


Proportion export value of key AFF products to the Korea in Sep-2025






Key AFF product export value to Korea, Sep-2025

South Korea's GDP per capita drops three levels in the IMF rank

Due to a weakening domestic economy and slower growth, South Korea's per capita GDP fell three places in the International Monetary Fund (IMF) ranks compared to the previous year. According to the World Economic Outlook report, in 2025 South Korea's per capita GDP is expected to decrease by 0.8% from 2024, to USD 35,962, causing the country to drop from 34th to 37th among 197 economies.

The IMF also forecasts that South Korea's GDP per capita could exceed USD 40,000 by 2028, one year earlier than previously projected, but its ranking is still expected to fall to 38th in 2028 and 42nd in 2029.

APEC 2025 expectes to bring USD 5 billion to South Korea's economy


According to estimates of the Korea Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI), the APEC 2025 Summit in Gyeongju could contribute more than KRW 7.4 trillion (approximately USD 5.4 billion) to the economy and create nearly 24,000 new jobs. Of this, domestic consumption accounts for over KRW 3 trillion (around USD 2.4 billion), mainly in services such as accommodation, retail, and transportation. The remaining KRW 4 trillion (about USD 3 billion) comes from infrastructure investments and medium- to long-term spillover effects.

Local service sector revenues are expected to triple during the event. KCCI notes that APEC 2025 can generate greater economic impact than APEC 2005 in Busan, while also promoting sustainable growth for the MICE (meetings, incentives, conferences, and exhibitions) tourism sector and regional economy.












Structure of exports by products to Korea, Sep-2025





South Korea increases to import seafood from Russia in Sept 2025

According to data from the analytics firm Union Forsea Corp., in September 2025, South Korea imported 27,300 tons of seafood from Russia, increasing 13% compared to the same period last year. In the first nine months of the year, total imports from Russia reached 192,700 tons, a slight increase of 1% compared to the same period in 2024, marking a recovery after a prolonged decline. Russia remains one of South Korea's largest seafood suppliers, accounting for 27% of the country's total seafood import value. Notably, the growth in September did not come from traditional items such as pollock, which continue to decline in both production and demand. Instead, the significant increase came from frozen sardines, with imports surging 1,356% to 16,700 tons, playing a key role in offsetting declines from other major product groups.

The shifting composition of seafood imports reflects the flexibility of the South Korean market, while also highlighting Russia's efforts to diversify its export products amid global geopolitical and trade fluctuations.









SPOTLIGHT



At the national discussion of the Korea Forest Service (KFS), lawmakers expressed deep concerns about the challenges facing South Korea's forestry and wood industry, focusing on three main areas:

First, lawmakers strongly criticized the KFS's lack of proactive response to U.S. tariffs on imported wood, arguing that the agency failed to monitor developments in a timely manner and did not implement effective measures to protect exporters.

Second, the national thinning wood collection rate has only reached 35.2% over the past 10 years, meaning that the majority of this resource is being wasted. Although the KFS has proposed solutions such as supporting automation and improving infrastructure, lawmakers argued that these measures still do not address the practical difficulties faced by processing plants in securing raw material supplies.


Finally, there is a crisis in the domestic wood pellet sector. Lawmakers questioned the KFS's delay in adjusting the Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) factor for imported pellets—a matter that has been discussed for three years but was only recently implemented—causing negative impacts on domestic producers.





Changes in percentage of export results to Korea, Sep-2025






Structure of exports by products to Korea, Sep-2025





SPOTLIGHT



According to data from the Korea Customs Service, in the first eight months of 2025, South Korea imported 2.27 million bags of coffee, an increase of 1.50% compared to the same period last year. Of which, approximately 90% consisted of green coffee beans used as raw material for processing, while the remainder was fully roasted and ground coffee products.

Korea Customs data also show that Brazil accounted for about 30% of total coffee imports in 2024, while Colombia and Vietnam ranked second and third, respectively.




Percentage of export value to Korea, Sep-2025







South Korea forecasts that pear production will rise 13.6% in 2025

According to the Korea Rural Economic Institute (KREI), South Korea's pear production in 2025 is expected to reach 203,000 tons, up 13.6% compared to 2024. The total cultivation area is 9,361 hectares, down 0.6% from the previous year, while yield per hectare is projected to increase 14.3%, reaching 2,166 kg (21.66 tons/ha). Production is expected to be 6.2% higher than the annual average.

However, Korean pears may face quality issues, with the proportion of deformed fruit expected to rise due to unusual weather conditions. Imported pear prices have also declined by 21.4% compared to last year. To mitigate losses, farms are advised to adjust harvest timing and use heat-resistant varieties such as Manhwang. In addition, South Korea is seeking to diversify export markets, including the United States, Australia, Vietnam, Taiwan, and Europe.










Structure of exports by products to Korea, Sep-2025






TOP 5 export enterprises by value to Korea, Sep-2025




TOP 5 export enterprises by volume to Korea, Sep-2025

At the Michelin Beyond Performance 2025 event held on October 22 in Thailand, the Asia-Pacific Regional CEO of Michelin emphasized that South Korea plays a central role as the largest consumer and B2B market in the region, while also serving as an important global export hub. Domestic demand spans various sectors, including automobile and truck manufacturing, heavy industrial equipment, and particularly, since most vehicles produced in South Korea are exported to international markets, product quality standards in the country are among the strictest in the world.

Regarding sustainable strategy, Michelin prepared comprehensively to comply with the EU's EUDR regulations on natural rubber traceability, ensuring that all raw materials are transparent and meet global environmental standards.


At the same time, natural rubber demand in South Korea is expected to rise significantly in the coming years, as the electric vehicle and heavy industry sectors expand production, driving strong demand for premium, durable tires that meet international green standards. This creates opportunities for rubber suppliers in Southeast Asia, including Vietnam, to increase exports of raw materials to South Korea to support Michelin's production chain and other industrial enterprises in the country.





Percentage of export value to Korea, Sep-2025








