





New position of Vietnamese United States

In 2022, US importers bought nearly 14 billion USD of agricultural and aquatic products of all kinds from Vietnam,

accounting for 25% of Vietnam's total bilateral trade turnover in 2022 of nearly agricultural export value. With this 123 billion USD. agricultural products in the turnover, the United States has become Vietnam's largest agricultural export market, surpassing China.

> Vietnam, from ranking 95th among the US's partners, has now become the 8th largest trading partner of the US, with a







In December 2022, consumer price inflation in the United States dropped to its lowest level in the past year (as announced by the US Department of Labor). This is a sign that the worst of

overheating prices may be over. The consumer price index (CPI) increased by 6.5% in December 2022, slower than the increase of 7.1% in November 2022. This is also the first month in the past 14 On January 26, the US Department of Commerce (DOC) months (since November 2021) that CPI decreased, thanks to the announced that GDP in the fourth quarter of 2022 had a growth decrease in gasoline and other commodity prices. This is also a rate of 2.9%, lower than 3.2% in the previous quarter. 








Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Dec-2022








Value ratio of TOP 5 export enterprises to the U.S., Dec-2022
















Export volume and value to the U.S., Dec-2022








Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Dec-2022










Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Dec-2022










Structure of exports by products to the U.S., Dec-2022










In 2022, Vietnamese agriculture will continue to have 11 product groups with an export turnover of over 1 billion USD, of which cashew nuts are one of 7 products with a turnover of over 3 billion USD (wood and wood products, shrimp, coffee, rice, rubber; vegetables, cashew nuts). The US market accounts for 31.57% of turnover and 31.98% of Vietnam's cashew nut export output.





SPOTLIGHTS

According to data from the United States International Trade Commission (USITC), in November the country's pepper imports continued to decrease by 6.6% over the previous month but increased by nearly 31% over the same period.

Accumulated for 11 months, US pepper imports decreased by 3.4% in volume but increased by 29.4% in value over the same period in 2021, reaching 82,356 tons with a turnover of 412.4 million USD. In particular, the amount of US pepper imported from Brazil and India in 11 months decreased by 37.2% and 24.9%, respectively, to 6,177 tons and 5,699 tons.

However, imports from Vietnam, the largest source of pepper for this market, increased by 3.9% in volume and 41.4% in value after 11 months, reaching 60,474 tons, worth 299.4 million USD. Vietnam's market share in the total volume of US pepper imports increased to 73.4% compared to 68.3% in the same period.







Inflation in the United States is rising, consumers are tightening spending on non-essential items such as wooden furniture, greatly affecting the export activities of Vietnamese businesses, possibly pulling down furniture export turnover. Wood entering the United States continues to decline sharply in the short term.

WOOD & PRODUCTS

In mid-December 2022, the US Federal Reserve decided to increase interest rates at a slower pace. According to experts, this is positive information for the global economy and can support speculative buying activities in the rubber market.

RUBBER

According to the Ministry of Industry and Trade, with the policy of multilateralization and market diversification, the fruit and vegetable industry will grow more positively in 2023. In particular, the United States has a large demand for importing fruit and vegetable products, however Vietnam only provides a small proportion, so the opportunity to expand to these markets is huge.

FRUITS & VEGETABLES

The Agency of Foreign Trade predicts that US importers will show signs of increasing pepper purchases with long-distance orders in the third and fourth quarters of 2023, however, the transaction volume will not be much.

PEPPER

Vietnam currently mainly exports Robusta coffee to the United States in raw form, which does not bring high value to the industry. In 2023 and the following years, Vietnam's coffee industry needs to promote branding, planning and development of appropriate raw material areas, on par with development requirements, promoting the application of science and technology, and transforming digital, green transformation, meeting strict requirements from the US market.

COFFEE

Due to the impact of inflation and economic recession in the US market, consumers are tightening spending, limiting non-essential foods, and importers are also more moderate, so it is predicted that in 2023, the situation will change. Exporting cashew kernels to this market still faces many difficulties and challenges.

CASHEW NUTS



Vietnam's seafood exports to this market will decrease slightly in the first quarter of 2023 due to the impact of inflation. However, the value of pangasius exports to the United States is forecast to grow again. In 2023, the whitefish market outlook is forecast to be positive with growth for tilapia, pangasius, pollock and haddock, while the cod market is constrained by reduced supply from Russia. Demand for pangasius and tilapia in the United States in 2023 is forecast optimistically thanks to stable supply. The US economy is facing difficulties, pangasius and tilapia open up opportunities for seafood companies to provide a protein that can serve a family of 4 to 5 people for only 15-20 USD.
