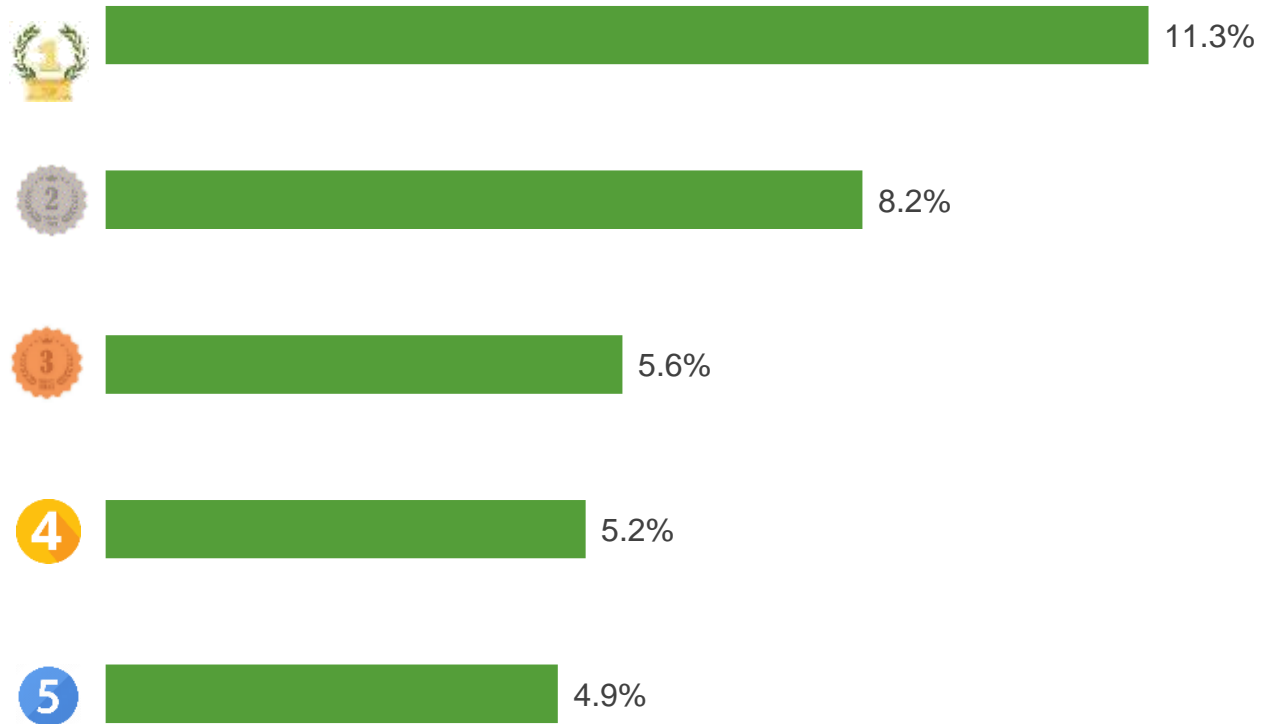

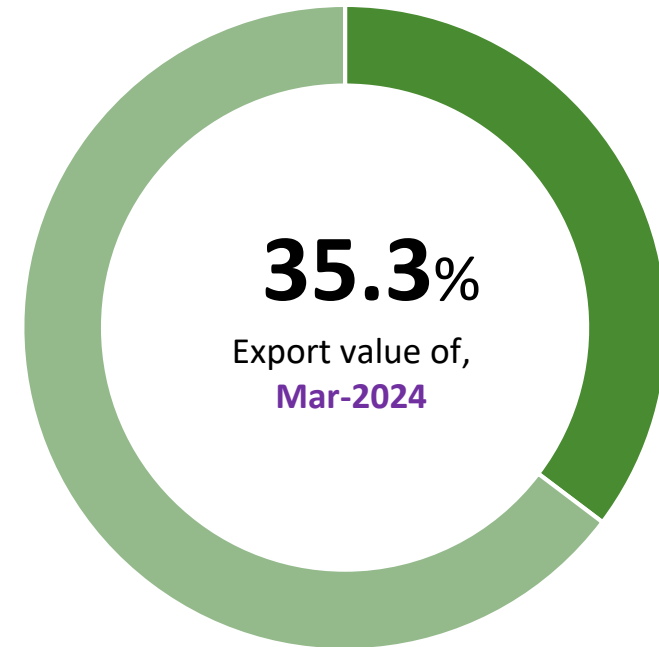

TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Mar-2024



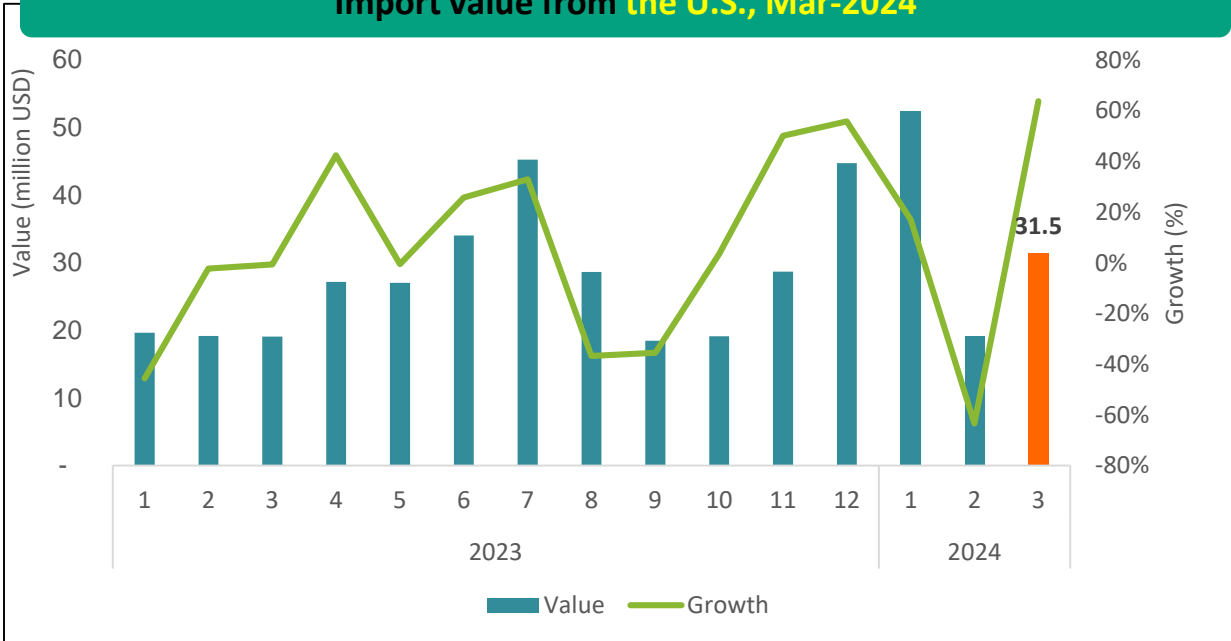

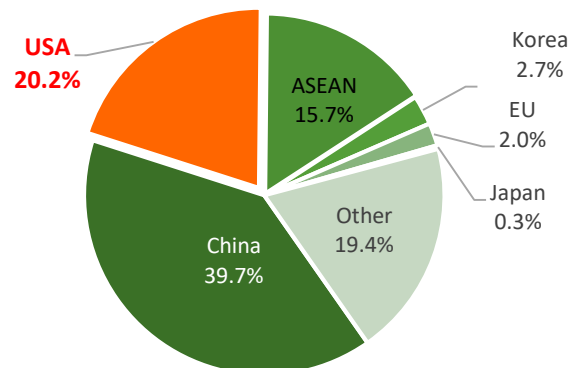

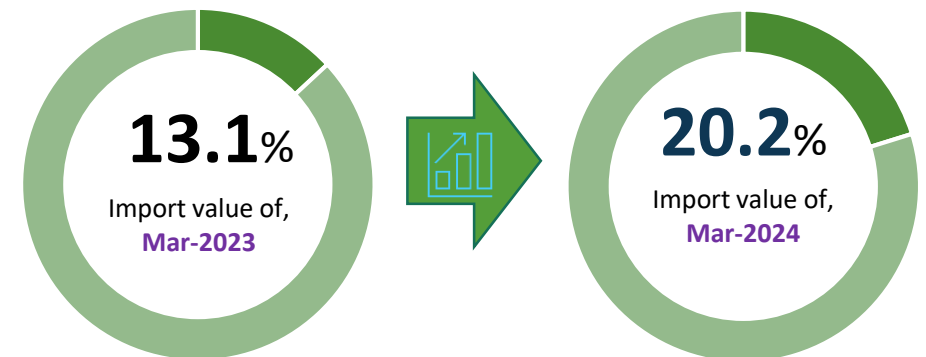

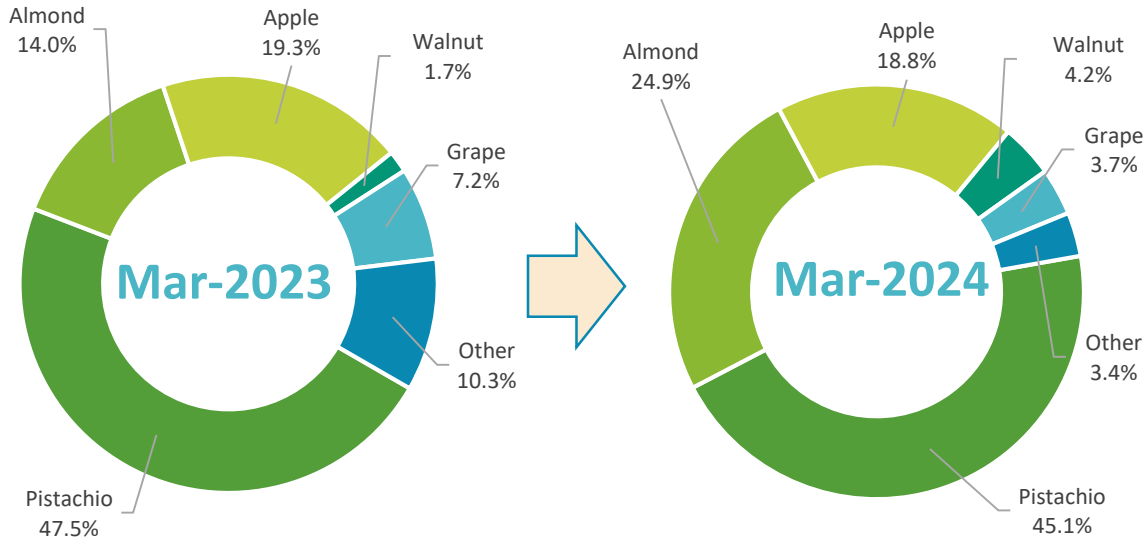


Changes in percentage of import value from the U.S., Mar-2024

According to the World Apple and Pear Association (WAPA), apple and pear inventories in the United States on March 1 reached 265,219 tons and 36,433 tons, respectively, up 35% and 16.5% over the same period in 2023.

Apple inventories increased due to increases in some varieties such as Fuji (up 12.6%), Golden Delicious (up 42%) and Granny Smith (up 60.8%). The increase in pear stocks is due to the varieties Bosc (up 230.4%) and Red Anjou (up 24.9%).

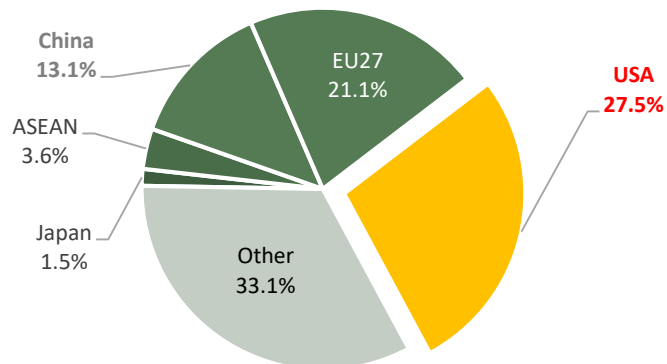

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



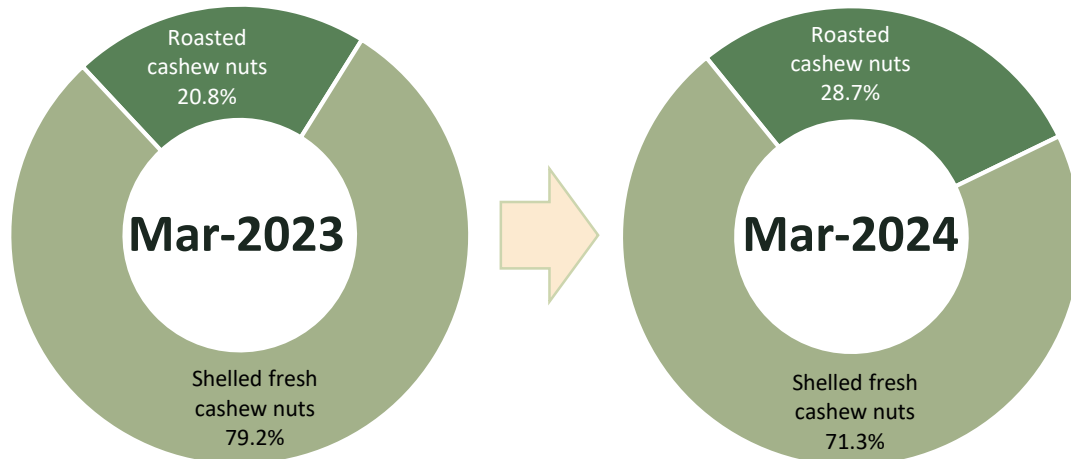

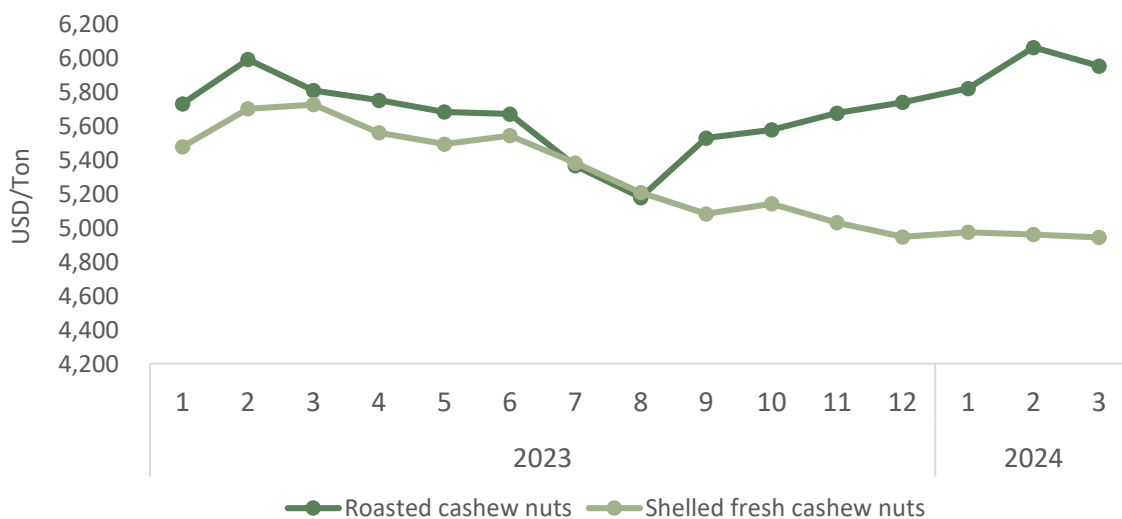

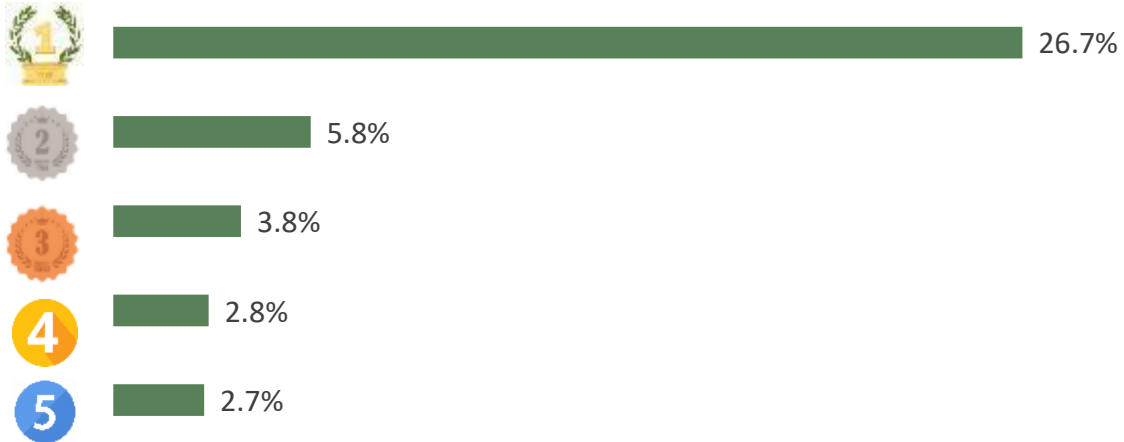

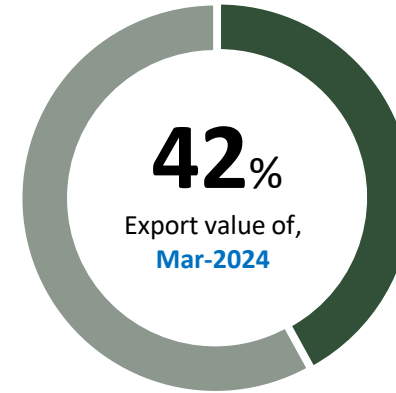

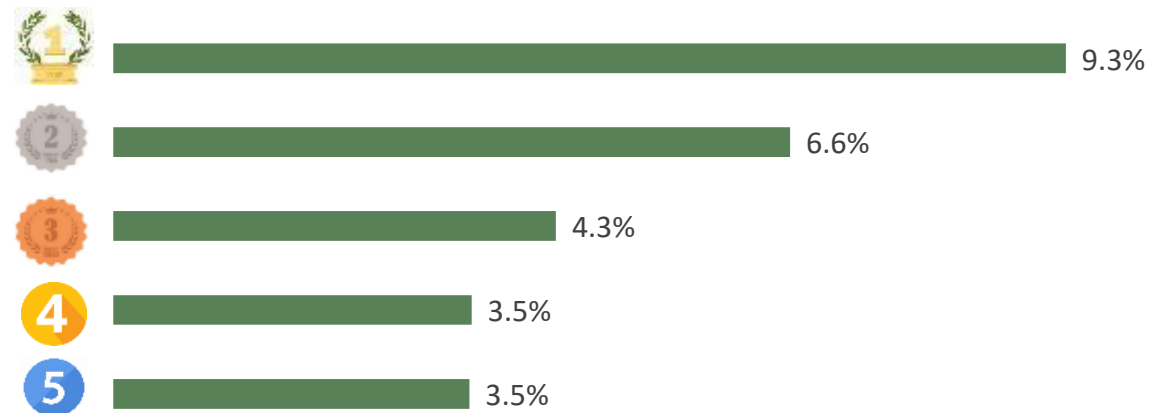
TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Mar-2024



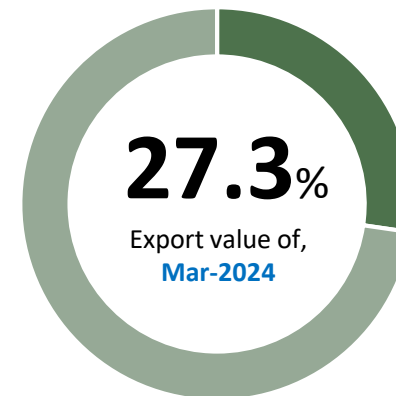
Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Mar-2024

SPOTLIGHTS

According to statistics from the US International Trade Commission, in the first 2 months of 2024, the US imported cashew nuts from the world reaching 24.3 thousand tons, worth 128.47 million USD, an increase of 16.2 % in volume and increased 6.9% in value compared to the same period last year. In particular, the United States increased imports of cashew nuts from Viet Nam and Benin, but decreased imports from Ivory Coast, Brazil and India.

The average import price of cashew nuts in the United States in the first 2 months of 2024 reached 5,287 USD/ton, down 8.0% over the same period last year. In particular, the average import price of cashew nuts in the United States decreased from most major suppliers, except Benin.

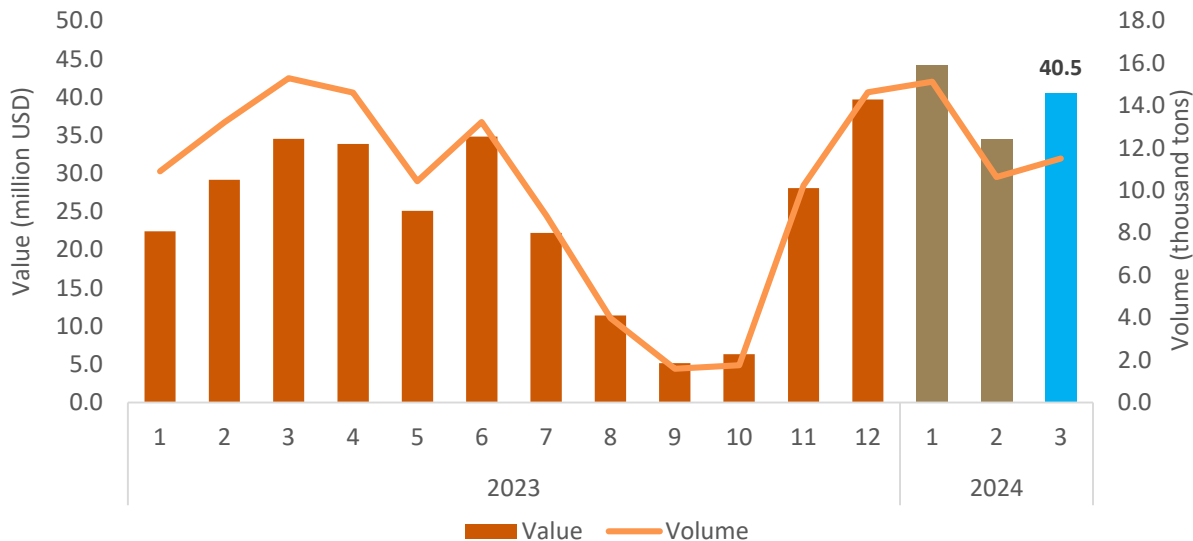

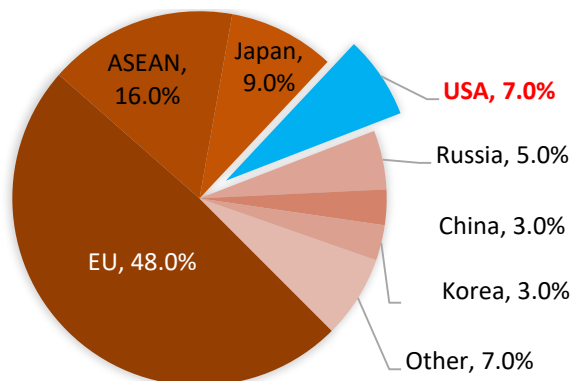

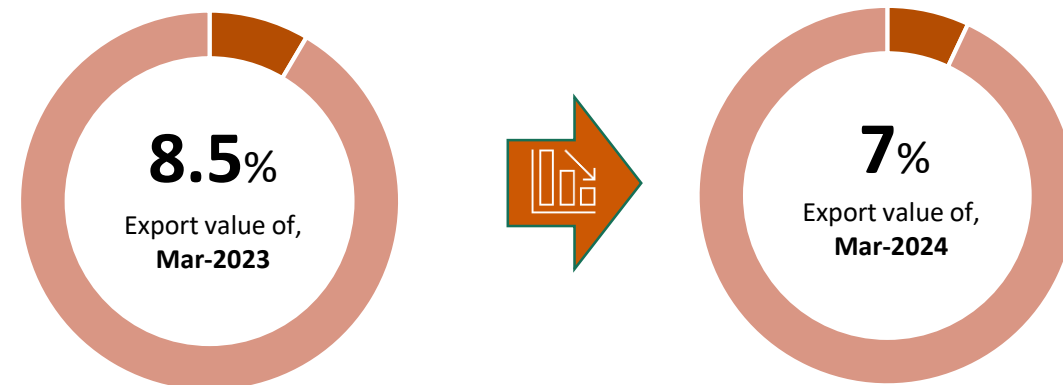

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024

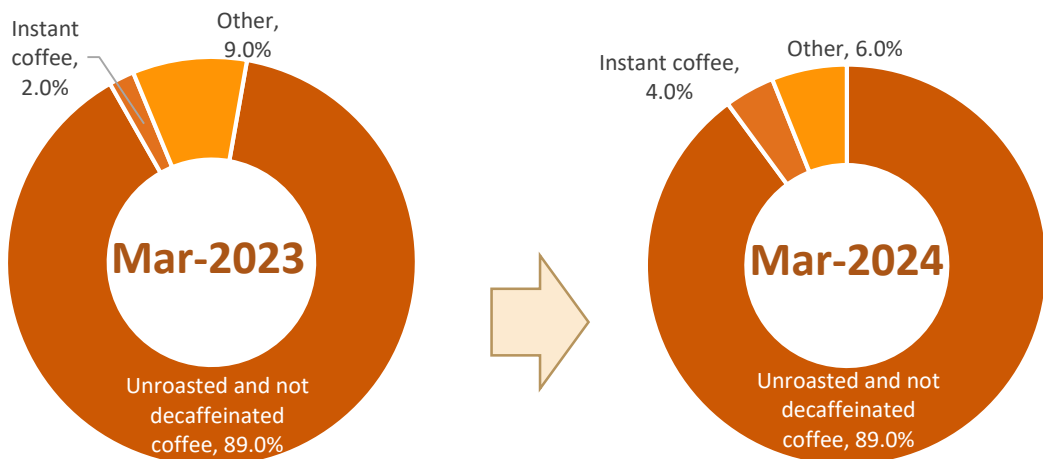


Changes in percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024

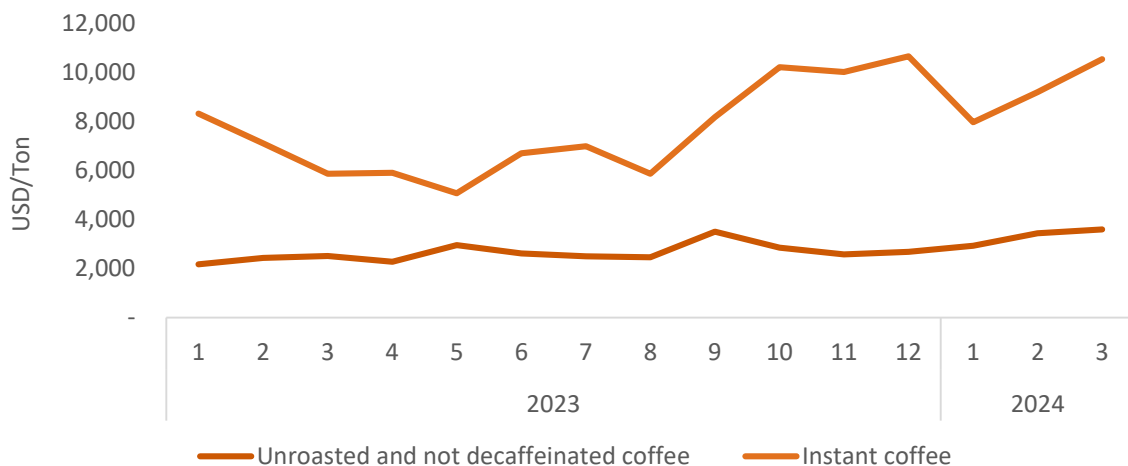

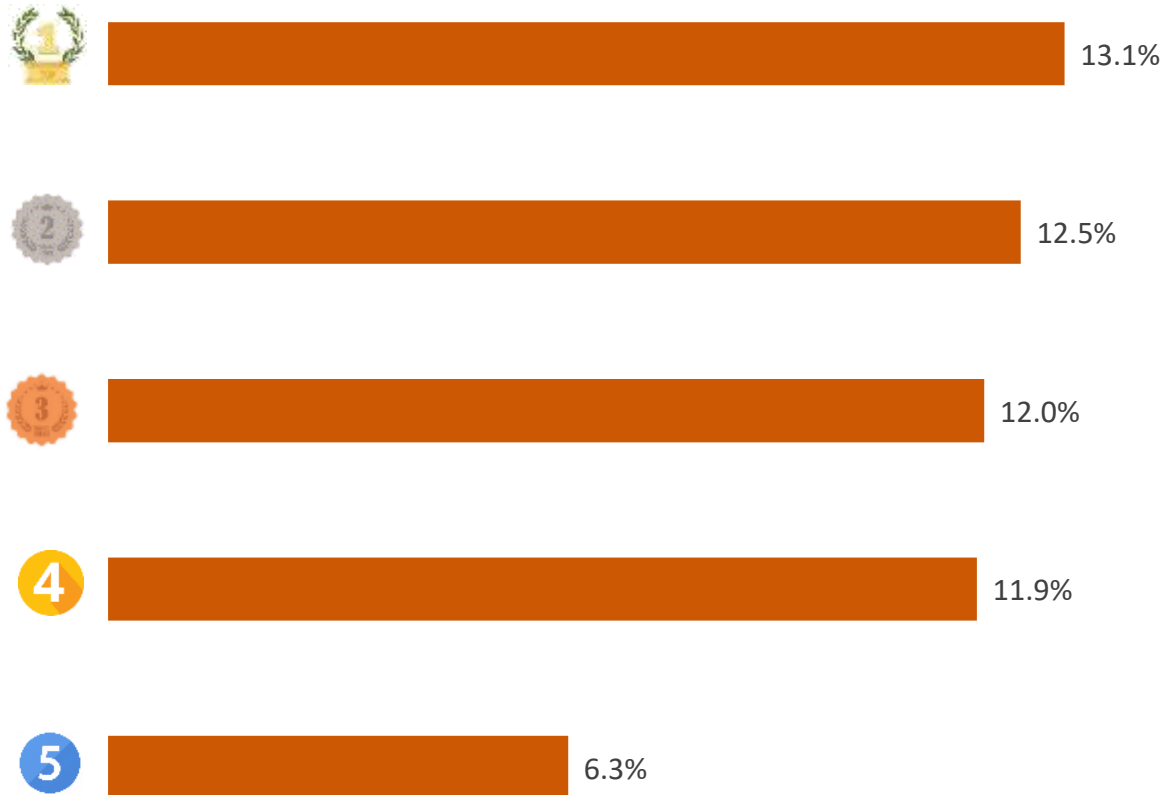

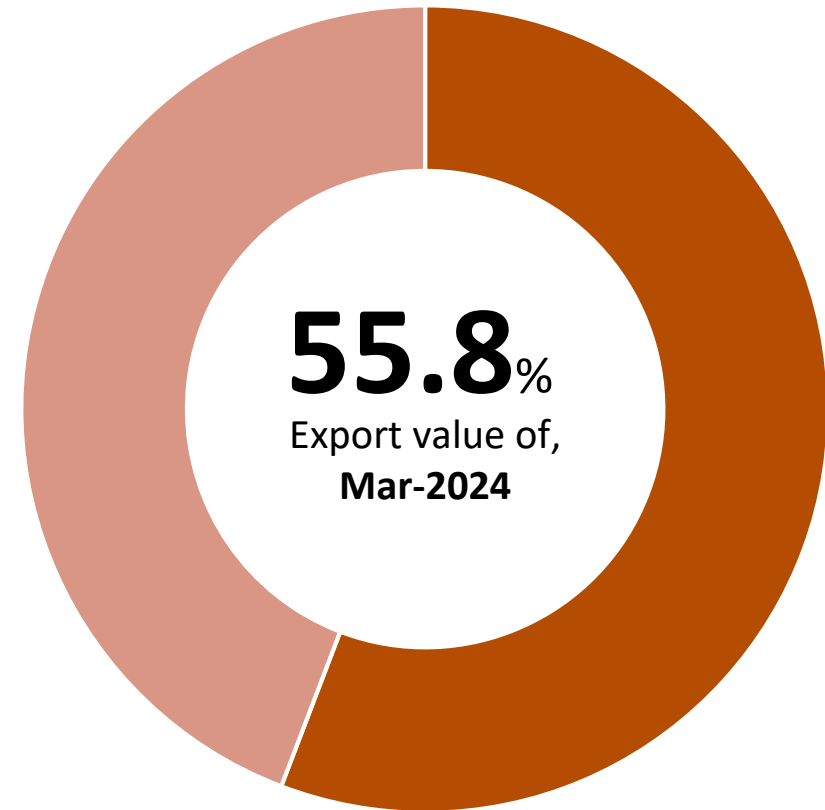

According to the US National Coffee Association, the coffee consumer market in the US has completely recovered. In 2023, US consumers spent an average of more than \$301 million per day on coffee and related goods. Daily coffee consumption by American adults reached its highest level in the last 20 years, accounting for about 67% (of people surveyed), an increase of 5% compared to 2020, and the average person uses 2.7 cups of coffee per day.

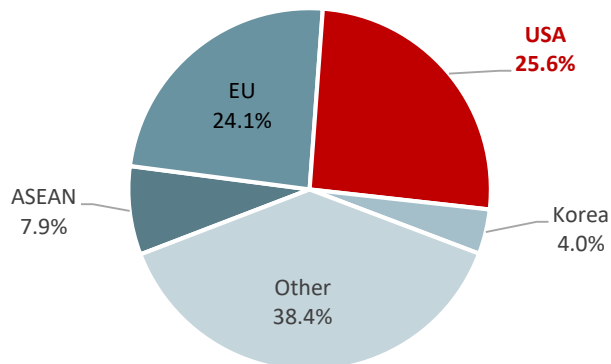

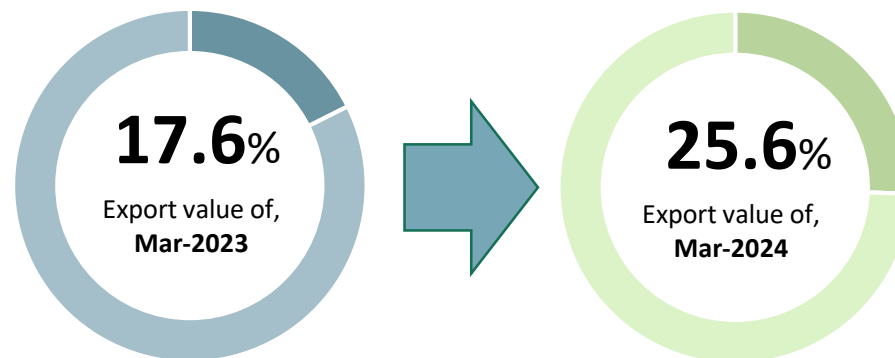

Percentage of export value to the U.S., Mar-2024



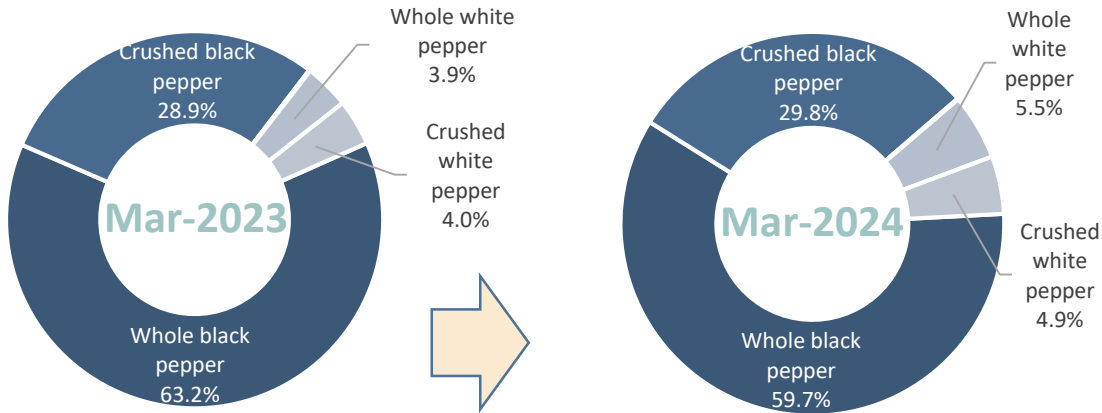

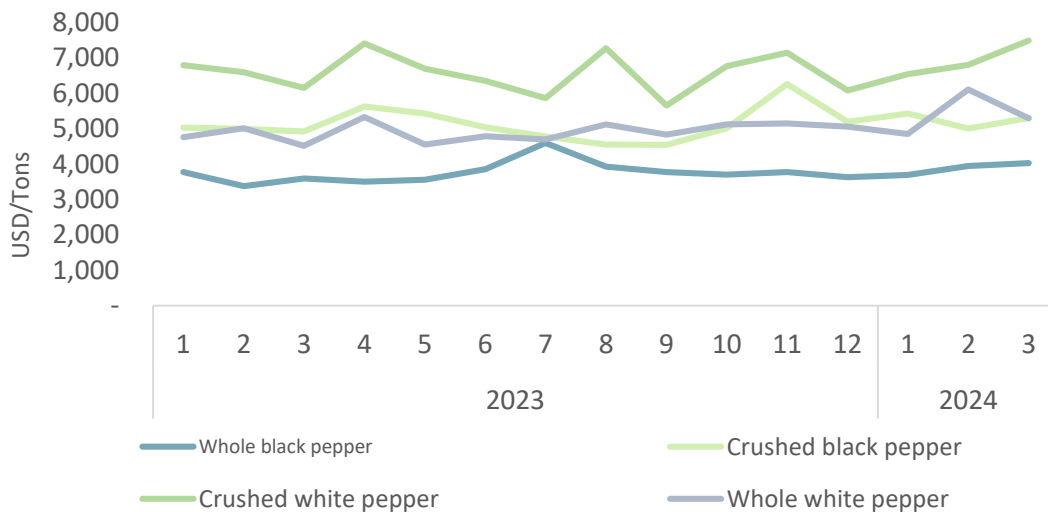

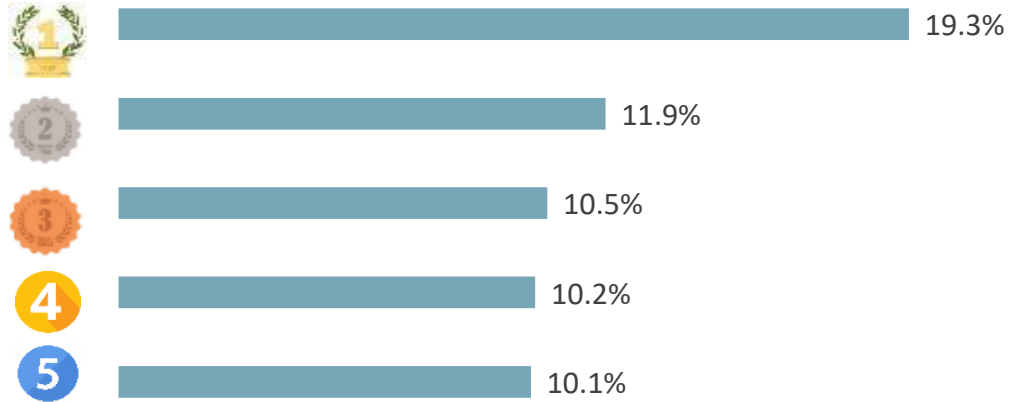

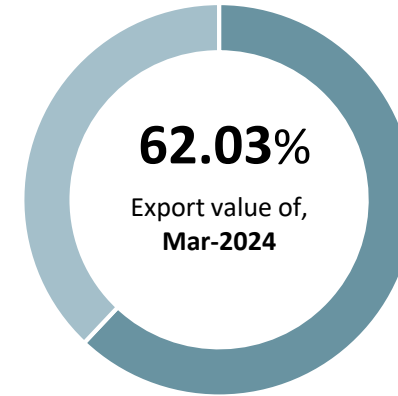

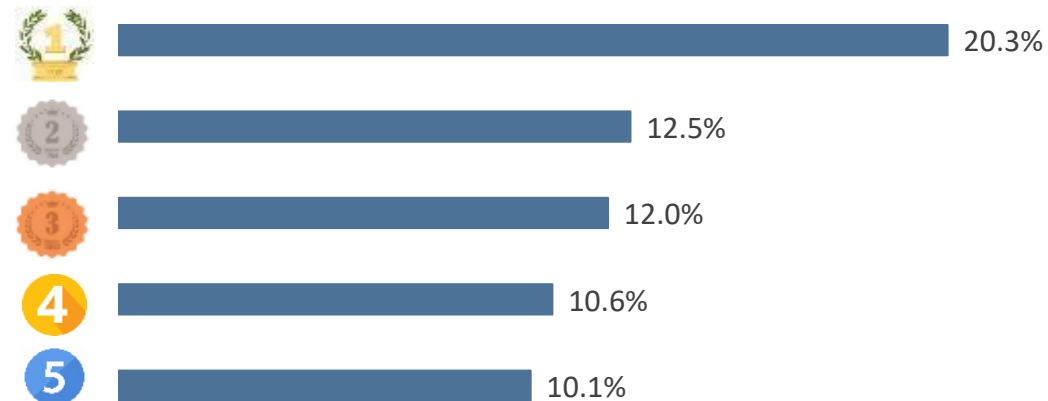
TOP 5 export enterprises by value to the U.S., Mar-2024



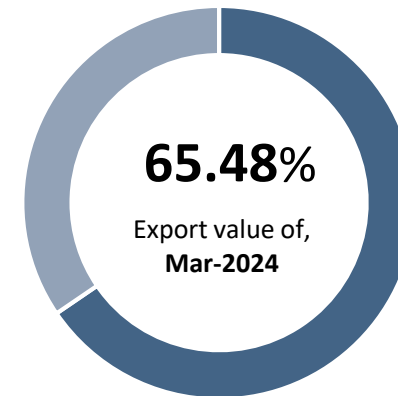
Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Mar-2024

SPOTLIGHTS



Pepper imports from the United States, the world's largest consumer market, are on the rise again after decreasing last year. Data from the United States International Trade Commission (USITC) shows that the country's pepper imports in February 2024 reached 6,917 tons, worth \$30.1 million, continuing to increase sharply by 40.7% in volume and 28.2% in value compared to the same period in 2023. Cumulatively in the first 2 months of 2024, US pepper imports reached 14,152 tons, worth more than \$66 million, an increase of 19.3% in volume and 13.8% in value compared to the same period last year.

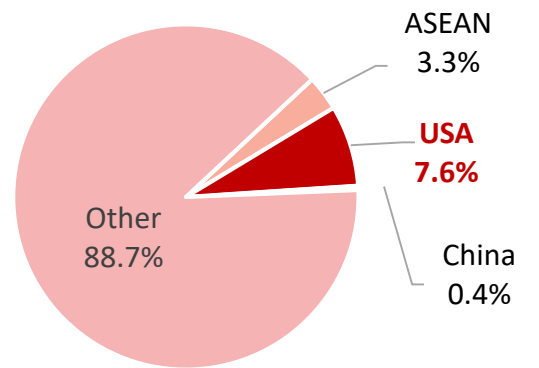

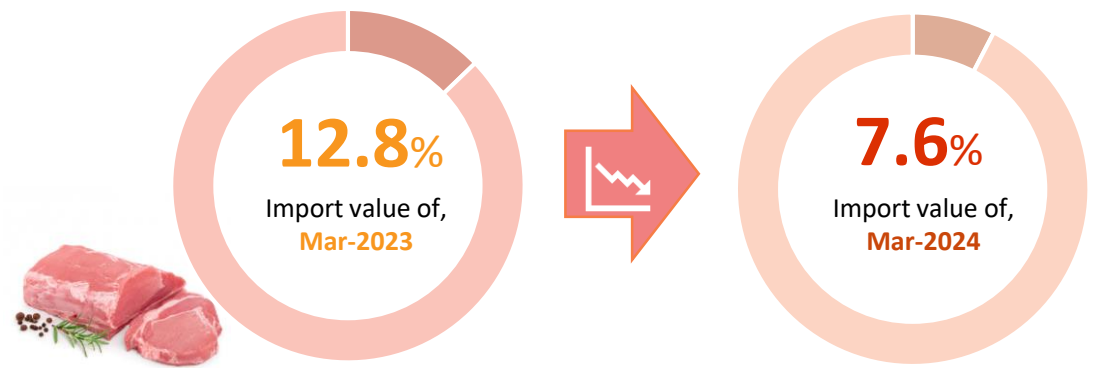

Changes in percentage of import value from the U.S., Mar-2024

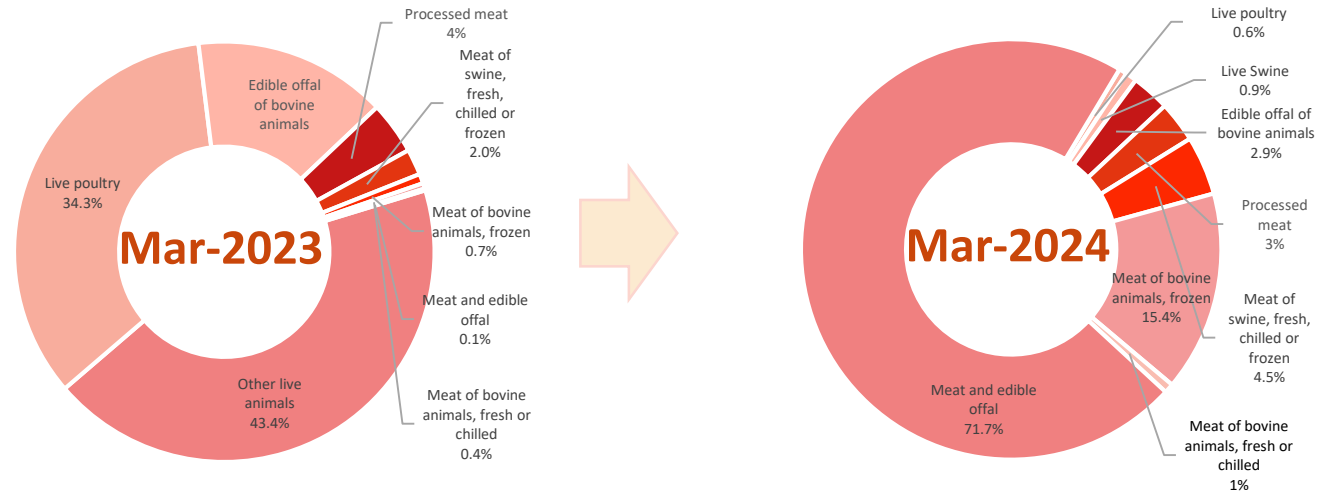

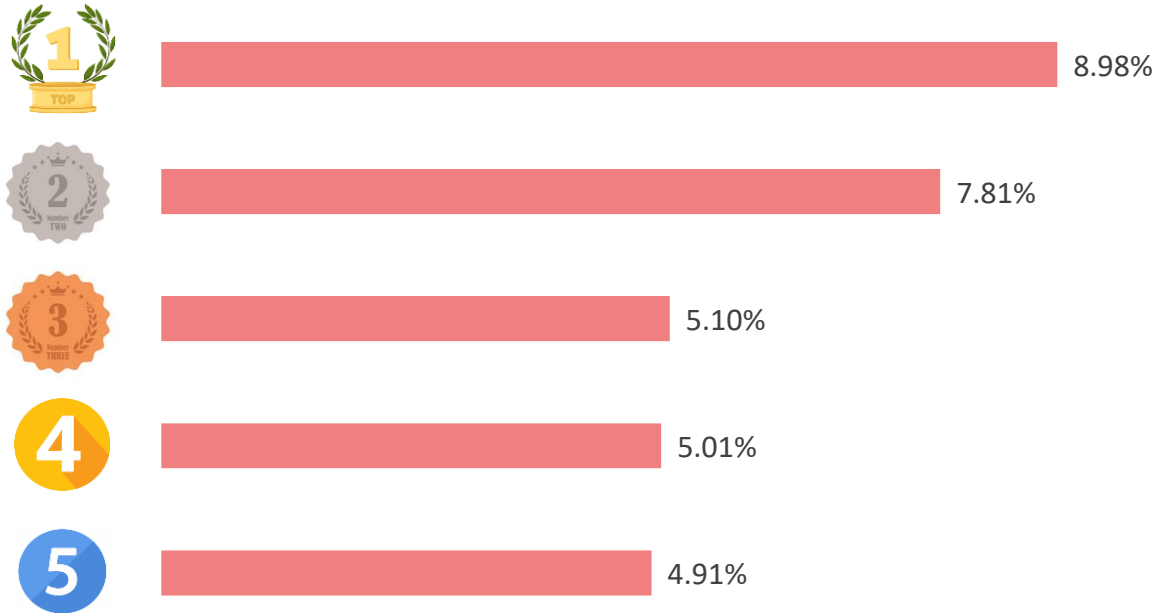

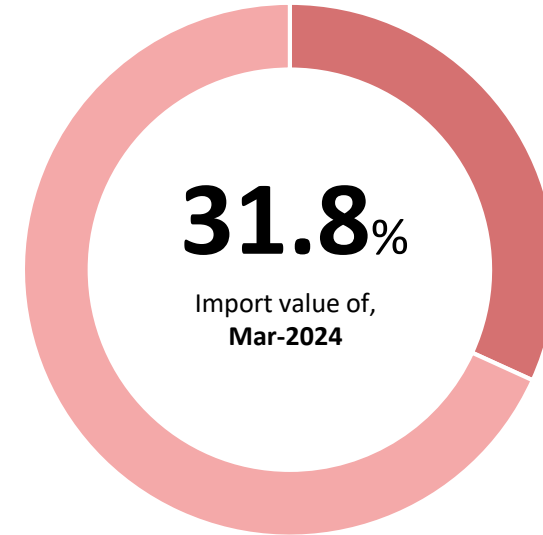

According to the US Department of Agriculture (USDA), as of March 1, 2024, the number of pigs on farms in the US reached 74.6 million heads. This marks a 1% increase compared to March 2023 but a 2% decrease compared to December 1, 2023. Of these, the majority are porkers, totaling 68.6 million, while the remaining 6.02 million are raised as breeders. From December 2023 to February 2024, 33.1 million pigs were weaned on US farms, reflecting a 2% increase over the same period last year. On average, each litter has 11.53 piglets weaned.

U.S. pig producers anticipate 2.92 million sows to farrow from March to May 2024 and 2.99 million sows to farrow from June to August 2024. Iowa leads in hog inventory among states with 25.2 million, followed by Minnesota with 9.10 million animals and North Carolina with 7.40 million animals.

By 2030, pork consumption in Latin America is expected to increase 14.2% compared to 2023, reaching 10.7 million tons.
