

Aug2025 compared to July-2025 and Aug-2024











Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries announced plans to revise the Japan Agricultural Standards (JAS) labeling standards – an important national certification that ensures quality and technical safety for wood products. Accordingly, this agency will completely ban using hand-stamped. Instead, the new regulation will require the adoption of traceability methods such as inkjet printing or labeling. The action was made to restore market confidence after a scandal related to the unauthorized use of the JAS label last year.


In terms of macroeconomics, the Bank of Japan (BoJ) kept its policy of unchanged interest rate, while consumer inflation in August slowed to 2.7%. However, one factor makes great pressure on the market is that the cost of building housing, according to a government survey, has increased by as much as 30% over the past five years, directly affecting consumer affordability and demand.










Structure of exports by products to Japan, Aug-2025





Vietnamese seafood is the top 3 major suppliers in Japan

According to the Japan Customs Agency, in the first 7 months of 2025, Vietnam is the Japan's third largest supplier of seafood, accounting for 7.4% of total imports. Japan imported 78.9 thousand tons of seafood from Vietnam, worth about 627 million USD.

This result shows that the competitiveness and ability to meet strict standards of Vietnamese enterprises have been significantly improved. Experts forecast that seafood exports to Japan will continue to increase in the second half of the year – a period when consumption demand is usually high.

Vietnam also benefits from the CPTPP and VJEPA, which help reduce tariffs and increase market penetration opportunities. However, in order to maintain and expand market share, businesses need to strictly comply with regulations on food safety, environment and traceability – key factors to meet the trend of sustainable and transparent consumption in Japan.





Changes in percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2025














According to a report by IMARC Group (2025), the Japanese instant coffee market will reach 867.3 million USD in 2024 and increase to 1.3729 billion USD by 2033, with an average growth rate (CAGR) of 4.7%/year in the period 2025–2033.

Key growth drivers include:

- Convenience demand: Consumers, especially office workers and students, prefer quick-brew products that are suitable for busy lifestyles.
- The trend of premiumization: Instant coffee has been improved in taste, quality, packaging and has become a "gourmet" choice for young people who love exquisite coffee experiences.
- Health-awareness: interest in organic, low-caffeine, or antioxidantrich coffee increases, in line with healthy and sustainable living trends.

SPOTLIGHTS



The Japan Specialty Coffee Association (SCAJ) and the International Specialty Coffee Association (SCA) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) at the SCAJ Conference in Tokyo to promote global cooperation in specialty coffee education. The agreement focuses on expanding the Coffee Value Assessment (CVA) program and the Q Program in Japan, helping to standardize professional training to international standards.

The two sides committed to develop a network of CVA trainers, enhancing training opportunities for professionals in the coffee value chain, and raising awareness and understanding of the quality of specialty coffee. According to SCAJ and SCA leaders, this cooperation will contribute to the development of the global coffee community, while investing in human resources shaping the future of the coffee industry.














Unusual heat affects potato harvest in Hokkaido


The potato harvest season in Hokkaido, the Japan's largest potato producing region, is at its peak, but the unusually hot summer heat has negative impact on farmers. The potato production in Tokachi region in Hokkaido accounts for about 30% of Japan's potato production. This year's potato production is about 10-20% lower than normal, and the volume of potatoes with small sizes and irregular shapes has increased due to recordhigh summer temperatures.



Changes in percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2025






Structure of exports by products to Japan, Aug-2025









Japan, Aug-2025





Cambodian cashew nut processing enterprises plan to expand production for exporting to the Japanese market

On October 1, 2025, the Ministry of Trade of Cambodia worked with Inoue Calcium Corporation to discuss the plan of expanding the production and processing of cashew nuts into finished products for export to the Japanese market.

At the meeting, the Ministry of Trade congratulated the cashew nut processing facility in Stung Treng province on its success in exporting the first batch of products, with a volume of 1 ton, to Japan, and said that this enterprise plans to continue exporting 2 more containers in 2026.

In addition, the Chairman of the Cambodia Cashew Nut Association said that the market, price and output of cashew nuts in 2025 will remain stable and positive, although heavy rainfall in the year has somewhat affected the quality of cashew nuts.



Percentage of export value to Japan, Aug-2025





At the beginning of 2026, Japan's total pig herd will be stable at about 8.65 million heads, of which the sow herd will reach 755 thousand heads. Pork production and slaughter numbers are almost unchanged compared to 2025, reaching 1.27 million tonnes of CWE and 16.05 million heads, respectively.

Pork consumption continued at a high level of 2.765 million tonnes CWE, supported by price advantages amid inflation and increased demand from both households and food services, although consumption of processed products slowed somewhat.

Pork imports slowed in the second half of 2025 due to high inventories, but are forecast to recover in 2026 to meet domestic demand, reaching 1.48 million tonnes CWE (weight per carcass).
