





#### AFF product import-export turnover between Vietnam and China, Apr-2024




### Key AFF product export value to China, Apr-2024

# China's Economic Update for April: Accelerated Production, Slowed Consumption

According to China's National Bureau of Statistics (NBS), industrial output in April increased by 6.7% over the same period last year, higher than 4.5% in March due to the recovery and acceleration in the manufacturing sector.

However, retail sales increased only 2.3% in April, slowing from the 3.1% increase in March. Fixed asset investment increased 4.2% in April.

China's exports and imports returned to growth in April and consumer prices rose for the third consecutive month.

However, new bank lending fell more

than expected in April, while broadbased credit growth hit a record low.

# The IMF suddenly raised its forecast for China's economic growth

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has forecast China's economic growth rate to reach 5% this year, from a forecast of 4.6% just a few weeks ago.

This outlook adjustment reflects the acceleration of the Chinese economy earlier this year and the government's new stimulus measures.

In a press release on May 29, the IMF raised China's gross domestic product (GDP) growth forecast for

2025 to 4.5% from 4.1% given in the previous forecast.









### Percentage of import value from China, Apr-2024





According to the Russian Federal Service for Animal Supervision and Plant Quarantine (Rosselkhoznadzor), China exported more than 30,000 tons of citrus fruits to Russia in the first 4 months of 2024, 10 times higher than the same period in 2023. That includes 9,900 tons of grapefruit, 14,700 tons of tangerines, 3,600 tons of lemons, 1,800 tons of oranges and 23 tons of peaches.

Loquat fruit from Hangzhou (China) is ripe and available on the market in early May 2024. After 2 consecutive years of reduced output, this year's loquat output is forecast to increase by 30% compared to previous years. . Son Tra grown in the greenhouse is harvested half a month earlier than Son Tra grown in the field (about May 15).



According to data from the General Administration of Customs of China, the export volume and value of major fruits such as apples, pears, and kiwis maintain growth in the first quarter of 2024. Specifically: fresh apple exports reached 233,300 tons, worth 267 million USD, up 23.9% and 10.33% respectively over the same period last year; Fresh pear exports reached 143,700 tons, worth 145 million USD, up 63.48% and 20.83% respectively; Fresh kiwi fruit exports reached 3,676.33 tons, worth 6.7949 million USD, up 97.4% and 139.86% respectively over the same period last year.

According to China News Service, at many durian growing facilities in the Yucai Ecological Area in Sanya, Hainan, durian fruits have grown well, reaching the size of a volleyball, and are expected to ripen and be brought to market. around mid to late June. Durian season in Hainan begins to ripen slowly from June to August, peaking in July.

In the first 3 months of 2024, China's import value of fruits and vegetables reached 6.6 billion USD, an increase of 5.85% over the same period in 2023. Of which, the import value from Vietnam accounted for 9.4 billion USD. %, an increase of 1.1 percentage points over the same period in 2023.



According to the Import-Export Department (Ministry of Industry and Trade), the demand for fruit and vegetable consumption in China is very large, but the import value from Vietnam is still low. The opportunity for the fruit and vegetable industry to increase market share in the Chinese market is still wide open. To promote exports to this market, Vietnamese fruit and vegetable businesses need to ensure and improve quality, strictly comply with regulations on quality and traceability.





### Percentage of export value to China, Apr-2024







According to the General Administration of Customs of China, China's roundwood imports in the first quarter of 2024 are estimated to reach 8.85 million m<sup>3</sup> with a value of 1.503 billion USD, down 5% in volume and 6% in value over the same period. last year. The average price of imported logs is 170 USD/m<sup>3</sup>, down 2% over the same period in 2023.


New Zealand is still China's largest roundwood supply market in the first quarter of 2024. China's roundwood imports from New Zealand are estimated to reach 4.29 million m³ with a value of 552 million USD, an increase of 12% in volume and value over the same period in 2023. The average price of imported roundwood from New Zealand in level of 129 USD/m³, down 2% over the same period in 2023.










### Structure of export value by products to China, Apr-2024


In April 2024, China imported 357.1 thousand tons of dried cassava chips worth 93.4 million USD, showing a decrease of 36.96% in volume and 40.61% in value compared to the same period last year. From January to April 2024, China's imports of dried cassava chips totaled 1.09 thousand tons valued at 286 million USD, reflecting a decline of 64.6% in volume and 66.03% in value compared to the same period last year. Notably, Thailand supplied 76% (down 69% from last year) of the imported dried cassava chips, while Vietnam accounted for 22.35% (down 34% from last year).

in April 2024, China's cassava starch imports totaled 368.8 thousand tons valued at 201 million USD, marking an increase of 98.02% in volume and 118% in value compared to the same period last year.


In the first four months of 2024, China imported a total of 1.37 million tons of cassava starch valued at 737 million USD, representing a 14.15% increase in volume and a 31.73% increase in value compared to the same period last year. Notably, Thailand accounted for 46.26% of the imports (a decrease of 4.95% from the previous year), Vietnam accounted for 38.84% (a decrease of 22.8%), and Cambodia accounted for 2.76% (an increase of 70.9%).










### Structure of exports by products to China, Apr-2024





### China's shrimp imports continue to decrease

According to China Customs, in April 2024, the total amount of shrimp imports reached 64,575 tons, worth 322.7 million USD, down 24% in volume and 25% in value compared to April 2023. Ecuador accounted for 73% of imports with about 47,075 tons, down 7% over the same period last year.

In the first 4 months of this year, China imported 289,737 tons, worth 1.39 billion USD, down 5.1% and 18% respectively over the same period last year.

Wholesale whiteleg shrimp prices have been trending up at the end of May, according to Huacai Zhaoyu, a Beijing-based seafood exchange. The average price of a 12kg box of medium-sized Ecuadorian shrimp increased to 450 yuan (\$63.44) on May 22, up 10 yuan from early May.

### China completely bans Japanese seafood

Since August 2023, China has suspended seafood imports from Japan citing "safety issues" related to Tokyo's discharge of treated radioactive water from the Fukushima nuclear power plant. 1 to the sea. However, the validity of seafood export registration licenses of processing and preservation facilities is still valid until the end of April 2024. By May 2024, Chinese customs authorities disabled the seafood export registration licenses of all Japanese processing and preservation facilities. This means that without a registration license, Japanese seafood products will not be able to export to the Chinese market.

Currently, Beijing has not given any explanation as to the reason for suspending this registration license. Recently, the Chinese side continues to use the phrase "nuclear contaminated water" to describe Japan's waste discharge and there is no sign that Beijing has changed its stance on Japanese seafood products. Tokyo, despite many bilateral meetings between officials of the two countries, has still not been able to come to a solution to this issue.







### **TOP 5 export enterprises by value to China, Apr-2024**




### TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to China, Apr-2024















According to the General Administration of Customs of China, in the first 3 months of 2024, China imported cashew nuts (HS 080131 and 080132) reached 9.97 thousand tons, worth nearly 49.37 million USD, an increase of 18.4% in volume. and increase 45.7% in value over the same period in 2023.

China imports cashew nuts mainly from Vietnam (accounting for 83.9% of China's total imports), Ivory Coast (accounting for 5.5%), Myanmar (accounting for 5.3%), Tanzania (accounting for 3.5%) and Benin (accounting for 1.4%).
