

Japan faces rice shortage pressure

Japan is facing its worst rice shortage in three decades, with prices skyrocketing and rice often missing from supermarket shelves. Several factors contribute to the crisis, including the hottest summer on record, rising demand for sushi due to an influx of foreign tourists, and years of flawed agricultural policies. Many supermarkets are now restricting customers to one bag of rice, while online orders are frequently canceled or subject to lotteries.

In June, private-sector rice inventories hit their lowest levels since 1999. A standard 5 kg bag of rice now costs 3,000 yen (USD 21), marking a 60% increase from last year. Japanese government officials are reexamining the nation's food system. Japan is only 38% self-sufficient in food production overall but is fully self-sufficient in rice. However, strict government control over rice imports and limits on domestic production to keep prices high have left the country vulnerable to supply disruptions.

Although the upcoming summer rice harvest is expected to alleviate the shortage, experts warn it may lead to renewed shortages next year. With the number of rice farmers in decline, concerns are growing over Japan's ability to secure a stable rice supply in the future.






Export value to Japan, Aug-2024



Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Aug-2024




Percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2024












TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Aug-20

Japan agrees to stricter monitoring of treated water from Fukushima plant

On September 20, 2024, Japan agreed to extend long-term monitoring of the treated water from the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant, including inspections by third-party officials, such as those from China. This step aims to encourage China to lift its ban on Japanese seafood imports, according to Prime Minister Fumio Kishida.

China's Ministry of Foreign Affairs welcomed the agreement, stating it would "gradually resume imports" if the agreed conditions are met. However, China still opposes the discharge of water from the Fukushima plant into the Pacific Ocean.

Japan's fishing industry has been heavily affected by China's import ban, and the potential lifting of the ban is seen as a positive development for Japanese fishermen. While the exact timeline for fully removing the ban remains uncertain, Japan hopes the enhanced monitoring system will reassure Beijing and lead to the resumption of seafood trade between the two countries.



Percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2024




Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Aug-2024





TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Aug-2024




Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Japan, Aug-2024






Import value from Japan, Aug-2024


According to a representative of the Idaho Potato Commission (U.S.), Japan is delaying trade processes to protect its domestic potato industry.




Export volume and value to Japan, Aug-2024







Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Aug-2024




Percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2024






Japan's annual coffee consumption exceeds 450,000 tons

Annual coffee consumption in Japan has surpassed 450,000 tons, driving continuous market growth. The ready-to-drink (RTD) coffee market alone is valued at approximately USD 15 billion, thanks to innovations in flavor and packaging.


Japan is also focusing on functional RTD products, enriched with vitamins and collagen, catering to the health-conscious consumer trend. RTD coffee exports are growing rapidly, particularly within Asia. Sustainable strategies, such as recycled packaging and fair trade practices, have further strengthened Japan's position in the coffee industry.






Percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2024





Changes in percentage of export results to Japan, Aug-2024








TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Aug-2024


Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to Japan, Aug-2024






TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Japan, Aug-2024

For the first time, Japan's MIRATH Agri-Tech will export cashews processed in Kampong Thom Province, Cambodia, to the European market, starting in October 2024, with a volume of around 250 tons.


MIRATH Agri-Tech stated that the cashew processing for the European market has been fully completed, with an export price of approximately USD 8 per kilogram. This export price allows Cambodia to remain competitive in the European cashew market against other countries. Europe is MIRATH's second-largest cashew market after Japan, followed by Singapore, Hong Kong, and Thailand. The company plans to further expand its exports to the European market next year.

In June, MIRATH Agri-Tech Co., Ltd established a medium-sized cashew processing plant headquartered in Kampong Svay District, Kampong Thom Province. The plant currently has a processing capacity of 20 tons of cashews per day.







In June 2024, Japan's import value of office furniture (HS 940330) decreased by 5% compared to the previous month and by 15% compared to the same period last year. China was the largest supplier, accounting for 70% of the total import value, followed by Malaysia with 9% and Italy with 5%. For kitchen furniture (HS 940340), the import value decreased by 6% compared to the previous month and remained stable compared to the same period last year, with the Philippines accounting for 50% and Vietnam 32% of the total import valu.










TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Japan, Aug-2024


