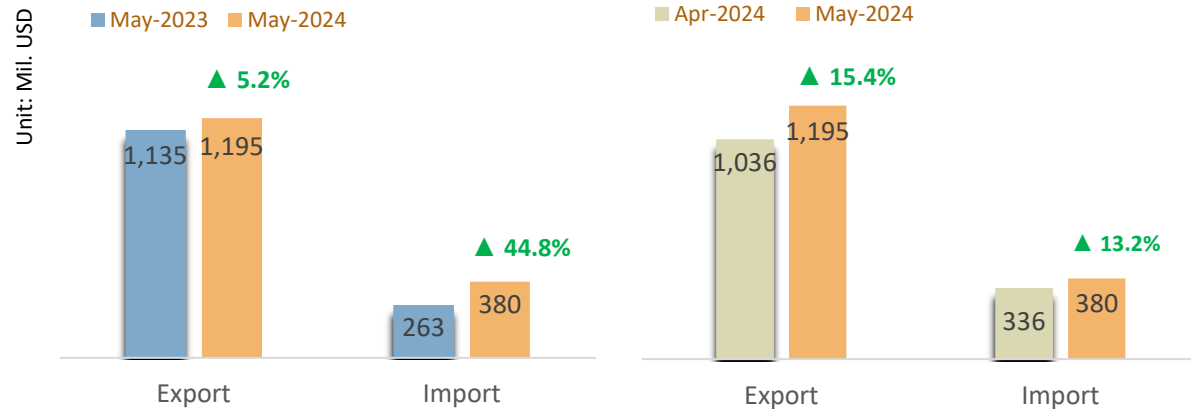

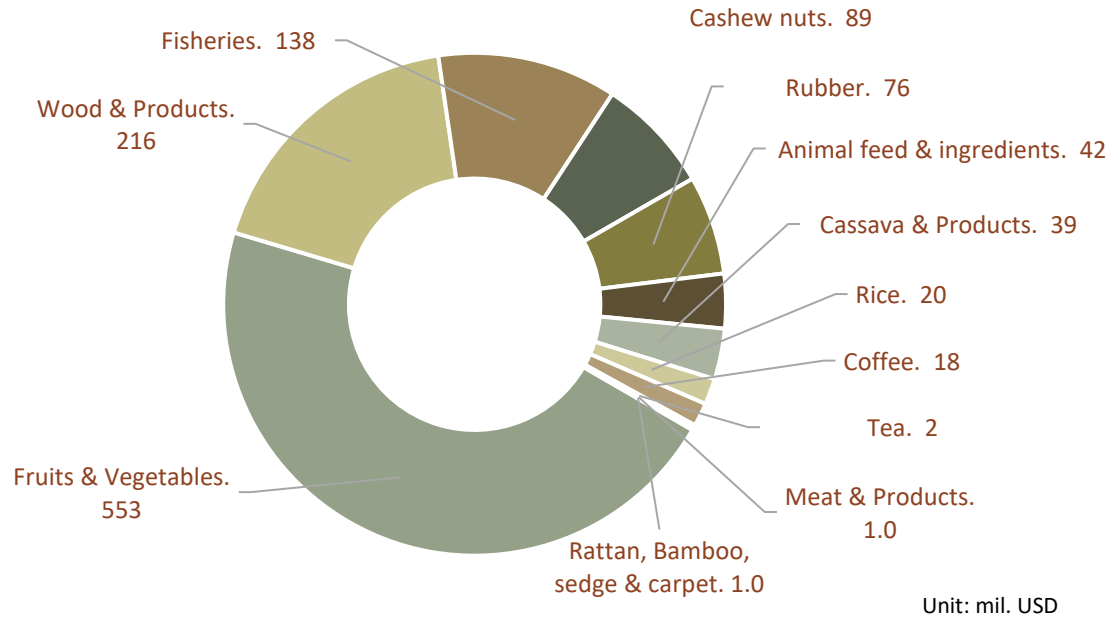

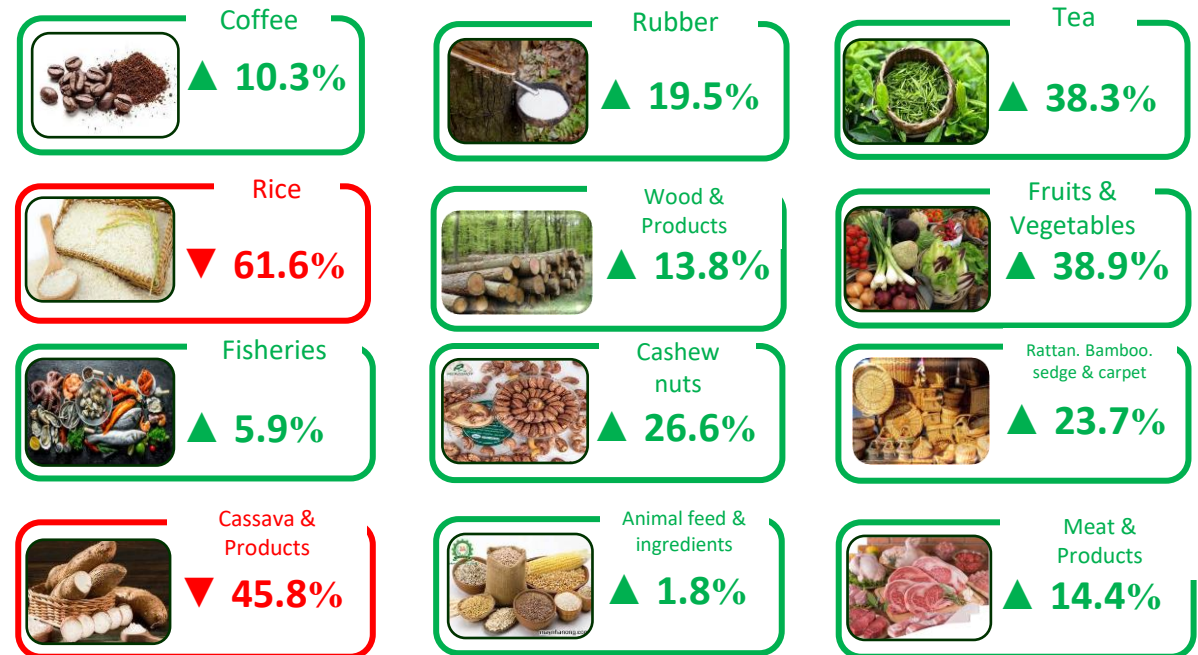
## AFF product import-export turnover between **Vietnam and China, May-2024**



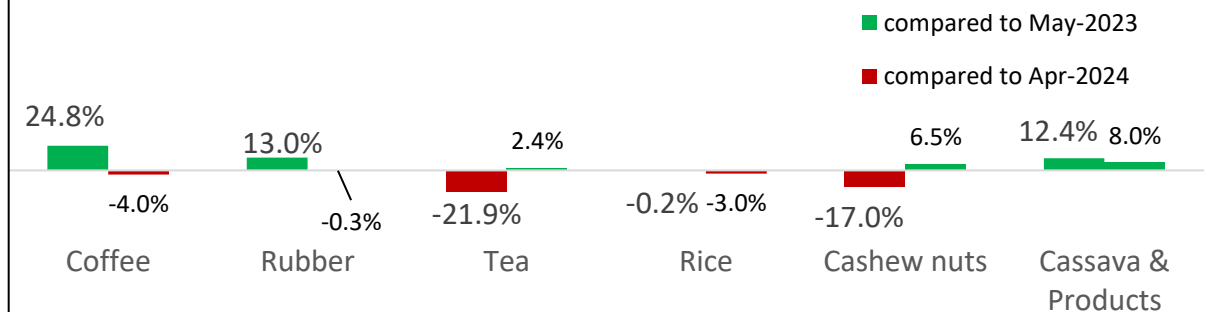
## Key AFF product export value to **China, May-2024**

## China's CPI increases in 4 consecutive months

According to the National Bureau of Statistics of China, the consumer price index (CPI) in May increases by 0.3% over the same period last year, and be the fourth consecutive months of increase.

Production costs index (PPI) continue

to decline, extending the deflationary period since the end of 2022. PPI in May decreases by 1.4% over the same period last year, lower than the decrease percent (2.5%) in April 2024 and better than Bloomberg's forecast.

China's leaders are promoting consumers' expenditure to boost economic growth. However, the real

estate crisis and youth unemployment are holding back the growth.

## Chinese production increased with the highest level in more than 3 years

According to Caixin/S&P Global, China's purchasing managers index (PMI) is 51.8 in June - the highest level since mid-2021, indicating the growth of manufacturing sector. China's industrial output reaches the 2-year peak in June. Domestic and international orders also increase with slower rate than the overall index.

Demand of consumers and intermediate goods is currently higher than machinery and equipment's

demand. Business owners are facing to high production costs due to increasing raw material prices (steel, aluminum, copper) and transportation costs.

The confidence index of manufacturers has reduced to the lowest level since November 2019 due to increasing competition concerns and uncertain economic growth prospects.



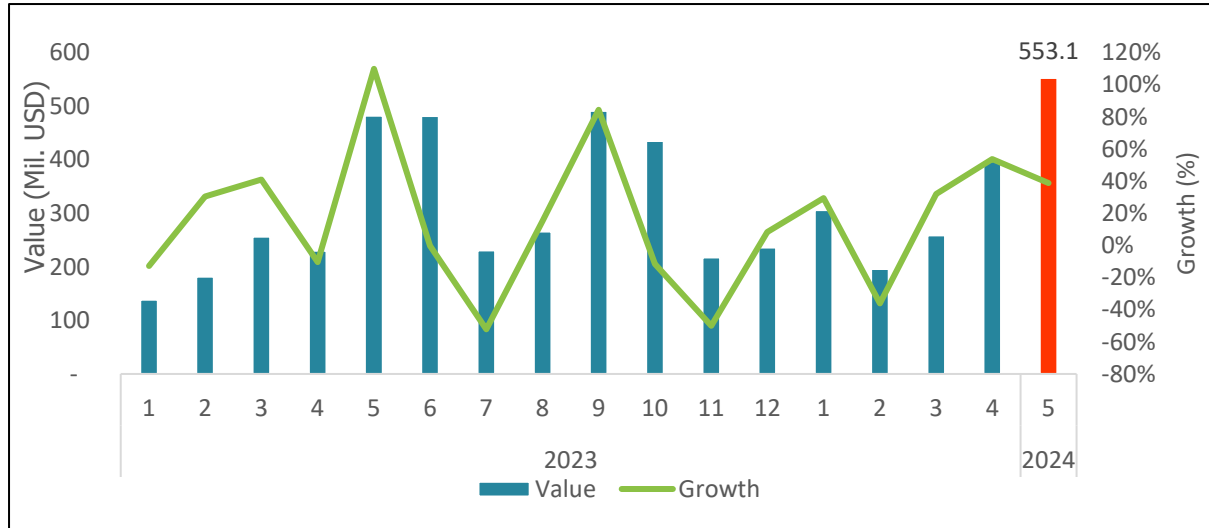

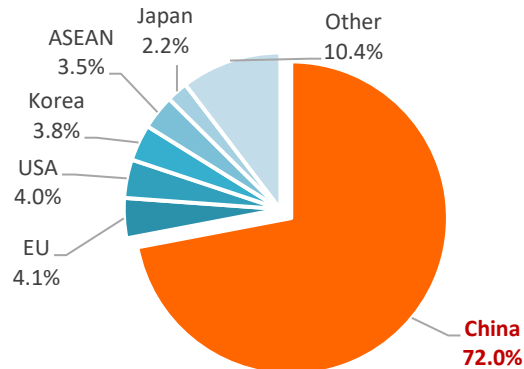

## Percentage of export value to China, May-2024



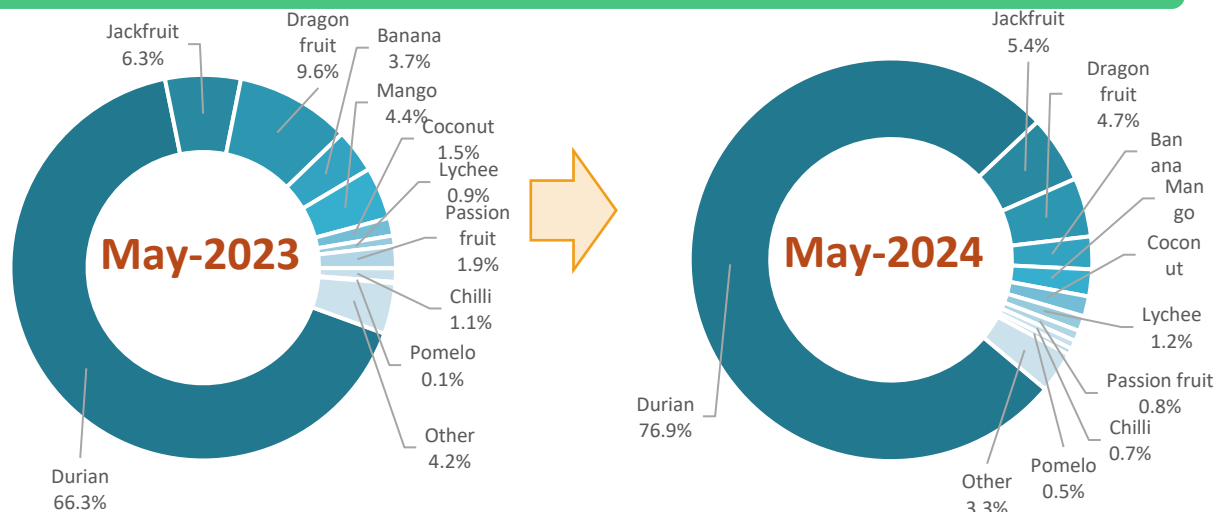

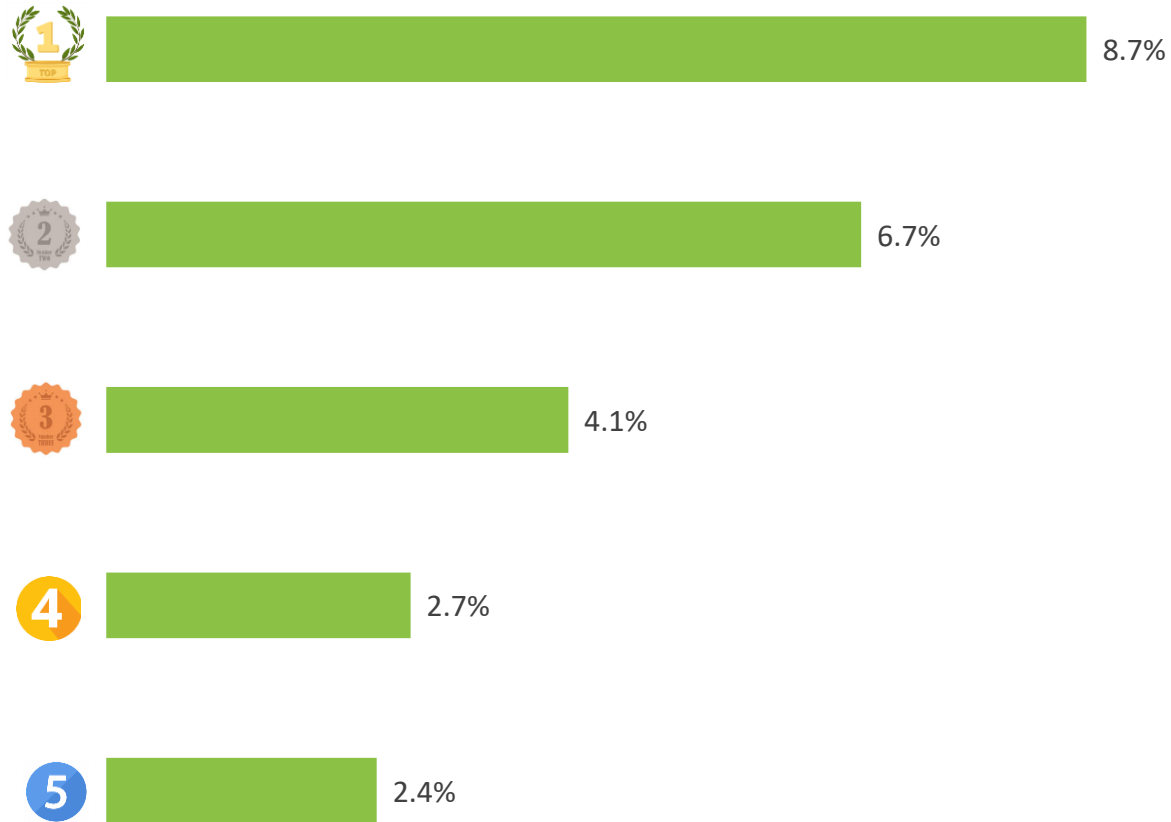

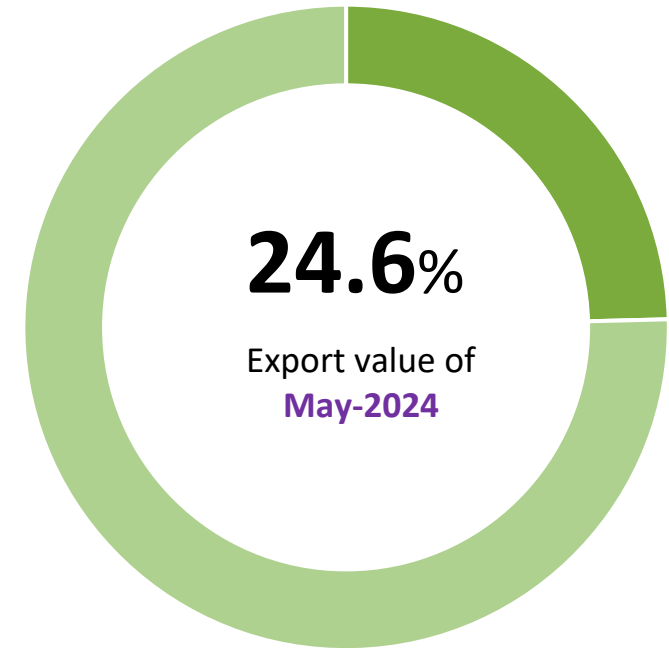

TOP 5 export enterprises by value to **China, May-2024**



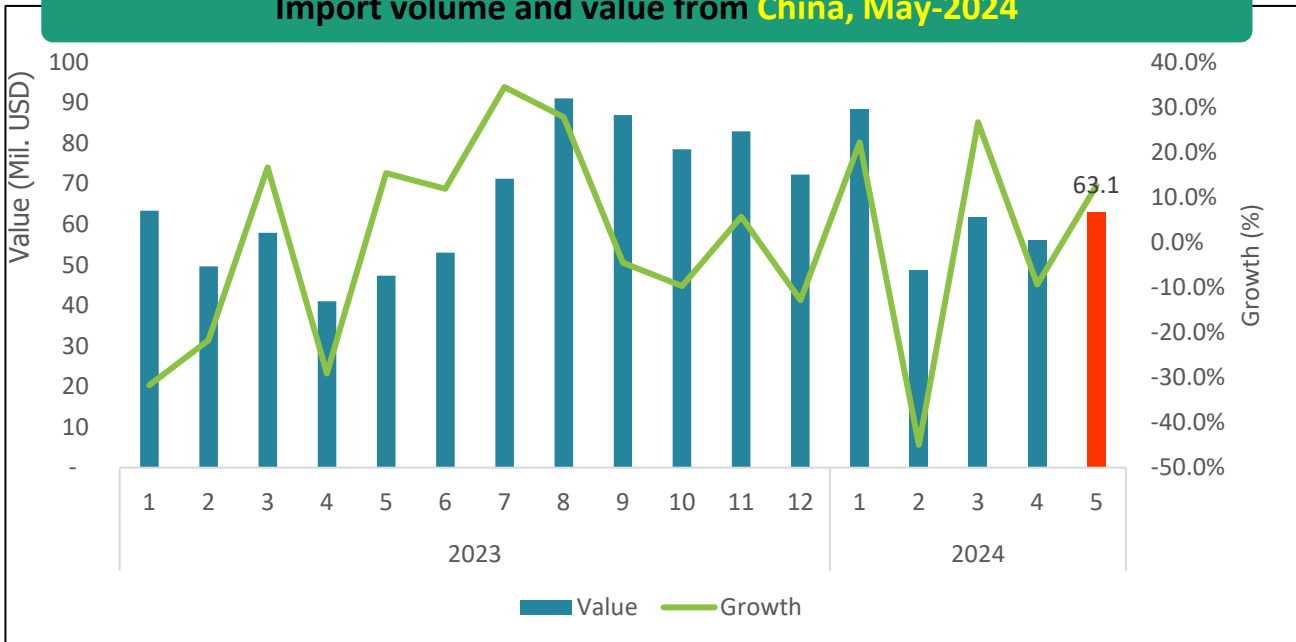

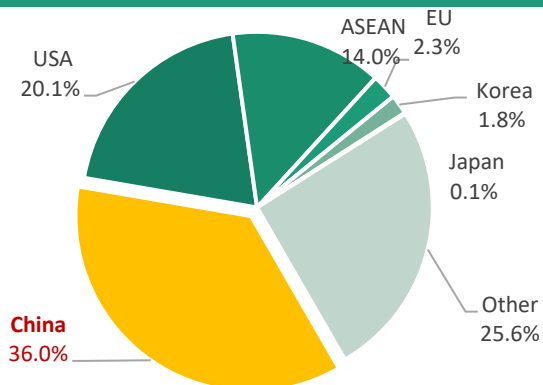

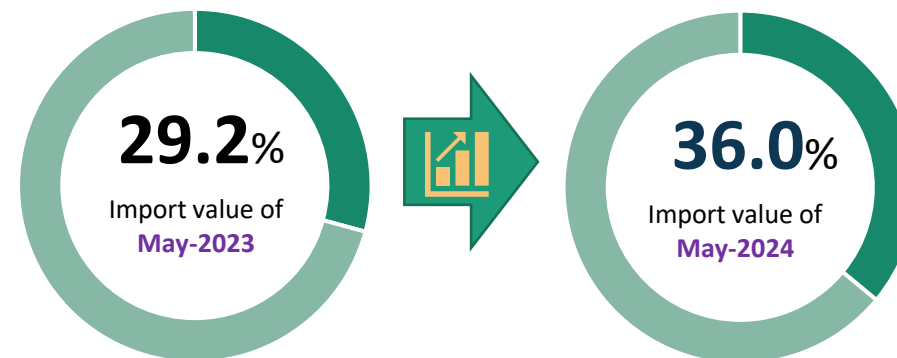

## Percentage of import value from China, May-2024



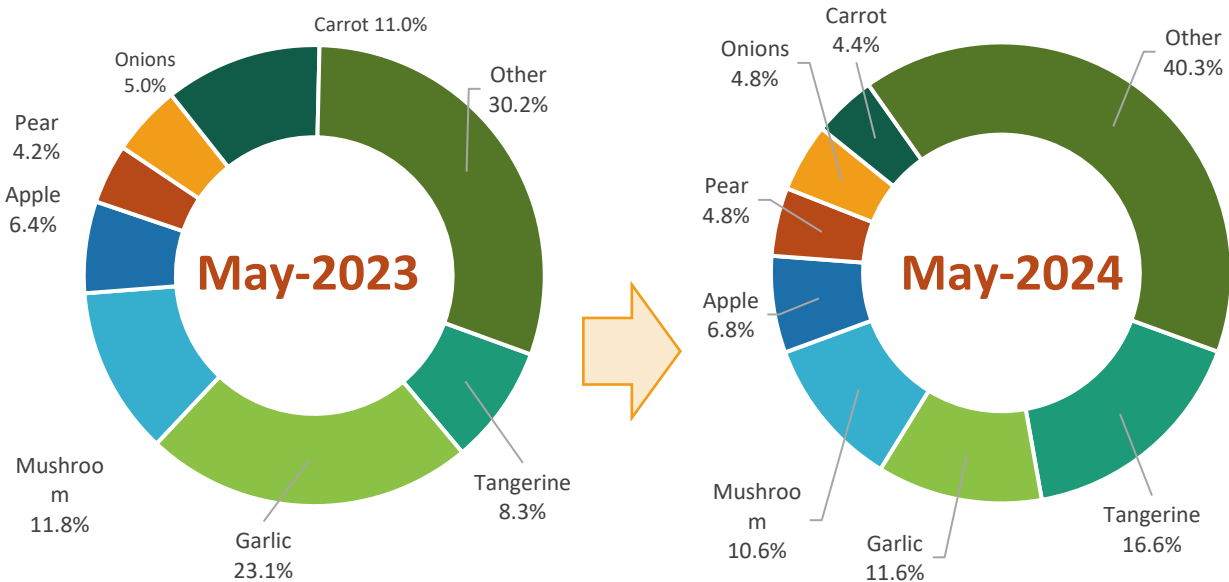

### **China opens to Malaysian fresh durian**

On June 20, China and Malaysia signed a Protocol on plant quarantine requirements for fresh Malaysian durian exported to China. Malaysia exported frozen durian to China in 2019. With this Protocol, Malaysia hopes to boost exports of fresh durian to China.

### **China imported 202,500 tons of fresh durian in the first 4 months of 2024**

According to China's General Administration of Customs, in the first 4 months of 2024, China imported 202,500 tons of fresh durian, with a value of 1.09 billion USD. The average price of imported fresh durian is about 5,395 USD/ton, increasing 4.9% over the same period last year.

Thailand remains the largest supplier of fresh durian to China. However, the proportion of imports from Thailand (accounting for 60% of China's total imports) decreased by 26.7 percentage points over the same period in 2023. The main reason is due to heat and drought affecting Thailand's durian harvest output. Meanwhile, Vietnamese durian accounts for 39.2% of the total imported fresh durian of China, an increase of 25.9 percentage points over the same period in 2023.

### **A large volume of Hainan durian is sold to the market**

This year is the second year that Hainan durian was launched on a large scale in market. Durian output increases significantly and time to market is earlier than last year (1 month). The retail price of durian at the beginning of the season is about 60 CNY/jin (about 18.6 USD/kg), equivalent to last year's price.

The production scale of durian in Hainan is forecasted to increase to 100,000 mu (about 6,667 hectares) within the next 3-5 years. Hainan durian blooms in March, sell to market from the end of May, harvest time is from mid-June to September.

### **The export value of fruit and vegetable to China is forecasted to grow strongly**

According to the Chairman of the Vietnam Fruit and Vegetable Association (Vinafruit), Vietnam's fruit and vegetable exports will continue to increase in the coming time thanks to abundant domestic supply and high demand from traditional and potential markets, especially some fruits such as durian, dragon fruit, pineapple, watermelon, mango, longan, lychee, etc.

According to the Secretary of Vinafruit, exporting durian to China is more favorable when logistics costs are cheap. Vietnam has opportunities to increase export because output and quality of Thailand's durian declined due to drought. In addition, this year Vietnam was granted double growing area codes compared to 2023, so that durian export turnover increases sharply.

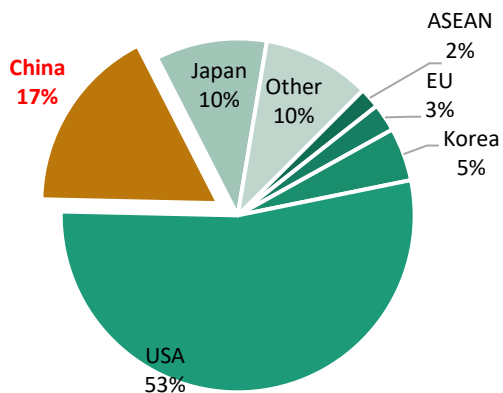

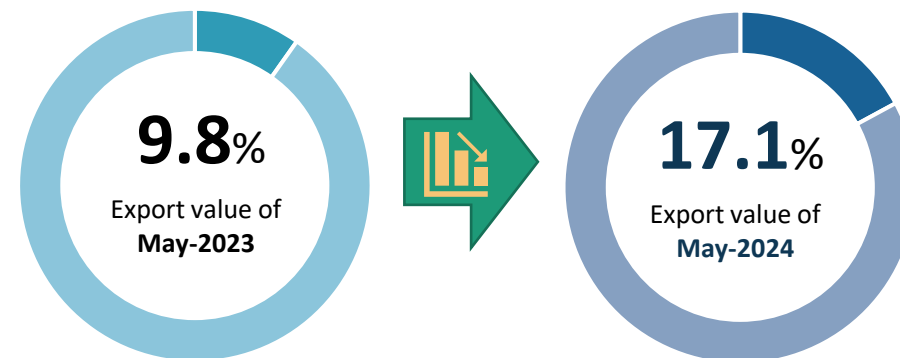

## Percentage of export value to China, May-2024



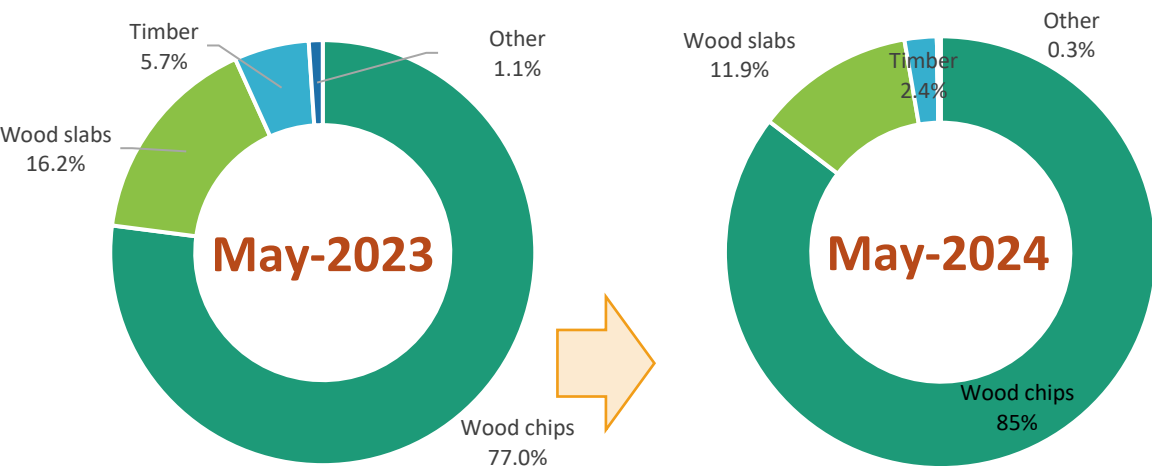

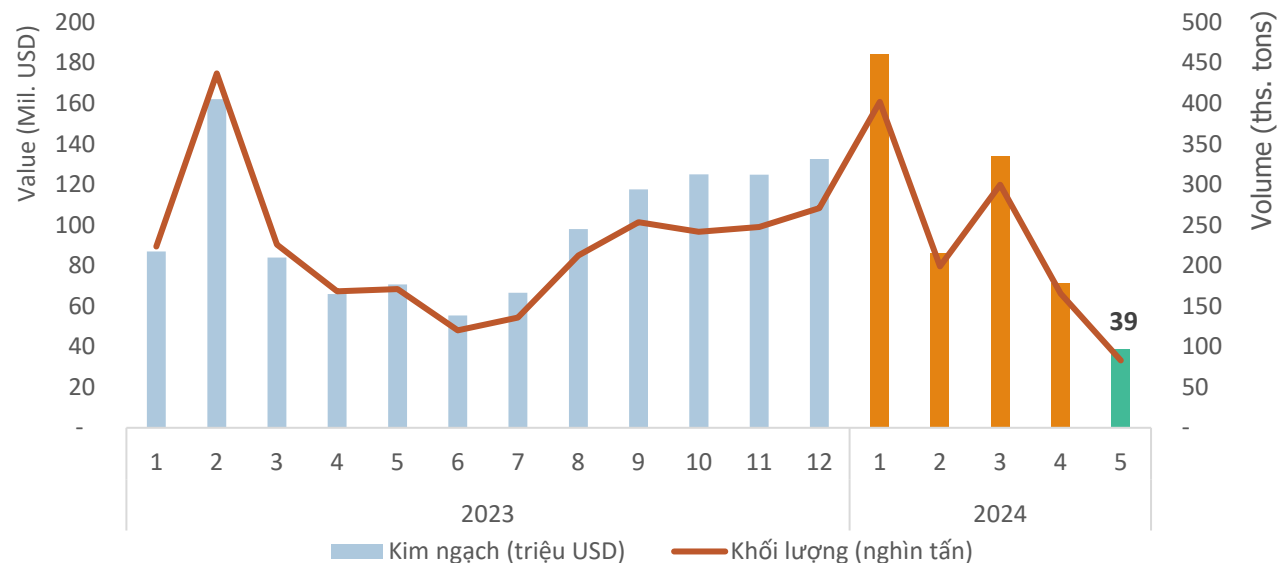
In the first quarter of 2024, China's plywood exports reached 2,936 million m<sup>3</sup> with a value of 1.104 billion USD, an increase of 25% in volume compared to the same period in 2023. Plywood exports to Taiwan reached 481,000 m<sup>3</sup> with a value 26 million USD, an increase of 500% over the same period in 2023.

In the first quarter of 2024, China imported 86,550 m<sup>3</sup> of plywood, an increase of 109% over the same period in 2023. Russia is the largest plywood supplier to China with 75,520 m<sup>3</sup>, an increase of 179% over the same period last year, and accounting for 87% of China's total imported plywood value.

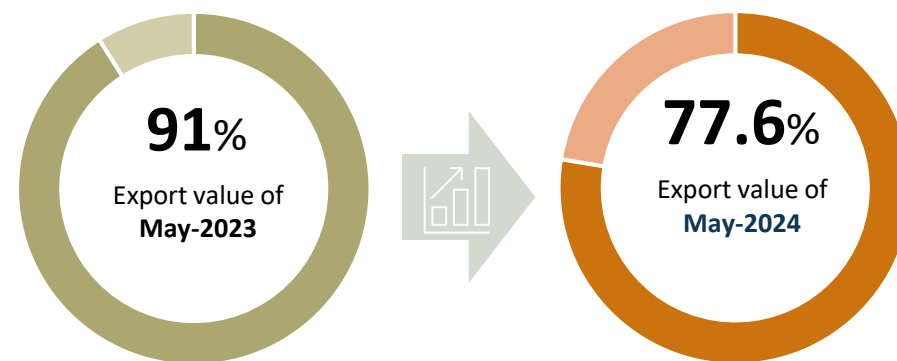

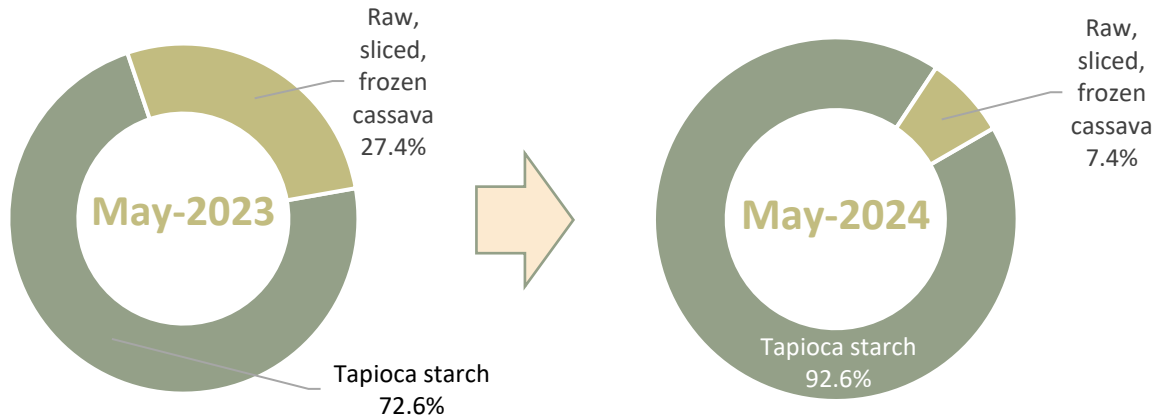

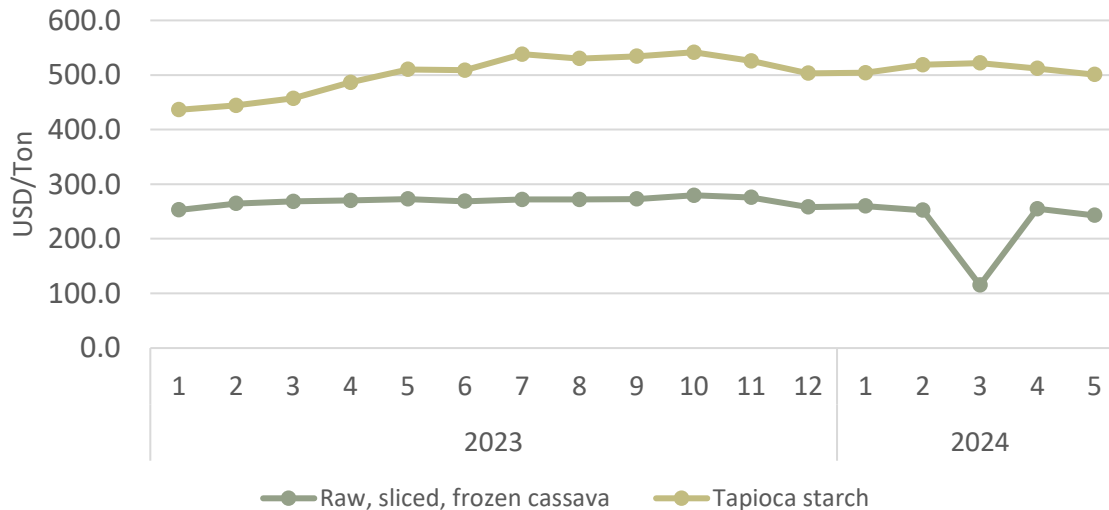

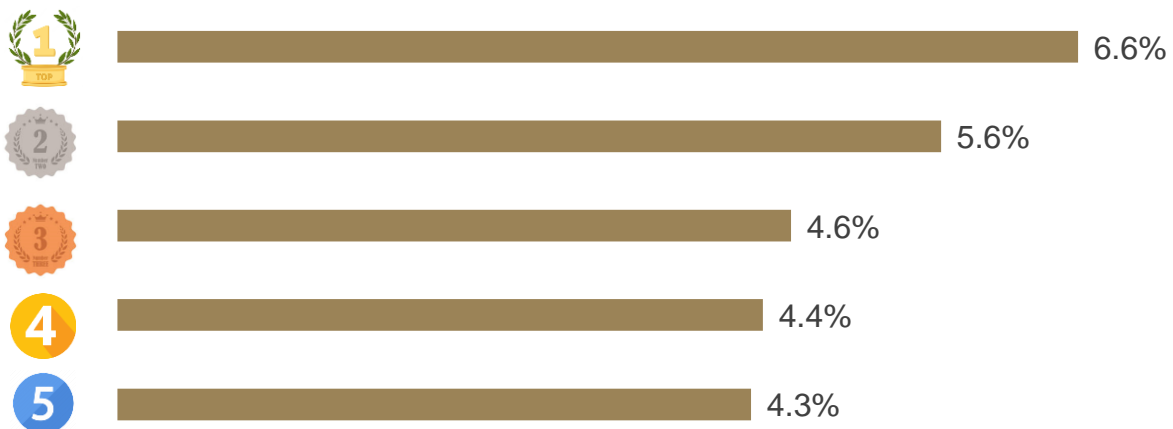

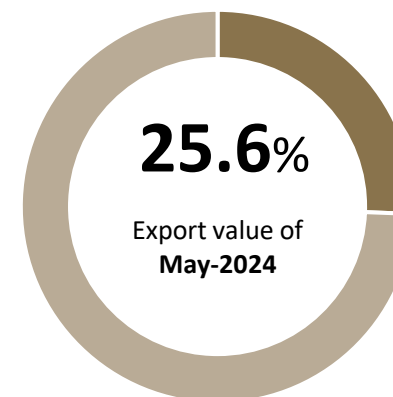

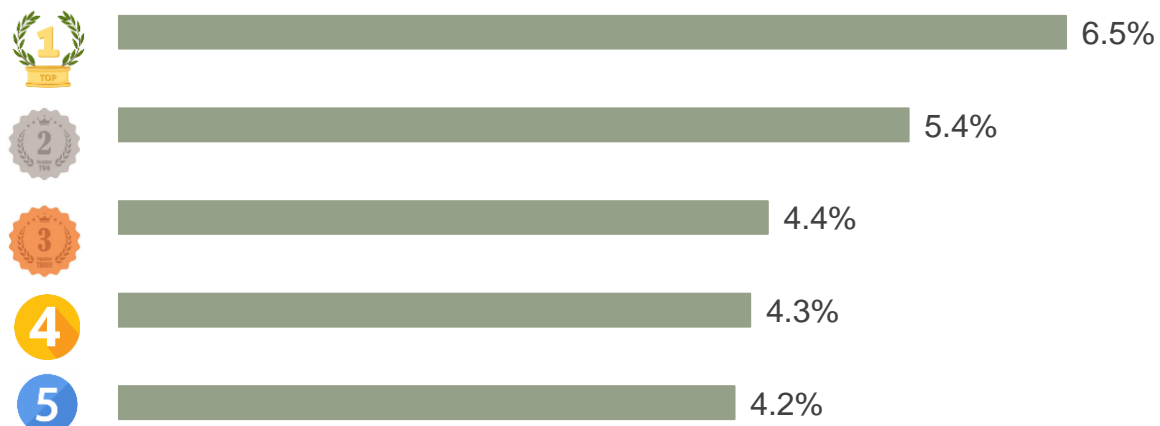
## TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Volume ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to **China, May-2024**



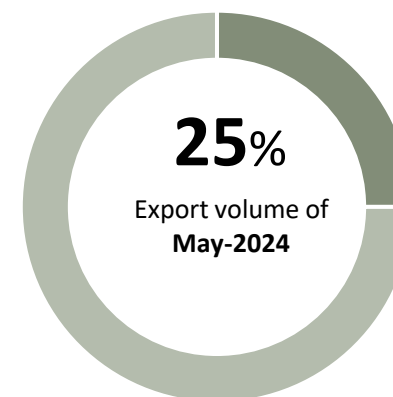
## Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to **China, May-2024**

In May 2024, China's imported 114.6 thousand tons dried cassava chips with value of 28.89 million USD, decreasing by 78.5% and 80.56% respectively over the same period last year.

Cumulatively in the first 5 months of 2024, the volume and value of China's imported dried cassava chips are 1.20 million tons and 315 million USD, respectively, declining 66.6% and 68.2% over the same period last year. Of which, the amount of dried cassava chips imported from Thailand accounted for 76.8%, from Vietnam accounted for 22.58%.



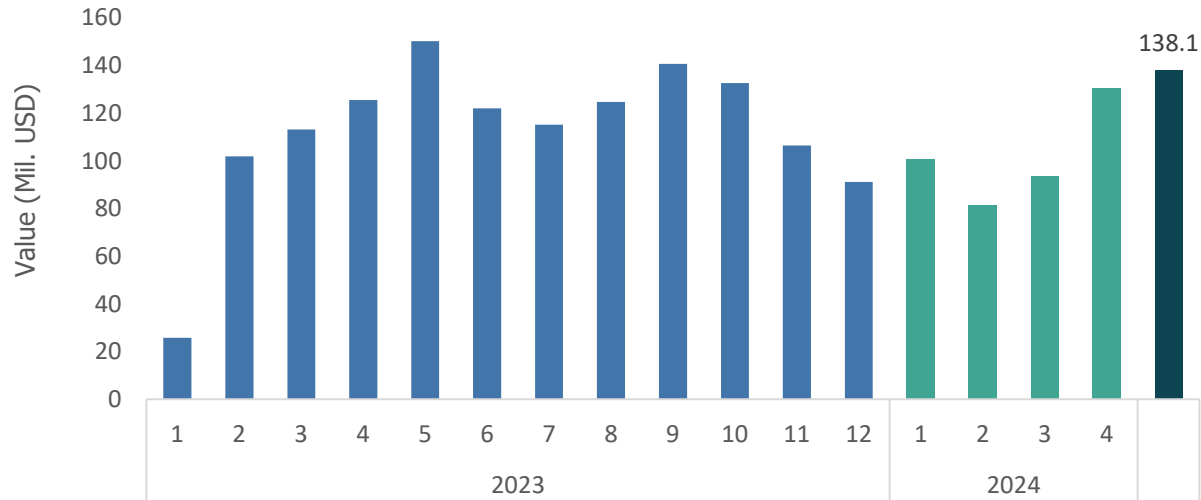
In May 2024, China's cassava starch import volume was 191.7 thousand tons, down 48.01% over the previous month but up 14.70% over the same period last year.

Cumulatively in the first 5 months of 2024, China's cassava starch import volume was 1.56 million tons, an increase of 14.22% over the same period last year. Thailand and Vietnam are the two main cassava starch suppliers with market shares of 45.49% and 36.86%, respectively.

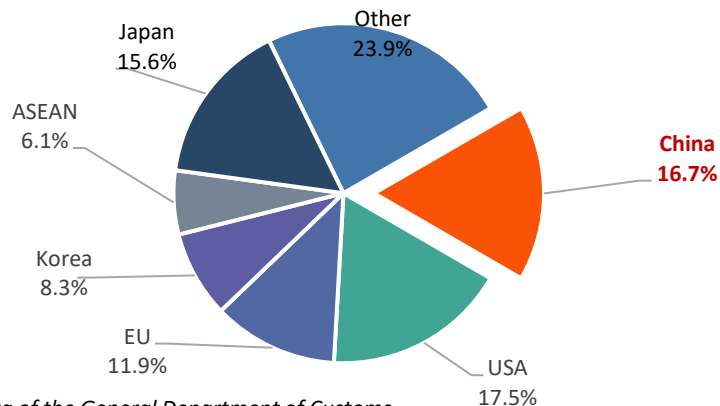

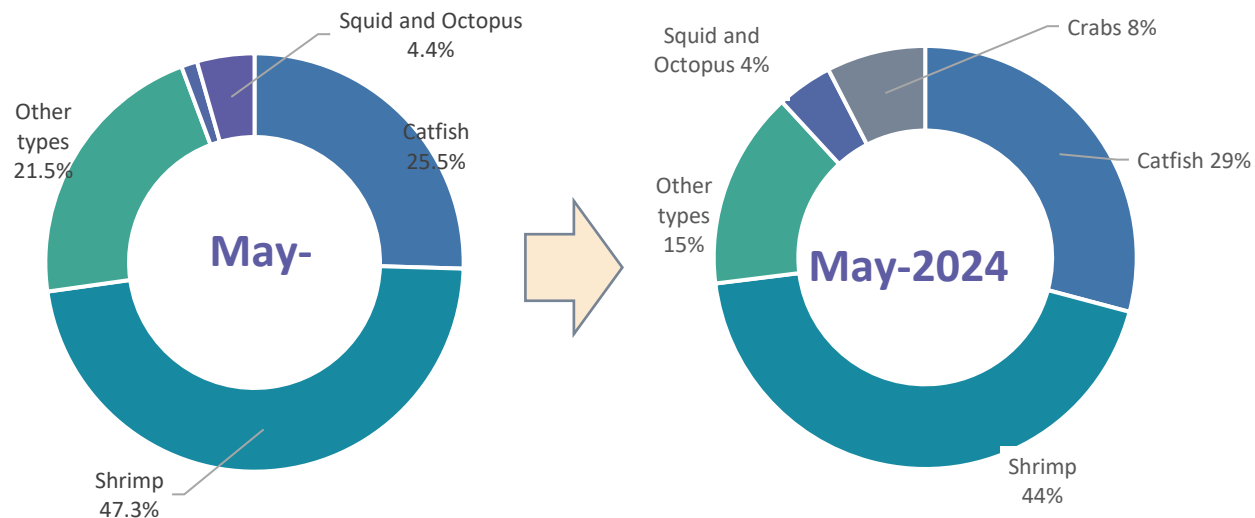

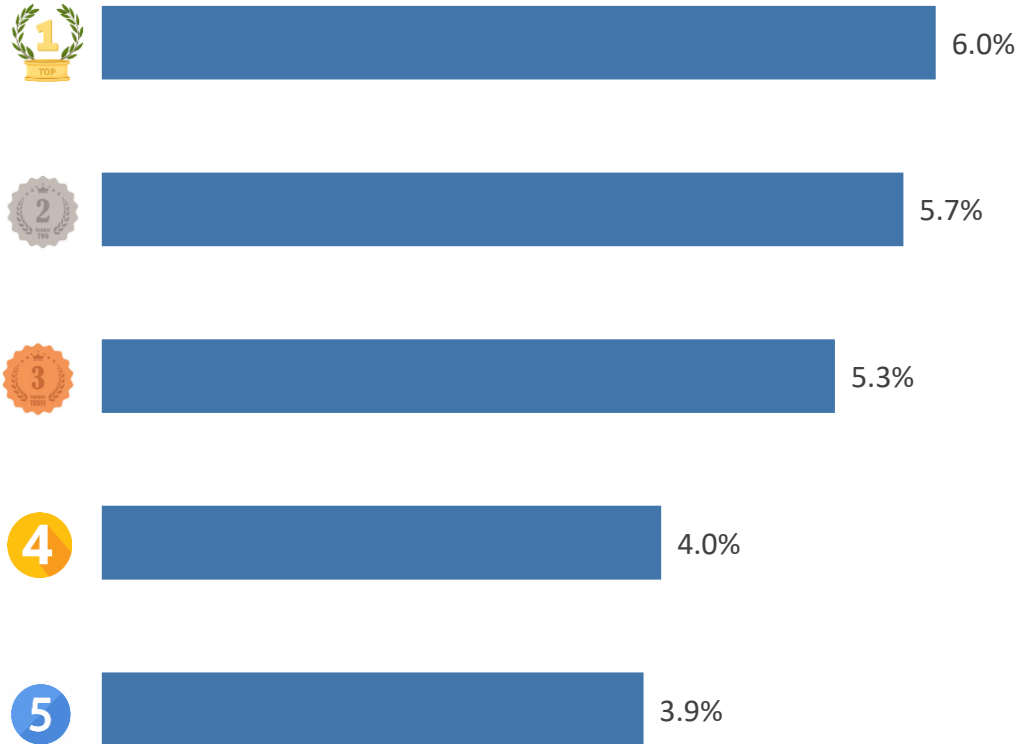

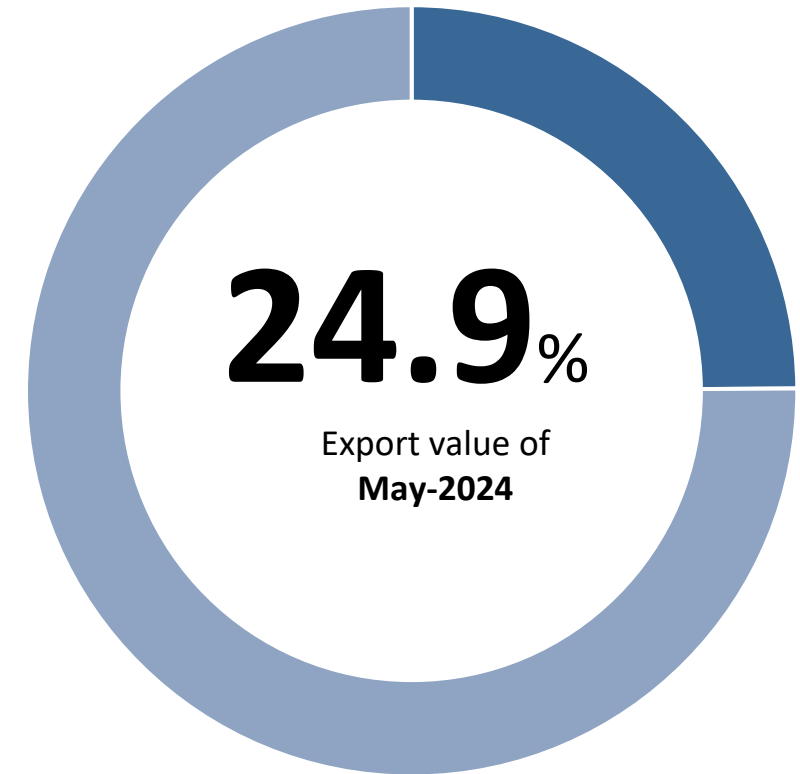

### China removes the ban on 9 Ecuadorian shrimp exporters

On June 5, China's General Administration of Customs removed restrictions with Ecuadorian shrimp, after imports were suspended due to "the sulfite residues exceeding the allowable level in shrimp shipments since February and March 2024. 9 businesses on the list can continue to export shrimp when they get standard compliance certificate in each shipment.

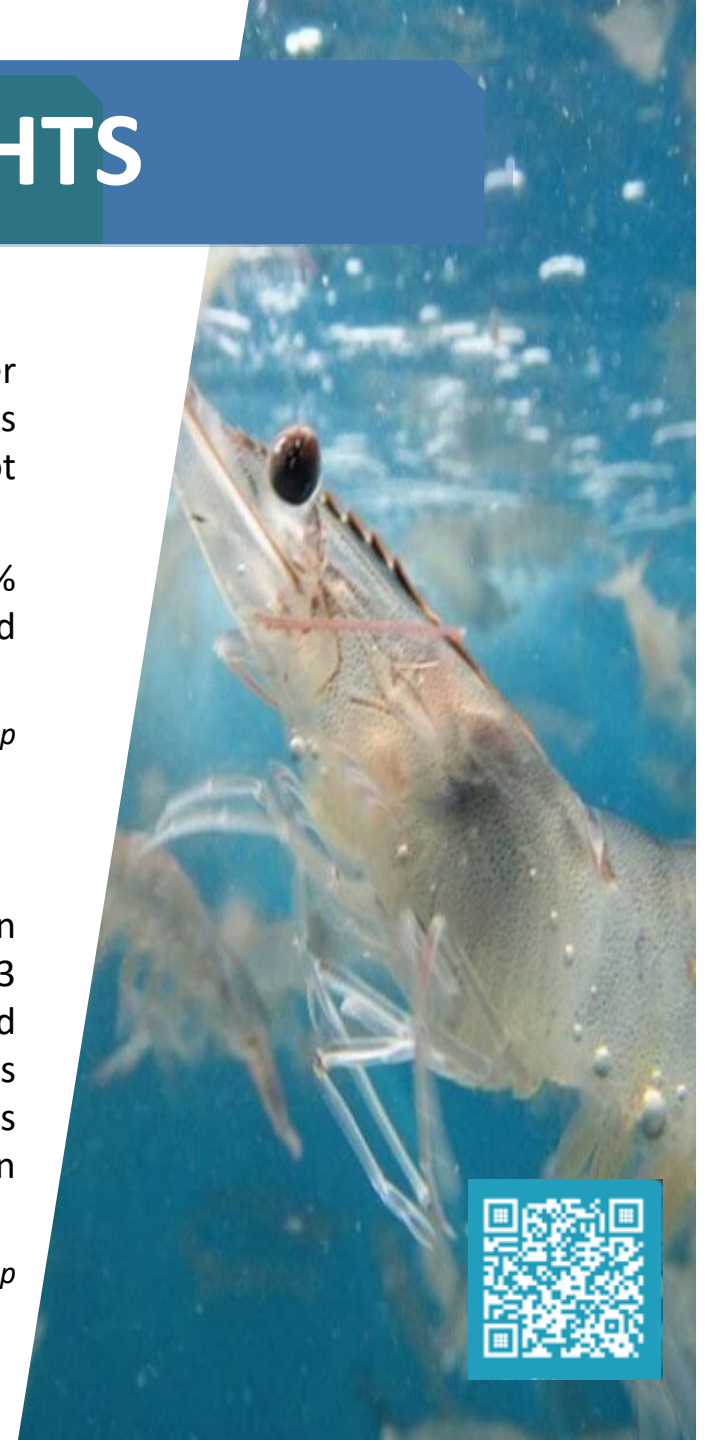
China's ban leads to reduce Ecuador's shrimp exports in the first quarter of 2024 by 27% in volume and 43% in value compared to the same period last year. Ecuador's shrimp export market share in China decreased from 64% in the first quarter of 2023 to 50% in the first quarter of 2024.

### Farmed shrimp prices in China continue to decrease

The price of white-legged shrimp in China dropped sharply, leading to many shrimp farmers lose. In Guangdong province, the price of 60 units/kg shrimp decreases to 38 CNY/kg (5.25 USD/kg) in week 23 (June 3-9, 2024). In Shandong, the price of 60 units/kg shrimp decreases to 37 yuan/kg (5.11 USD/kg), and in Jiangsu, the price drops to 34 yuan/kg (4.69 USD/kg). According to "Aquaculture Wealth", shrimp prices are currently lower than production costs (36-40 CNY/kg, about 4.97-5.52 USD/kg), causing shrimp farmers to lose money. The price of 60 units/kg shrimp will fall to 30 yuan/kg (4.14 USD/kg) in July. This situation causes many farmers harvested shrimp but not yet release new batches.

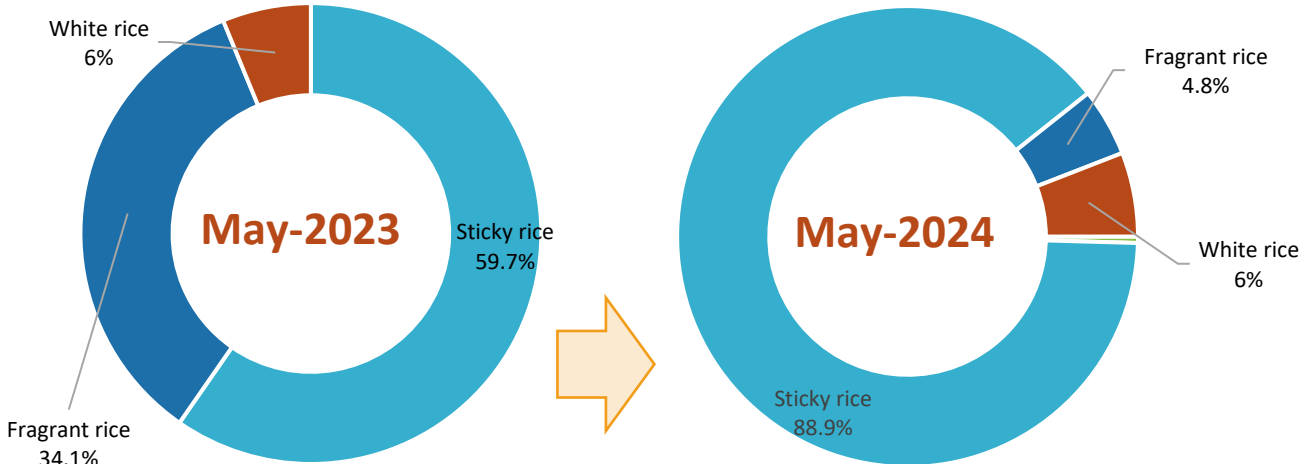

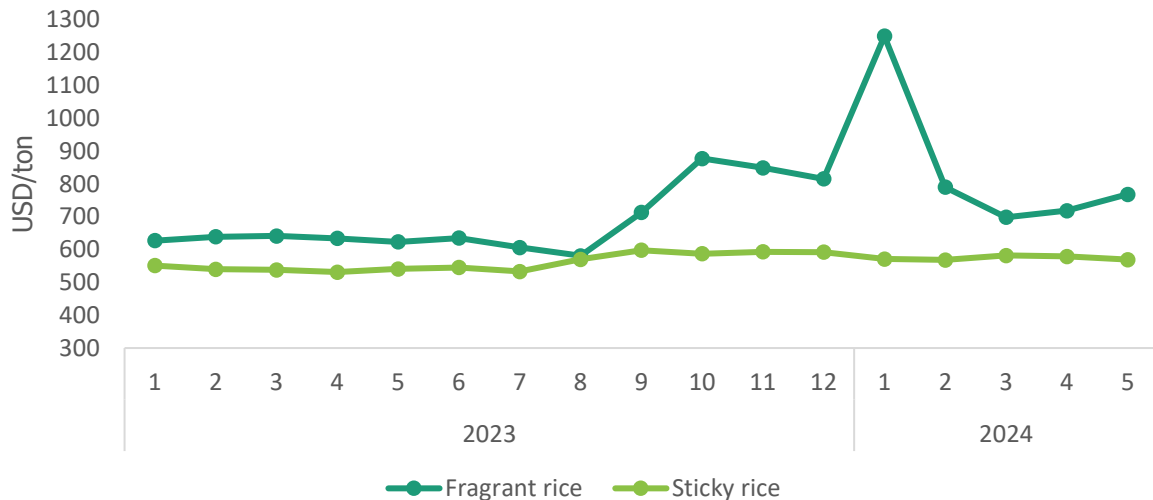

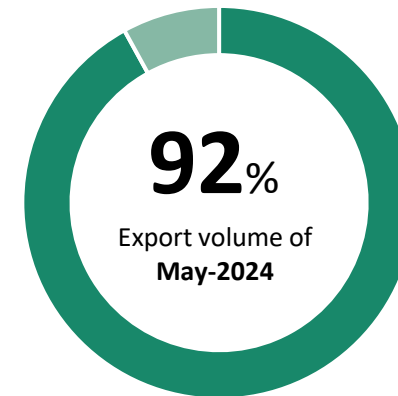
## Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to China, May-2024

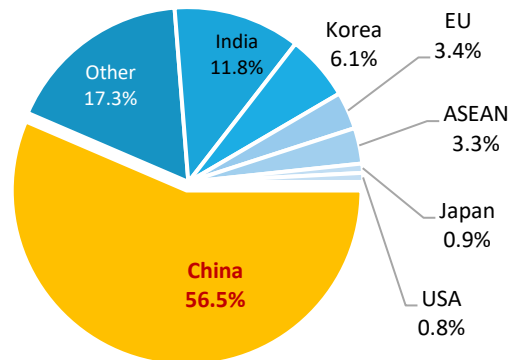

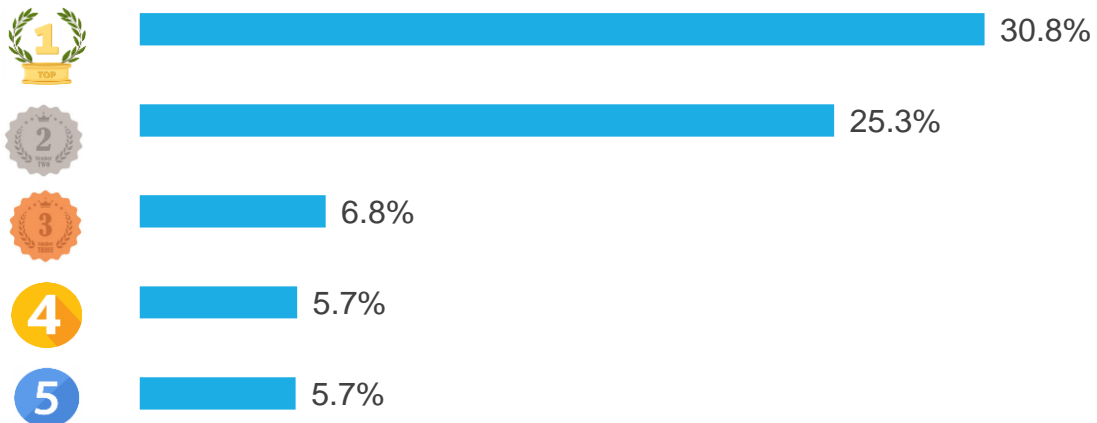

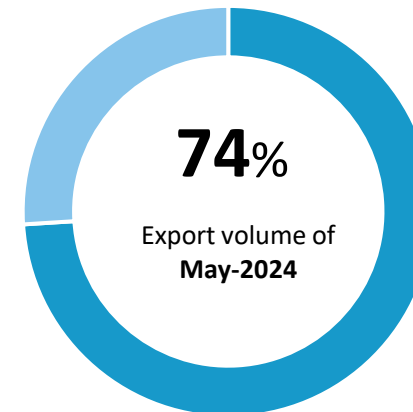

❖ In May 2024, China imports 485 thousand tons of natural and synthetic rubber (including rubber latex), down 20.9% in volume compared to the same period in 2023.

In the first 5 months of 2024, China imports 2.81 million tons of natural and synthetic rubber (including latex), down 16.6% in volume compared to the same period in 2023.

❖ In May 2024, rubber tire output in China is about 93.4 million units, an increase of 9.5% over the same period last year. In the first 5 months of 2024, rubber tire output reaches 432.1 million units, an increase of 11.1% over the same period last year.

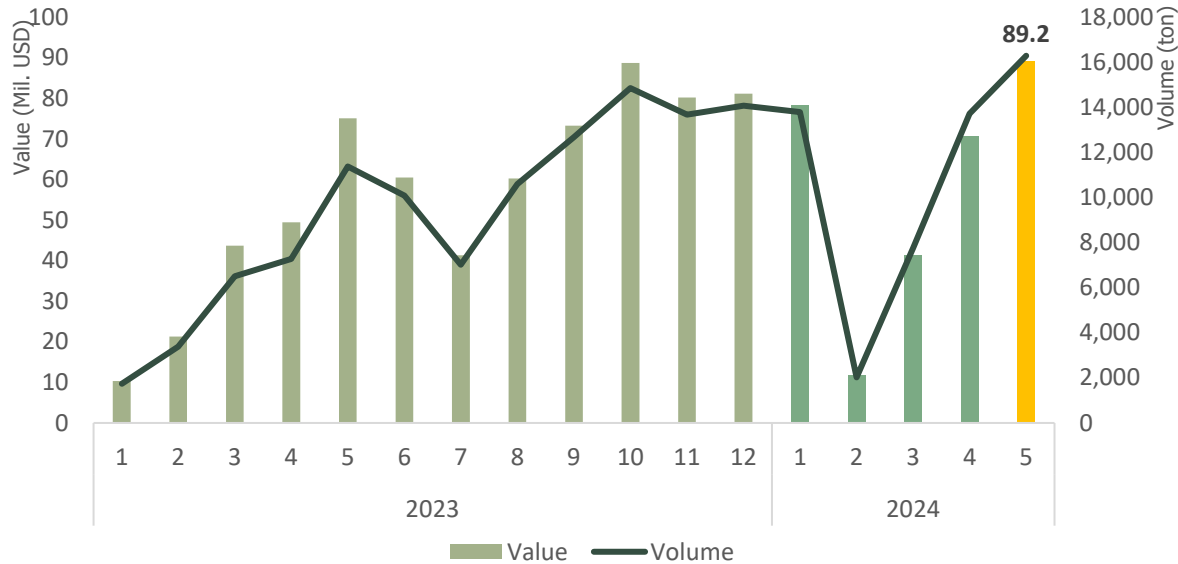

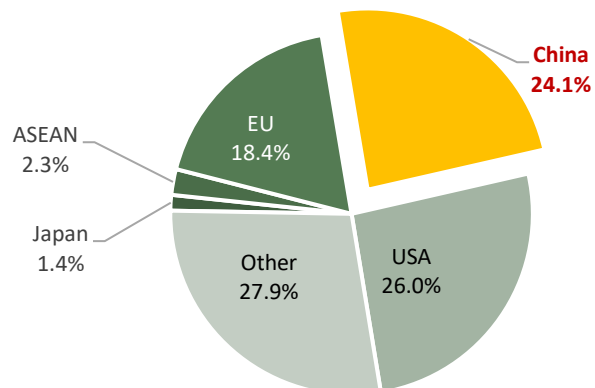

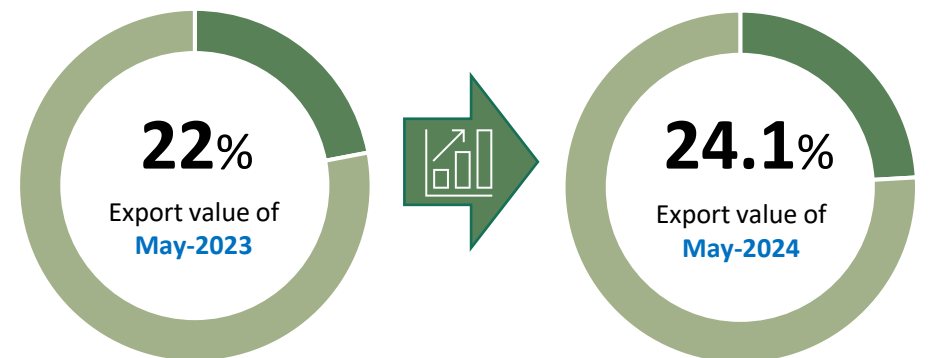

## Changes in percentage of export value to China, May-2024



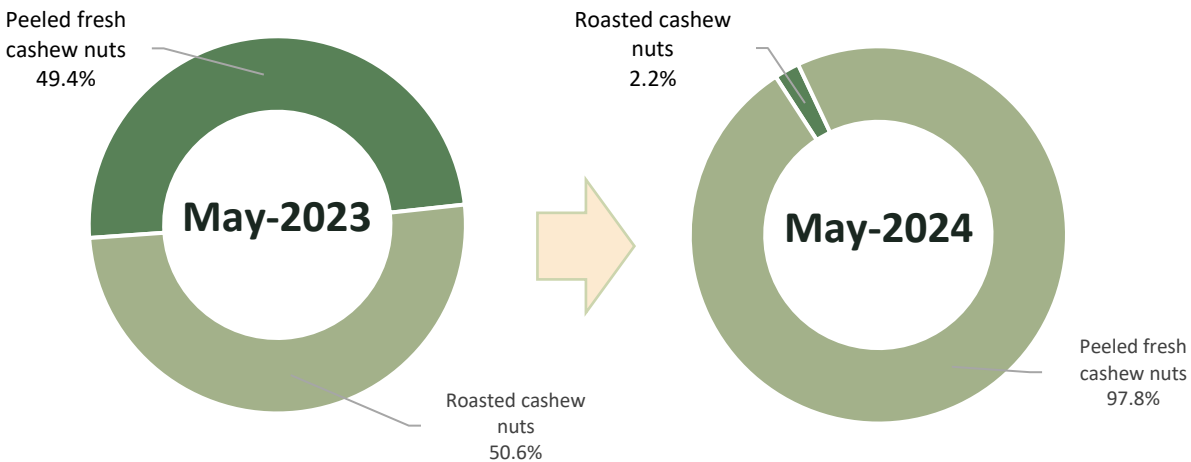
## Changes in percentage of export value to China, Nov-2023



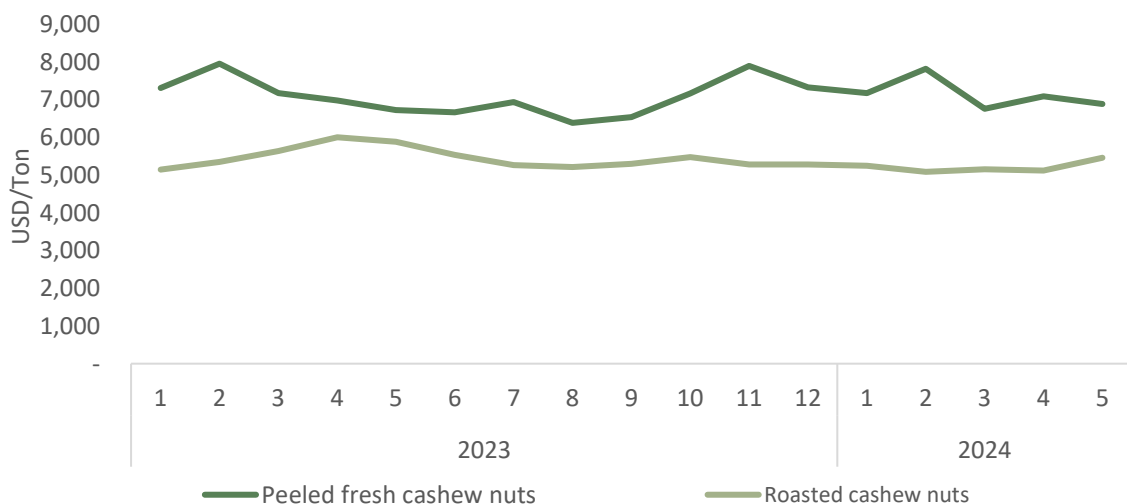

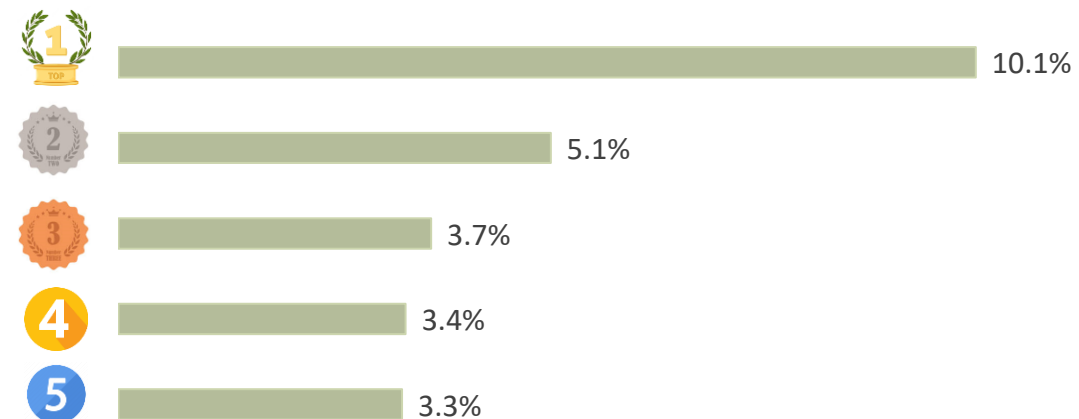

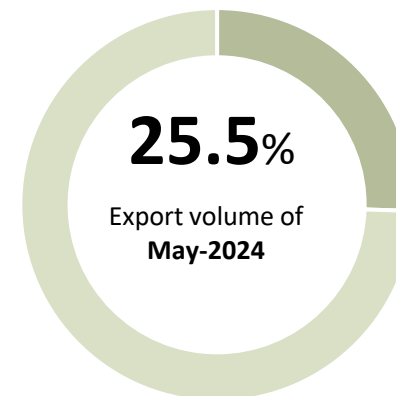
## Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to China, May-2024
